

Introduction to Children's Literature

The book is intended for students, researchers and readers of (children's) literature. The authors tackle the issue of describing children's literature and connecting it to other practices and phenomena as well as the issues connected with understanding children's literature. The main intention of this book is to present as many different levels at which children's literature has been perceived and has appeared throughout history, and possibly create space for any future areas of research.³

The first chapter discusses the term 'children's literature'. The following chapter describes the key institutional mechanisms for the creation of children's literature, its distribution and evaluation: publishers, libraries, reward books, required reading, censorship, etc. This is followed by a chapter devoted to the status of authors and readers of children's literature, and a chapter on the status of genre in children's literature. The subsequent three chapters represent the historical and poetic features of picture books, novels, fairy tales and fantastic stories, as well as children's poetry. A special chapter is devoted to the literary animalistic stories, a prominent phenomenon in children's literature, while the final chapter introduces outlines of young adult literature, which is closely related to children's literature.


Uvod u dječju književnost

Knjiga je namijenjena studentima, istraživačima i čitateljima (djeće) književnosti. Autorice se u knjizi bave pitanjima opisa dječje književnosti, povezanosti s drugim praksama i pojavnama, kao i pitanjima razumijevanja dječje književnosti. Glavna intencija uvoda jest predstaviti što je moguće više različitih razina na kojima se dječja književnost tijekom povijesti percipirala i pojavljivala, te eventualno stvoriti prostore za neka buduća područja istraživanja.

U prvom poglavlju problematizira se pojam dječje književnosti. Slijedi poglavlje u kojem se opisuju ključni institucijski mehanizmi produkcije dječje književnosti, distribucije i valorizacije: nakladnici, knjižnice, nagradne knjige, lektira, cenzura i dr.

Nakon toga slijedi poglavlje posvećeno statusu autora i čitatelja dječje književnosti, a zatim poglavlje o statusu žanra u dječjoj književnosti. U sljedeća tri poglavlja predstavljaju se povjesne i poetičke značajke slikovnice, romana, bajke, fantastične priče i dječjeg pjesništva. Posebno je poglavlje posvećeno u dječjoj književnosti istaknutom fenomenu književne animalistike, a u posljednjem su poglavlju predstavljene konture dječjoj književnosti srodne adolescentske književnosti.⁴



The Book of Proceedings dedicated to the novel *The Strange Adventures of Hlapić the Apprentice* by Ivana Brlić-Mažuranić (1874-1938) and related topics contains most of the papers presented at the international research conference *From the Strange to the Wondrous*, which was held from 17 to 20 April 2013 in Zagreb and Slavonski Brod, marking the 100th anniversary of the publication of the novel. The papers published in the Book of Proceedings are grouped into three thematic sections. The first part, entitled "About Hlapić", includes 30 research papers which explore the novel from a number of aspects. The second part of the book is entitled "With Hlapić" and includes 7 papers that approach the novel from the educational point of view and explore different issues from the aspects of Croatian language and literature teaching methodology. The third part, entitled "Around Hlapić", contains 15 papers divided into three subgroups according to the authors' research interests, with the second subgroup being dedicated to *Croatian Tales of Long Ago*. All papers have been peer-reviewed and categorized. The list of referees is provided at the back of the book.⁵

Zbornik radova o romanu *Čudnovate zgode šegrta Hlapića* Ivane Brlić-Mažuranić (1874. – 1938.) i srodnim temama sadrži većinu radova s međunarodne znanstvene konferencije *Od čudnovatog do čudesnog* održane od 17. do 20. travnja 2013. u Zagrebu i Slavonskome Brodu, o stotoj obljetnici objavljivanja tog romana. Radovi u zborniku grupirani su u tri tematske cjeline. Prvi dio, pod nazivom „*O Hlapiću*“, uključuje 30 radova koji istražuju djelo s različitim aspekata. Drugi dio knjige naslovjen je „*S Hlapićem*“ i obuhvaća 7 radova koji romanu pristupaju s pedagoškog stajališta i istražuju različita pitanja iz aspekta metodike hrvatskoga jezika i književnosti. Treći dio, pod nazivom „*Oko Hlapića*“, sadrži 15 radova raspoređenih u tri podskupine prema istraživačkim interesima autora, od kojih se izdvaja druga posvećena djelu *Priče iz davnine*. Svi radovi podvrgnuti su međunarodnoj i domaćoj recenziji i kategorizirani prema ocjenama recenzentata. Popis recenzentata objavljen je na kraju knjige.⁶
