Dear Readers,

I have taken on the honourable but onerous duty of being the editor in chief of the journal of the Croatian Entomological Society – *Entomologica Croatica*, which has an unbroken series since 1995. To date the editors in chief have been Academicians Zdravko Lorkovic and Milan Maceljski.

This issue is dedicated to Academician Milan Maceljski, to mark his eightieth year.

Things begun need to be continued, and in fact the assignment does not seem so very arduous, but in today's conditions of globalisation and the desire for the development of the science of entomology in the country it is nevertheless a major challenge. It is our wish to keep up and develop scientific Croatian, but in order to be closer to the world at large and generally intelligible, we shall also use the language of the majority. Croatian authors who choose to write in English also have the opportunity in their Croatian abstracts to contribute to the preservation of the Croatian of the discipline. The best solution would indeed be if the journal could be written bilingually.

It is our hope that, alongside foreign investigators who show an interest in publishing the results of their scientific research in our journal and also in investigating the Croatian entomofauna, our own scientists with the same wish will grow in numbers. We shall do our best to make sure that the journal comes out at regular intervals, and that the contents and the quality of the papers contribute to its being cited more frequently, hence meeting the criteria set for the promotion of young researchers.

For the future we would like the journal to be an indicator of the development of the entomological science within the framework of natural history in the world at large and in our own country in particular.

May the Croatian Clearwing Moth (*Hemaris croatica* Esper 1779), which our Society has adopted as its symbol, flutter into the hands of as large as possible a number of readers and may it not leave them indifferent. May it spur them to research and to publish high-quality scientific papers from the domain of entomology.

I would like to thank members of the editorial board for their efforts in the past, and look forward to renewed collaboration.

The new editor is professor emeritus of the university, but is still active in university life in Zagreb, in the post-graduate school, in Dubrovnik and in Mostar in undergraduate teaching and scientific projects. She is mainly concerned with research into coleopterans in the forest communities of Highland Croatia. She has published over one hundred original scientific and survey papers, and several textbooks and books and created TV programmes. She has organised and been a participant in numerous conferences from the areas of biology, ecology and entomology. Professor Durbesic has supervised over fifty undergraduate dissertations, eight master's theses and nine doctoral theses, as well as scientific projects. She is a member of a number of scientific associations at home and abroad, and has been a member of the Croatian Entomological Society/Association from its foundation. She has won a number of awards and acknowledgements, such as national scientific awards, a plaque from the Croatian Biological Association and the Croatian Ecological Association, and is an honorary member of these associations. She has been particularly prominent in the Croatian Ecological Association, of which she is lifetime honorary president.
