

EKONOMSKI PREGLED is the journal of the Croatian Economic Association (CEA) which publishes theoretical, empirical and applicable articles, covering all fields of economic science. The journal is published twelve times a year. Ekonomski pregled publishes the CEA members' papers. One becomes the CEA's member by subscribing to the journal EKONOMSKI PREGLED. Papers should be written in A4 format, double spaced (including footnotes and references), wide margins and pages numbered consecutively. They should be sent in three hard copies and a copy in electronic version- (floppy disc or CD, in WORD or PDF format).

The first page should contain the author's name and surname, the name and address of the institution he is employed in, e-mail address, phone, and the title of paper.

The articles, as a rule, should not exceed 24 pages (1,5 sheet), including bibliography. The abstract enclosed in Croatian and English, among 10-15 lines, outlines the purpose of article, methodology, results and conclusion. The key words should be also cited.

The cited sources in text should be in shortened form; e.g. (Porter, 1990). If the part of text in article is taken over or it has been literally cited, the page that the citation is taken from should be cited. If more works by the same author with the same year of publication are cited, they should be differed by the letters (a,b,c), after the publication year. Bibliographic data should be exact and complete. The list of all used and cited works should be given at the end of text, alphabetically, in the following way:

Any article which does not conform to the above instructions may be returned for the necessary revision before publication.

Contributions which aspire to scientific/professional categorization are liable to peer-review. Only positively rated articles will be published. These articles are categorized as follows:

- original scientific paper (contains so far unpublished results of original scientific researches)
- preliminary statement (contains the results of new researches on the projects in progress), not necessarily having as much details as needed for checking data in original scientific papers. Such papers demand fast publication.
- article review (gives a concise and critical survey of the condition and trends of specific sphere, and is accompanied by comprehensive bibliography which shows the author's contribution to this sphere.)
- professional paper (should not be associated with original research, but gives proposals for the application of results of previous scientific researches.)
- presentation from scientific meeting (should be conceived as an integral article, and is published on the proposal of editor and members of editorial board.)

Decision on categorization is brought by the Editorial board based on the suggestion of two reviewers.
