## **AUTHOR GUIDELINES**

submissions.

Manuscript and figures need to be submitted at the Editor-in-Chief e-mail address. The manuscript should not exceed 25 formatted pages if previously editor-in-chief did not approve it. Text needs to be formatted as DOC file type (Microsoft Word). The main or corresponding author need to ask editor, fill and send back copyright form where transferring relevant rights to publisher. Such statement is valid for all authors and need to be sent by post to Editor-in-Chief. Format papers as A4, 1.5 spaced, font type Times New Roman, 12 point for text, 11 point for figure/ tables captions, that both are also italic. The manuscript margins are 3.5 cm up - left, and 2.5 cm down - right.

Manuscripts should be organized in the following order:

- Title (12-point font, bold),
- Name(s) author(s) (12-point font),
- Adress(es), and corresponding author's marks with e-mail (11-point font, italic),
- Key-words up to 5 terms (10-point font),
- Summary up to 200 words (10 point font).

The summary should not be longer than 200 words and should be written in English and Croatian. No references should be cited in the summary.

Main parts of paper are: (1) Introduction, (2) Methods, techniques, material studied and area description, (3) Results and Discusions, (4) Conclusions, (5) References.

#### Headings and Subhedas

Make sure that major headings, subheads and sub-subheads are clearly distinguishable by using

following styles:

- (1) First Level Headings 12 point bold on line by itself
- (2) Second Level Headings 12 point italic, bold, on line by itself
- (3) Third Level Headings 12 point italic, on line by itself.

All references to publications in the text should be presented in a list of references. The manuscripts should be carefully checked to ensure that the spelling of the authors' names and dates are exactly the same in the text as in the reference list. In the text refer to the author's name or to original source and year of publication, followed – if necessary – by a short reference to appropriate pages. If reference is made in the next to publications written by more than two authors the name of the first author should be used, followed by «et al.». This indication, however, should never be used in the list of references. In this list names of authors and coauthors with initials should be mentioned instead. The list of references should be arranged alphabetically on authors' names, and chronologically per author.

The following format should be used for the reference list:

(a) for periodicals Jurković, I. and Durn, G. (1988): Deposits in the Zrin District of Trgovska Gora in Croatia.

Geol. vjesnik, 41, 327-339, Zagreb.

(b) for procedings of conferences, symposia, etc. Durn, G., et al. (2002): Geochemical and Mineralogical Assessment of Lime Stabilized

Waste from Petroleum Industry in Croatia, ASME Engineering Technology Conference on Energy, February 4-6, P. 9., Houston.

- (c) for books Wilson, J. L. (1975): Carbonate faces in geologic history. Springer, 471 pp, Berlin.
- (d) for multi-author books Stonesipher, S. A. (1978): Chemistry of deep-sea philipsite, clinoptilolite, and host sediments.

In: Sand, L. B. and Mumpton, F. A. (editors): Natural zeolites, Pergamon, 221-234 pp., Oxford.

All references where DOL is available need to have it visible, after the end of entry (\_'dot' DOL).

References, if it is needed, are separated into following subtitles - published papers (books), internet sources and/or from professional archives.

### **Tables and Figures**

Tables and figures should be sent at the end of DOC file as text (tables) and imported (figures) bitmaps (.jpg, .tiff ...). The position of figure or table in the text should be signed (eg. Position c.) Figure 1./Table 1.). Number figures and tables in Arabic numerals. Avoid numbering individual figures as Fig. 11a. and Fig 11b. Instead, make them Fig. 11 and Fig. 12. Figures and photos prepared for paper can be black-white or color. Be sure to send clear, high-resolution figures and photos, becasue they could be reduced in size and formatted in two-columns text. If you would like to keep original size of your figure propose it (eg. Position c.) Figure 1 in original size).

Figures are named in the following style:

Figure 1: Here comes the caption if only I sentence is used

Figure 2: This is caption of Figure 2. Note difference of 2 or more sentences are used.

Tables are named in the same way.

When paper is accepted, final text with imported tables and figures at the end is submitted as DOC. Simultaneously, the figures are sent also as set of bitmaps in resolution of 300 dpi.

#### Units

The use of SI metric units is obligatory.

#### Miscellaneous

Footnotes should be used if absolutely essential. In most cases it should be possible to incorporate them in the normal text. When the citations, figures or tables are mentioned in text, they need to be bolded like Jurković and Durn (1988), Figures 5, Tables 2.

These instructions are intendend to aid you in preparing your manuscript to be considered for publication in The Mining-Geology-Petroleum Engineering Bulletin. Failure to follow these guidelines could result in your manuscript being returned to you for further revision.

## SUBMISSION PREPARATION CHECKLIST

As part of the submission process, authors are required to check off their submission's compliance with all of the following items, and submissions may be returned to authors that do not adhere to these guidelines.

- 1. The submission has not been previously published, nor is it before another journal for consideration (or an explanation has been provided in Comments to the Editor).
- 2. The submission is prepared according to author's instruction, i.e. text adheres to the

stylistic and bibliographic requirements outlined in the Author Guidelines, which is found in About the Journal.

- 3. Where available, DOI and URLs for the references have been provided.
- Author(s) are enclosed recommendation of two reviewers, and editor will decided about acceptance.
