Ubroju *Kardio lista* za prosinac 2010. godine objavljen je u rubrici "Ostalo" rad pod naslovom "Pet godina rada Laboratorija za kateterizaciju srca i invazivnu kardiologiju Kliničkog bolničkog centra Osijek" autorice dr. Sandre Makarović¹, u kojemu je između ostalog spomenuto i osnivanje Laboratorija godine 2005. god., a sada su podijeljene zahvalnice kolegama "koji su prepoznali potrebu za otvaranjem kateterizacijskog laboratoriјa te nam pomogli u njegovom nastajanju i radu. Time se neizmjerno puno učinilo za pacijente iz područja cijele Slavonije i Baranje..."

Čitajući članak, kao bivši v. d. Zamjenik ravnatelja i Ravnatelj Kliničke bolnice Osijek iskre sjećanja upravo na to vrijeme inicijacije, stvaranja elaborata, opstrukcije nekih "zaslužnika" koji su na razne načine spriječavali otvaranje ovog vitalnog centra za dijagnostiku i liječenje kardiovaskularnih bolesnika davajući svakojaku pripomoć u nakanama otvaranja takvih centara daleko od Osijeka. Na svakom koraku opstruirala se prenamjena prostora, kupnja aparature, edukacija liječnika i medicinskih sestara...

Stoga bih molio u duhu kolegijalnosti i (sada vec) međikohistoriografske istine, da objavite ovaj članak kako bi se ispravila nenamjerna nepravda. Čitav projekt počeo je 2003. godine, a realiziran 2005. godine, kada je Laboratorij otvoren. Ne smijemo dopustiti relikvije nekih prošlih vremena u kojima su paradoksalne nezaslužene lоворike brali drugi, a oni koji su ostvarili projekt nisu niti spomenuti.

Naime, nakon odbijanja zahtjeva 2002. godine, tijekom 2003. na inicijativu tadašnje predstojnice Interne klinike i šefa Kardiovaskularnog odjela klinike prof. dr. sc. Katje Čatipović Veselica i Udruge kardiovaskularnih bolesnika sačinjen je elaborat i pokrenut zahtjev prema Ravnateljstvu bolnice o potrebitosti osnivanja kateterizacijskog laboratoriјa kao vitalnoga projekta. Tadašnje Ravnateljstvo shvatilo je i prihvatiло ovu inicijativu te je stvoren tim Ravnateljstva, predstojnika Interne i Kirurške klinike te Odjela za anestezijologiju i Odjela za radiologiju tadašnje Kliničke bolnice Osijek koji će delegirati liječnike, medicinske sestre i tehničare za edukaciju. U međuvremenu potpisana je ugovor o suradnji između Kliničkog bolničkog centra Zagreb i Kliničke bolnice Osijek, pa su tako poslana prva dva kardiologa, jedan kirurg, pa kasnije još dva završena kirurga na subspecializaciju iz kardijalne kirurgije, dva anestezijologa te medicinski tehničari, medicinske sestre, instrumentarke, anestezijološki tehničari, inženjeri radiologije koji su odlazili na edukaciju u Zagreb. Invasive Cardiology and Cardiosurgery in Osijek — Beginning of 2003

An article entitled "Five-Year Work of the Laboratory for the Catheterization of Heart and Invasive Cardiology of the Clinical Hospital Centre Osijek", by author Dr. Sandra Makarović¹, was published in the issue of *Kardio list* in December 2010 in the column "Other". The article mentions the establishment of the Laboratory in 2005 and now the certificates of gratitude have been distributed among the colleagues who have recognized the need for opening catheterization laboratory helping us in its establishment and work. This is how a lot has been done for the patients from the region of Slavonia and Baranja...

Reading the article as a former Deputy Principal and Principal of the Osijek Clinical Hospital, I remember the time of initiation, preparation of the study, obstruction by some "meritous persons" who in various ways tried to prevent opening of this vital center for diagnostics and treatment of cardiovascular patients giving different kinds of help in opening such centers far away from Osijek. At every step they obstructed the refurbishment of premises, purchase of devices, training of physicians and nurses...

Therefore, I would like to ask you in the name of collegiality and for the sake of historic truth to publish this article as to make accidentally caused injustice right. The project started in 2003 and was implemented in 2005 when the Laboratory was opened. We should not allow any heritage of past times occur when paradoxical non-deserved recognitions and credits were taken by others, and those who implemented the project were not even mentioned.

After the request in 2002 was rejected, during 2003 on request by the former principal of the Internal Medicine Clinic and Chief of Cardiovascular Department of the Clinic, Prof. Katja Čatipović Veselica, PhD and Association of Cardiovascular Patients, a study was prepared and the request was submitted to the Hospital Directorate of necessity of establishment of catheterization laboratory as a vital project. The former Directorate understood and accepted this initiative and formed a Directorate team, team of Principles of Internal Medicine and Surgical Clinic, Department for Anesthesiology and the Radiology Department of the Osijek Clinical Hospital that delegated physicians and nurses for training. In the meantime, an agreement of cooperation between the Clinical Hospital Centre Zagreb and Osijek Clinical Hospital was concluded, so two cardiologists were sent, one surgeon and later two educated surgeons were sent for subspecialization in cardiac surgery, two anesthesiologists and nurses, instrument nurses, anesthesiologist nurses, radiology engineers who went to Zagreb for the purpose of receiving training.
