At the International Children's Map Exhibition held this year on the topic of *Life in a globalized world*, as part of the 25th International Cartographic Conference organized by the International Cartographic Association (ICA) from 3-8 July 2011, in Paris, 186 children's drawings from 31 countries, including 6 drawings from Croatia, were exhibited.

The *Barbara Petchenik* awards for children's maps were initiated by the ICA in 1993, in memory of Barbara Petchenik, Vice-President of the Association and a cartographer who dedicated her working life to maps and children. The awards are presented every two years during the international cartographic conference, ideally one for every continent, with special attention paid to the age of the child who produced the drawing.

So far, Croatia has participated successfully in exhibitions in Barcelona in 1995, Stockholm in 1997, Ottawa in 1999, Beijing in 2001, Durban in 2003, A Coruna in 2005, Moscow in 2007 and Santiago in 2009. The drawing *Once is not enough – recycle* by Marinko Cirkvenčić, exhibited in Barcelona, was included in the UNICEF poster *Children Draw the World*, and *Compass Card* by Anita Matković, exhibited in Stockholm, was one of the winners. The drawing *World Map* by Ranko Vuković, exhibited in Beijing, was chosen as the cover illustration for the book *Spatial Data Quality Elements* (edited by S. C. Gupta and J. L. Morrison, translated by D. Tutić and M. Lapaine), published by the State Geodetic Administration in Zagreb in 2001. Amela Kičić's, *Eco Map of the World*, exhibited in Beijing, was included as an illustration in a desk calendar published for 2004 on the occasion of the International Cartographic Conference in Durban, by the South African Council for Geoscience, in collaboration with the ICA. Six children's drawings from Croatia were published in the book *Children Map the World* edited by J. M. Anderson, J. Atwal, P. Wiegand and A. Auringer Wood (ESRI Press, Redlands, California, 2005). Hrvatska na Međunarodnoj izložbi dječjih radova u Parizu 2011.

Pariz, 3–8. srpnja 2011.

Na Međunarodnoj izložbi dječjih radova koja se ove godine na temu *Život u globaliziranom svijetu* održala u sklopu 25. međunarodne kartografske konferencije Međunarodnoga kartografskog društva u Parizu, od 3. do 8. srpnja 2011. bilo je izloženo 186 dječjih radova iz 31 države među kojima i 6 iz Hrvatske.

Nagradu *Barbara Petchenik* za dječju kartu svijeta pokrenulo je Međunarodno kartografsko društvo (International Cartographic Association – ICA) 1993. godine kao uspomenu na Barbaru Petchenik, dopredsjednicu toga društva i kartografkinju koja se cijeli život bavila s kartama i djecom. Nagrade se dodjeljuju svake druge godine za vrijeme međunarodne kartografske konferencije, po mogućnosti barem jedna za svaki kontinent, a posebna se pažnja posvećuje dobu djeteta koje je nacrtalo crtež.

Hrvatska je do sada s uspjehom sudjelovala na izložbama u Barceloni 1995, Stockholmu 1997, Ottawi 1999, Pekingu 2001, Durbanu 2003, A Coruñi 2005, Moskvi 2007. i Santiagu 2009. Rad *Once is not enough – Recycle* Marinka Cirkvenčića izložen u Barceloni uvršten je poslije u poster UNICEF-a *Children Draw the World*, a *Compass Card* Anite Matković, izložen u Stockholmu, proglašen je jednim od pobjednika. Crtež *World Map* Ranka Vukovića izložen u Pekingu, izabran je za ilustraciju na naslovnici knjige *Elementi kvalitete prostornih podataka* (urednici izvornika S. C. Gupta i J. L. Morrison, preveli D. Tutić i M. Lapaine) što ju je izdala Državna geodetska uprava u Zagrebu, 2001. *Eco map of the World* Amele Kičić izložena u Pekingu, uvrštena je kao ilustracija u stolni kalendar što ga je za 2004. godinu, a u povodu Međunarodne kartografske konferencije u Durbanu, izdao the Council for Geoscience iz Južne Afrike u suradnji s ICA-om. Šest dječjih radova iz Hrvatske objavljeno je u knjizi *Children Map the World* što su je uredili J. M. Anderson, J. Atwal, P. Wiegand i A. Auringer Wood (ESRI Press, Redlands, California, 2005). Natjecateljski rad za izložbu u Barceloni *My Island* Ivane Miličević izabran je za na-

Miličević, exhibited in Barcelona, was published on the cover of *Cartography and Geoinformation*, No. 5. In the second volume of this book, this time edited by T. Bandrova, J. R. Nunez, M. Konecny and J. Atwal (ESRI Press, Redlands, California, 2010), a map by six-year-old Elvis Plantak from Varaždin entitled *A Map of the World in Colours for Dancing* was published. The same child's work was published on the cover of *Cartography and Geoinformation*, No. 8. A drawing entitled *Many Nations - One World in the Balloon* by Agata Lučić, displayed in Moscow, was chosen to illustrate certificates awarded to participants in the workshop *Children draw the world* held during the 2010 Festival of Science organized by the Croatian Cartographic Society.

The Committee for Exhibitions of the Croatian Cartographic Society informed the Croatian public of the rules and directions for the Barbara Petchenik Award Children's Map Competition for 2011 in the journals *Geodetski list*, *Meridijani* and *Modra lasta*, and on the web-pages of the Croatian Cartographic Society (<http://www.kartografija.hr>), Croatian Geographic Society (<http://www.geografija.hr>), the Croatian Educational Portal Zbornica (<http://www.zbornica.com/>), Portal for Schools (<http://www.skole.hr/>), Portal Kinfo.hr (<http://www.kinfo.hr/>) and association "Suradnici u učenju" (<http://ucitelji.hr/>). Institutions with primary and secondary school curricula, which can be found on the website of the Ministry of Science, Education and Sports, <http://public.mzos.hr>, were informed by e-mail. As a result, several primary and secondary schools advertised the competition on their web-pages.

Altogether, 34 institutions submitted 190 children's drawings to the competition (Table 1).

The Committee comprised Assist. Prof. Dr. Ivka Kljajić, Assist. Prof. Robert Župan and Ana Kuveždić Divjak, Grad. Eng. from the Institute for Cartography and Photogrammetry of the Faculty of Geodesy, University of Zagreb, Mira Miletić-Drder, MSc, from the National and University Library in Zagreb and Vladimir Blažanović, an artist academician from Zagreb. They selected the following six children's drawings to represent Croatia at the International Children's Map Exhibition in Paris:
