Psoriasis 2007, 2nd International Congress on Psoriasis

In Paris, Palais des Congrés, June 21-24, 2007, under the auspices of the EADV Psoriasis Taskforce, Professor Luis Dubertret organized successful 2nd International Congress on Psoriasis with some 1000 participants. It was a scientific and clinical event that takes place every third year in Paris, organized alternatively by national psoriasis clubs.

The Congress consisted of plenary sessions, workshops (14 in total) and satellite symposia. The program covered all relevant aspects of psoriasis, as follows: genetics, pharmacogenomics, comorbidity and treatment safety, and cardiovascular risk in psoriasis, with special reference to the management of severe psoriasis manifestations, systemic drugs for psoriasis (retinoids, cyclosporine and fumaric acid as well as biologicals). Special workshops were dedicated to phototherapy, extracutaneous manifestations of the disease,

treatment of psoriasis in children and pregnancy, treatment of psoriasis in specific localizations (anogenital area, nail psoriasis, scalp psoriasis). It was emphasized that no advances in the management of psoriasis could be expected without close and ethical collaboration between practitioners and pharmaceutical industries. The satellite symposium entitled Realizing the Individualized Treatment Opportunity in Psoriasis, sponsored by Wyeth (chairman, Professor Louis Dubertret), caught great attention of the audience. Four experts from Croatia took active part in the Congress, which offered an excellent opportunity for discussion and exchange of experience with colleagues from all over the world. The Congress provided a valuable contribution to the celebration of the 400th anniversary of the famous Parisian Saint Louis Hospital, and was accompanied by excellently organized and attractive social events. The 3rd Congress on Psoriasis will be organized by Professor Sterry (Germany) in three years.

Dr. Luitgard Wiest, ISD Vice-President, took active part in the Opening Ceremony and as a lecturer in workshops and plenary program. The lectures were presented in lecture hall, Audimax, at Technical University, whereas practical courses/workshops and the Meet the Expert Sessions took place at Department of Dermatology, University of Munich. Very important topics were tackled at this year's Academy, on Friday, July 27 in particular: What's new in dermato-allergology, dermatosurgery and lasers, esthetic dermatology, and pediatric dermatology.
