Historical review and bibliography of master theses of postgraduate study – Agricultural economics, masters study at the University of Zagreb, Faculty of Agriculture (1964 – 2010)

Tito Žimbrek Monography

Prof Tito Žimbrek, longtime head of the study, is the author of the monographic review of the postgraduate study Agricultural economics, masters study at the University of Zagreb, Faculty of Agriculture.

On 286 pages the development of postgraduate education and the activities of agricultural economists at the University of Zagreb, Faculty of Agriculture, as well as historical overview of masters study Agricultural economics, are shown.

The Study was conducted since the academic year 1964/1965 until the academic year 2005/2006, when the Bologna Process was introduced at the University.

The most important part of the monography is the bibliography of masters theses. This includes analytic description of 87 masters theses and includes content, aims, methods, hypotheses and key findings of the research for each thesis. Detailed descriptions of subject matters and research areas, as well as short review of Croatian agriculture in time when the Study was conducted, is also given.

In conducting this Study over a hundred teachers from various Faculties were involved.

MScs who finished this Study are successful members of academic communities at higher educational institutions as well as other educational and scientific institutions. Around one third of the students who got their masters degrees, successfully finished doctoral study.

When all this is taken into account, it is safe to say that the postgraduate study Economics of agriculture contributed to the development and reputation of the agroeconomics in Croatia and abroad.

This monography is dedicated to those who attended the Study, all the teachers and all those who contributed to the Study's successful functioning.

The monography can be used as a useful literature for preparing exams and seminars at undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate studies in the field of agroeconomics.
