

IVICA ANIĆ, D.D.S., Ph.D., docent u Zavodu za dentalnu patologiju Stomatološkog fakulteta u Zagrebu, rođen je godine 1961. u Zagrebu gdje je završio školovanje i godine 1984. diplomirao na Stomatološkom fakultetu. Po nacionalnosti je Hrvat. Kao student dobitnik je Rektorove nagrade za rad iz područja onkologije.

Nakon studija radio je kratko vrijeme u primarnoj stomatološkoj skrbi u Hrvatskoj i u Sloveniji, zatim je upisao poslijediplomski studij na Stomatološkom fakultetu u Zagrebu gdje je 1988. obranio i magistarski rad. a 1991. i doktorsku disertaciju.

Rad na Fakultetu počeo je kao znanstveni novak 1988. zatim je bio izabran za asistenta, a 1993. za docenta. Za izvanrednog profesora izabran je godine 1996.

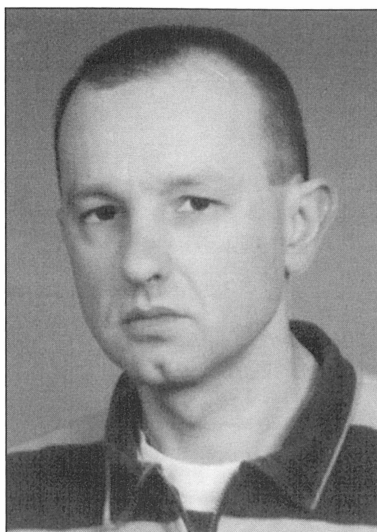
Specijalistički ispit iz dentalne i oralne patologije s parodontologijom položio je 1992.

Usavršavajući se u struci i na znanstvenome polju, boravio je 1990 u United Medical and Dental School, St. Guys and St. Thomas Hospital u Londonu, a zatim 1993./94. na Showa University u Tokiju.

Početkom Domovinskog rata u Hrvatskoj proveo je kao dobrovoljac Zbora narodne garde određeno vrijeme na istočnom bojištu. Posebna su mu područja zanimanja primjena mekog i tvrdog lasera na tvrda i meka tkiva zuba i usne šupljine, rubna pukotina amalgama, elektropotencijal amalgama, anomalije zuba, kompozitni materijali i druga, iz kojih je objavio oko 35 radova od kojih su neki prevedeni na japanski jezik. Sudionik je međunarodnih simpozija i kongresa pa je 1991. u Cannesu njegov rad nominiran za najbolji znanstveni rad u Europi na području endodoncije, a 1995. dobiva u Tel Avivu "Hans Genet Award" koji European Society of Endodontology, Netherlands Society of Endodontology i Hans Genet foundation dodjeljuju najperspektivnijem mladom endodontologu u Europi za prethodne dvije godine.

Voditelj je tečajeva trajne izobrazbe na Stomatološkom fakultetu u Zagrebu, sudjeluje u dvama projektima financiranim od Ministarstva znanosti i tehnologije Republike Hrvatske.

Član je Hrvatskoga stomatološkog društva, Hrvatskoga liječničkog zbora, European Society of Endodontology, Hrvatskoga društva za medicinsku i biološku teh-



IVICA ANIĆ, D.D.S., Ph.D., Associate Professor in the Department of Dental Pathology School of Dental Medicine in Zagreb. Born in 1961 in Zagreb, where he completed his education, graduating from the School of Dental Medicine in 1984. He is a Croat. As a student he received the Rector's Award for his work in the field of oncology.

After graduating Prof. Anić worked for a short period in primary dental care in Croatia and Slovenia, and later enrolled in postgraduate study at the School of Dental Medicine in Zagreb, where he defended his Master of Science Thesis in 1988 and Doctoral Dissertation in 1991. In 1988 he began work at the School as a young scientific researcher. He was later elected Assistant, and then Assistant Professor in 1993. He has been elected Associate Professor. He passed the specialization exam in dental and oral pathology with parodontology in 1992.

In 1990 he paid a study visit to the United Medical and Dental School, St. Guys and St. Thomas Hospital, London, and in 1993/94 he stayed in the Showa University in Tokio, Japan. At the beginning of the War in Croatia he was a Volunteer in the Corps of the National Guard in Croatia and spent some time on the eastern front.

Prof. Anić's special areas of interest are the application of soft and hard laser on hard and soft tooth tissue and the oral cavity, marginal amalgam crazing, electropotential of amalgam, tooth anomalies, composite materials and others, about which he has published 35 papers, some of which have been translated into Japanese. He has participated in international congresses and symposiums. In 1991, in Cannes, his paper was nominated the best scientific paper in Europe in the field of endodontics, and in 1995 he received the "Hans Genet Award" in Tel Aviv, which is awarded by the European Society of Endodontology, Netherlands Society of Endodontology and the Hans Genet Foundation to the most perspective young endodontologist in Europe in the last two years.

Prof. Anić is Head of courses for permanent education at the School of Dental Medicine in Zagreb. He is also Co-investigator in two projects financed by the Ministry of Science and Technology of the Republic
