

1967 he moved to Zagreb and began work in PLIVA He was Editor in Chief and Proof Reader of many volumes of PLIVA's journals "Saopćenja" and "Medicus", and he started the monographic publication "Libelli Medici" and continually endeavoured to record events or data important for Croatian medicine, such as "Regulations of the Croatian Medical Association" from 1874 and texts of the physicians' hymn Carmen Medicorum. Vol. 33, No. 1 of *Acta Stomatologica Croatica* 1999 was the last result of his work. The journal was printed only a few days after his funeral at Mirgoj cemetery, Zagreb.

We said our farewells to Dr. Vladimir Baković with sadness in our hearts, aware that we had lost a great, noble and honest man, who radiated goodness and whose advice had helped us on so many occasions and whose words had encouraged and cheered us. His name remains, briefly but permanently written into the works of Croatian dental journalism. It is a great shame that we did not have the opportunity of longer co-operation.

The Editorial Office of *Acta Stomatologica Croatica* will always be grateful to him for joining us and for his professionalism in helping to produce a which will be a model for dental scientific and professional journalism, and for his kindness and friendship, which created among us an atmosphere of humanity and optimism. May he rest in peace.

Prof. Ivica Krmpotić
11. X. 1944. - 3. V. 1994.

Dobri ljudi uvijek prerano odlaze iz ovozemaljskog života. Jesu li tome razlozi u tome što njihova dobrota nije u stanju izdržati udarce koje im svakodnevica zadaje pa se brže i lakše troše, ili su uzroci negdje drugdje u nama nepoznatim visinama, ili se pak radi o tome da nestanak dobrote iz naše sredine više primjećujemo od nestanka prosječnosti, o tome je teško prosuđivati.

Činjenica je međutim da nam oni nedostaju, da ih se često sjećamo, da ih često spominjemo, da su još uvijek tu među nama premda ih fizički već duže nema.

Prof. Ivica Krmpotić umro je prije 5 godina, 3. svibnja 1994. Bio je naš prijatelj, kolega i suradnik, poštenjak i dobričina kakva je trebalo tražiti, vrli suprug i roditelj, vrstan stručnjak i znanstvenik. Na Stomatološkom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu i u hrvatskoj stomatologiji rijetki su bili pojedinci s kojima on nije bio u dobrim odnosima.

Ako je takvih i bilo, uzroci neslaganja bili su u njima, jer on jednostavno nije znao za lošu suradnju među ljudima.

Prošlo je pet godina otkako je toga proljetnog popodneva uz crveno nebo na zagrebačkome obzoru otišao iz svo-

ga Zagreba u vječnost, prošavši kalvariju teške bolesti kakva se događa tek rijetkima.

Njegov odlazak u dobi od nenavršenih 50 godina bio je težak udarac njegovoj obitelji, Zavodu za oralnu kirurgiju i Stomatološkom fakultetu u Zagrebu.

Njegovi Iva i Marko danas sigurno kroče njegovim putom, a žena mu Ljerka neprekidno kiti njegov grob cvijećem i s ponosom mu spominje ime.

Zavod su tih godina napustili stariji kolege odlaskom u mirovinu, a zrela se generacija slomila njegovom smrću. Danas kada Zavod stručno i znanstveno opet potpuno djeluje, kao njegov prijatelj, kolega i suradnik mogu reći da se odnosi iz doba u kojem je radio prof. Ivica Krmpotić neće više ponoviti, niti će odnosi koji su tada vladali više ikada krastiti Zavod za oralnu kirurgiju.

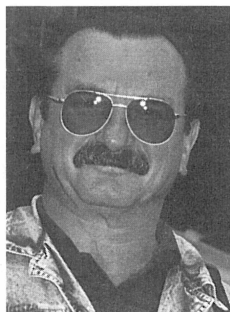

Tonko Kojundžić s pjesmom, koju mu je posvetila njemu nepoznata gospođa Vinka Anić, koja jednostavno govori sve o tome vremenu i o tome velikom čovjeku - našem Krmpiću.

Prof. Ivica Krmpotić 11.10.1944 - 3.5.1994

The good always leave this earthly life too early. Is it perhaps because their goodness cannot withstand the blows which everyday life delivers, and thus they deteriorate quicker, or are the reasons elsewhere in heights unknown to us, or is it because we are more aware of losing goodness from our surroundings than losing mediocrity?.

It is a fact that we miss them, that we frequently remember them, mention their names, and although they may have been physically absent for some time, they are still present among us.

Prof. Ivica Krmpotić died five years ago on the 3rd May 1994. He was our friend, colleague and co-worker. He was a good-natured, honest man, a wonderful husband and father, excellent dentist and scientist. There were few individuals at the School of Dental Medicine University of Zagreb and Croatian dentistry with whom he was not in good relations. If there were such individuals the reasons for discord were in them, because he simply was unable to provoke discord among people.

Five years have passed since that Spring afternoon when he left his Zagreb for eternity, after a Calvary of serious diseases.

His death at the age of 49 years was a hard blow to his family, the Department of Oral Surgery and the School of Dental Medicine in Zagreb.

His Iva and Marko are today following in his footsteps and his Ljerka regularly covers his grave with flowers and talks of him with pride.

Several older colleagues retired from the Department at that time, and consequently the mature generation was broken by his death. Today, when the Department is professionally and scientifically again completely active, I can say, as his friend, colleague and co-worker, that the relations which prevailed at the time Prof. Ivica Krmpotić worked can never be the same again, and neither will the relations which prevailed ever recur in the Department of Oral Surgery.

It is not my intention to speak of his professional-scientific abilities, because they are known to all who knew him, and those who did not have the pleasure of knowing him can find data in the Archives of the School of Dental Medicine in Zagreb. However, it should be remembered that modern dental implantology in Croatia developed on the basis of his projects and works and that the state of maxillofacial prosthetics today can be attributed to Prof. Ivo Miše and Prof. Ivica Krmpotić, as they succeeded in creating important scientific and professional results in this field.

I remember the exceptional character of Prof. Ivica Krmpotić, his wit, cheerfulness and kindness. I remember the family dinners, winter skiing holidays or outings to the Kornat islands with colleagues and friends, relaxing in good company and heavenly surroundings.

Today such moments remain in our memory, and in photographs which are slowly fading in family albums and the occasional video recording. Our mutual friend, Mr. Tonko Kojundžić dedicated a poem, which has been devoted to him

by Mrs. Vinka Anić, who simply speaks of that time and of that great man, our Krmpa.

This is how it was before
our company and Kaprije
boat, coves all just right
with the maestral gently blowing
why hurry to work or home
leave it all until dawn
with the sound of the crickets in the pine
enjoy life and do not hasten.

But how long can such days last
only The Almighty can say
since you are not here
all is despair, all is changed
far from the beauty while you were here
why did God decide to take you
I know why -
because he loved your company too.

TRAUMATSKE OZLJEDE ZUBA

Autori su ovoga vrlo preglednoga priručnika, koji na jednostavan, znanstveno i stručno dokumentiran način obrađuje sve mogućnosti traumatskih ozljeda zuba, osim poznatoga tandema Andreasen, još i profesor L.K. Bakland, voditelj Zavoda za endodonciju Stomatološkog fakulteta Sveučilišta Loma Linda iz S.A.D. i profesor M.T. Flores, pedodont sa Stomatološkog fakulteta u Valparaisu u Čileu.

Već sama činjenica da su 64 stranice podijeljene na 19 poglavlja koja daju odgovore na mnoga pitanja iz dentalne traumatologije govori o jednostavnosti priručnika, a time i njegovoj prihvatljivosti za svakoga tko se u svom kliničkom radu ili u nastavi susreće s traumom zuba.

Priručnik se bavi epidemiologijom traumatskih ozljeda zuba, vrstama i posljedicama traume, podjelama zubnih ozljeda, načinom pregleda ozljeđenika i dijagnostikom, a pobliže opisuje prijelom zubne krune bez otvaranja pulpe i s njom, prijelom korijena, prijelom alveolarnoga nastavka, konkusiju, subluksaciju, ekstruzivnu, lateralnu i intruzivnu luksaciju te avulziju zuba. Opisane su zatim ozljede primarne denticije, prevencija traumatskih ozljeda zuba te se daju obavi-
