

IZVJEŠTAJ - INTERNATIONAL TOURISM AND HOSPITALITY ACADEMY AT SEA

Profesorica Adele Ladkin pozvana je sudjelovati na 8. International Tourism and Hospitality Academy at Sea (ITHAS), putovanju u trajanju od tjedan dana koje uključuje predavanja i stručna razgledavanja vezana za ovogodišnju temu - Specifični oblici turizma.

ITHAS je pokrenut 2005. godine, a 2013. godine održao se po osmi put, ponovno u organizaciji Ekonomskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. Ukupno je sudjelovalo 108 studenata i profesora sa 4 sveučilišta: Ekonomski fakultet Sveučilišta u Zagrebu; Munich University of Applied Sciences, Department of Tourism, Njemačka; Jyväskylä University of Applied Sciences, School of Tourism and Services Management, Finska te Ekonomski fakultet Sveučilišta u Ljubljani. Program je osmislila profesorica Nevenka Čavlek sa Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, idejna začetnica ovog projekta, a brodove je i ove godine osigurao i putovanje dijelom i sponzorirao turoperator specijalist za Hrvatsku, I.D. Riva Tours iz Münchena.

Svrha ITHAS-a je raznolika. ITHAS pruža studentima jedinstveno iskustvo stručnih posjeta kako bi iz prve ruke doživjeli organizacijske aspekte turizma, studenti imaju koristi od predavanja vrhunskih međunarodnih stručnjaka u području turizma, a

Professor Adele Ladkin was invited to participate in the 8th International Tourism and Hospitality Academy at Sea (ITHAS), a week long sea voyage incorporating academic lectures and site visits based on the theme of Special Interest Tourism.

Founded in 2005 and held in 2013 for the eighth time, ITHAS 2013 was hosted by the Faculty of Economics & Business of the University of Zagreb. There were 108 students and professors participating in the study voyage from four participating universities: the University of Zagreb, Faculty of Economics and Business, Croatia; Munich University of Applied Sciences, Department of Tourism, Germany; Jyväskylä University of Applied Sciences, School of Tourism and Services Management, Finland; and University of Ljubljana, Faculty of Economics, Slovenia. The programme was expertly put together by the founder of ITHAS, Professor Nevenka Čavlek from the University of Zagreb, with the boats and partial sponsorship provided by a Munich based tour operator I.D. Riva

Tours, specialized in Croatia.

The purpose of ITHAS is diverse. It gives students the unique opportunity to undertake site study visits to experience first hand the operational aspects of tourism, students benefit from academic lectures from international

spajanje sudionika s različitih sveučilišta na brodovima omogućuje međusobno upoznavanje različitih kultura i rad unutar raznolikih kulturnih grupa.

Na četiri broda plovilo je 27 profesora i asistenata te 81 student te su svakog dana sudjelovali na predavanjima tijekom plovidbe, a kada bi brodovi pristali, odlazili su na razgledavanje destinacije autobusima ili pješice. Te su destinacije ovoga puta bile: Makarska, Ploče, otok Brač, Vodice i Zadar u Hrvatskoj, te svetište Međugorje i grad Mostar u Bosni i Hercegovini. Studenti sa svakog sveučilišta su također prezentirali svoje matične institucije i dali su prikaz razvoja turizma u svojim zemljama.

Putovanje je završilo 11. svibnja u Zadru, na vrijeme da se ITHAS pridruži međunarodnoj znanstvenoj konferenciji „Myths of Tourism“ koju su organizirali Odjel za turizam i komunikacijske znanosti Sveučilišta u Zadru i Katedra za turizam Ekonomskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu.

Profesorica Ladkin je izjavila: „Ovo je bila izvrsna prilika za studente. Imali smo organiziran raspored s mnogo različitih aktivnosti i poučnim iskustvima. Svi smo se složili da je to bilo iznimno vrijedno putovanje. I vrijeme nam je bilo dobro, a more mirno!“

Tijekom putovanja profesorica Adele Ladkin i profesorica Nevenka Čavlek provele su pilot studiju za njihovo predstojeće istraživanje o iskustvima poduzetnika u nautičkom turizmu koje će se provesti u suradnji s I.D. Riva Toursom.

tourism experts, and the bringing together of the different university participants on the boats allows for cultural exchange and practice in working with diverse cultural groups.

The 81 students and 27 professors and assistants sailed on four boats, with each day typically involving lectures during the sailing times and site excursions on foot and by bus when each destination was reached. Destinations included Makarska, Ploče, The Island of Brač, Vodice and Zadar in Croatia, and Medugorje Pilgrimage Site and Mostar in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The students from each university also gave presentations of their home universities and a review of tourism in their respective countries.

The voyage ended in Zadar on May 11th, in time to join with the International conference ‘Myths of Tourism’ organised jointly by the University of Zadar and the University of Zagreb.

Professor Ladkin said “This was a fantastic opportunity for the students. We had a packed schedule with many different activities and learning experiences. We all agreed it was an extremely worthwhile trip. The weather was also kind to us, with calm Seas!”

During the voyage, Professors Ladkin and Čavlek undertook a pilot study for their forthcoming research on experiences of naval entrepreneurs in tourism being undertaken in collaboration with I.D.Riva Tours.
