

## Prvi akademik iz područja stomatologije - Vjekoslav Jerolimov

Hrvatska akademija znanosti i umjetnosti (HAZU) na izornoj skupštini održanoj 15. svibnja 2014. izabrala je 36 novih članova u svojih 9 razreda, od kojih 11 akademika. Među izabranima, u 153 godine djelovanja HAZU, jest i prvi akademik iz područja stomatologije - akademik Vjekoslav Jerolimov u Razred medicinskih znanosti.

Akademik Vjekoslav Jerolimov rođen je 1945. godine. Diplomirao je na Stomatološkom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, gdje je proveo cijeli radni vijek. Na znanstvenom usavršavanju u inozemstvu boravio je, među ostalim, godinu i pol na Velškom sveučilištu (*University of Wales*) u Cardiffu. Redoviti profesor postaje 1993., a umirovljen je 2010. Osnivač je jedne katedre i dvaju kliničkih zavoda. Uvodi nove kolegije u studij te je urednik i autor niza udžbenika. Međunarodni utjecaj i zapaženi doprinos ostvaruje u tehnologiji materijala zubnih proteza te u području temporomandibularnih poremećaja. Mentor je 89 diplomskih, magistarskih i doktorskih radova. Bio je pozvani predavač na mnogim skupovima te gost-profesor na Velškom sveučilištu (*University of Wales*) u Cardiffu i na Sveučilištu zdravstvenih znanosti Savezne Države Oregon (*Oregon Health Sciences University*) u Portlandu. Autor je 378 radova, od kojih je 126 objavljeno u međunarodno indeksiranim časopisima. Njegov 91 rad ima CC/SCI/SCOPUS vrijednosti, a citirani su u najuglednijim međunarodnim citatnim bazama više od 500 puta. Autor je pet knjiga te 19 poglavlja u 14 knjiga. Sudjelovao je u 16 projekata, od čega je sedam bilo međunarodnih. Član je uredničkih odbora triju domaćih i četiriju međunarodnih časopisa, a suosnivač je i bivši urednik *Hrvatskoga stomatološkog vjesnika*. U Europi sudjeluje u donošenju zajedničkih osnova programa diplomskih studija stomatologije, te programa specijalizacije iz stomatološke protetike. Organizator je 60 znanstveno-stručnih skupova. Bio je prodekan i dekan Stomatološkog fakulteta u Zagrebu, zatim prorektor i kandidat za rektora Sveučilišta u Zagrebu. Redoviti je član Akademije medicinskih znanosti Hrvatske, Međunarodne akademije stomatoloških znanosti (*Academy of Dentistry International*) te niza domaćih i međunarodnih znanstveno-stručnih društava. Predsjednik je Hrvatskoga stomatološkog društva i član Uprave Hrvatskoga liječničkog zbora. Bio je predsjednik Europskoga društva za dentalnu protetiku (*European Prosthodontic Association*). Član suradnik Hrvatske akademije znanosti i umjetnosti postao je 2006. U toj instituciji sudjeluje u donošenju deklaracije *Hrvatska temeljena na znanju i primjeni znanja* (2004.). Također sudjeluje u organizaciji skupova *Dani Andrije Štampara* (2004.) i *Međunarodni simpozij o Josipu Jurju Strossmayeru* te je suautor monografije o tom našem velikanu (2006.). U Akademiji je organizirao osam znanstvenih skupova iz područja stomatologije. Urednik je prvog broja Akademijina časopisa *Rad - medicinske znanosti*, te dvaju zbornika radova sa znanstvenih skupova. Zamjenik je glavnog urednika *Rada - medicinske znanosti* i tajnik Odbora za orofacijalne bolesti. Od mnogih njegovih nagrada ističemo ordene Danice hrvatske s likom Ruđera Boškovića te s likom Katarine Zrinske, *Award of Excellence in Scholarship in Dental Materials* od Academy of Dental Materials (SAD), priznanje *Honorary Life Member* od European Prosthodontic Association, Nagradu Grada Zagreba za znanost i Nagradu Grada Zadra za životno djelo te priznanje *Honorary Life Member* od European Dental Students' Association.



## First Academician from the Dental Science - Vjekoslav Jerolimov

For the first time in its 153 years it chose one academician from the dental science – Vjekoslav Jerolimov in the Department of Medicine.

On its electoral assembly on May 15 2014 the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts (CASA) elected 36 new members. For the first time in its 153 years it chose one academician from the dental science – Vjekoslav Jerolimov in the Department of Medicine.

Academician Vjekoslav Jerolimov was born in 1945. He graduated at the School of Dental Medicine University of Zagreb, where he worked his whole professional career. He spent 1,5 years at the University of Cardiff in Wales. He was elected full professor in 1993, and retired in 2010. He founded one Chair and 2 clinical departments. He introduced new subjects in the curriculum and authored numerous textbooks. His international influence and marked contribution was in the technology of dental prosthesis materials and in temporomandibular disorders. He mentored

89 graduate, master and PhD theses. He was invited to speak on numerous congresses and guest-professor at the University of Wales in Cardiff and Oregon Health Sciences University in Portland. He authored 378 publications with 126 articles in internationally indexed journals. Ninety-one of his publications have CC/SCI/SCOPUS value, and he was cited more than 500 times. There are 5 books with his authorship, as well as 19 further chapters in 14 books. He participated in 16 projects (7 international). Professor Jerolimov is a member of 3 Croatian and 4 international editorial boards; he is a co-founder and former editor-in-chief of Croatian Dental Journal. He is active in delivering common basics of dental studies and postgraduate program in prosthetics. He organized 60 scientific and professional meetings. He was Dean and Vicedean of the School of Dental Medicine University of Zagreb, Prorektor and a candidate for rectorship of the University of Zagreb. He is a full member of the Academy of Medical Sciences of Croatia, Academy of Dentistry International and numerous Croatian and international professional and scientific societies. He is the President of the Croatian Dental Society of the Croatian Medical Association, and a member of the board of the Croatian Medical Association. He is past president of the European Prosthodontic Association. He was elected Associated Member of the CASA in 2006. He participated in the creation of the declaration Croatia based on knowledge and use of knowledge (2004). He participated in the organization of the Andrija Štampar Days in 2004 and International symposium on Josip Juraj Strossmayer in 2006. He also co-authored a monography with the same name. He organized 8 scientific events in the CASA and edited one issue of *Rad – medical sciences* and two Books of abstracts of the scientific meetings. He is deputy editor of the *Rad – medical sciences* and secretary of the Board for Orofacial diseases. His numerous awards include the Danica hrvatska with Ruđer Bošković and with Katarina Zrinska, Award of Excellence in Scholarship in Dental Materials awarded by the Academy of Dental Materials as well as Honorary Life Membership of the European Prosthodontic Association, City of Zagreb Award for Science, City of Zagreb Award for Lifetime Achievement and Honorary Life Membership by the European Dental Students' Association.
