Sci.; 1999–2003 President – Croatian Physiological Society; 2000 Full member – Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts; 2000 – 2009 Rector, Univ. of Rijeka; 2001–2002 and 2007–2008 President-Rectors Assembly of Croatian Universities; 2002–2003 Member, Council Europ. During his Rectors mandate a new University Campus was built and scientific potential of University increased for 50 percent. 2013 Chairman – Dept. Mentor and supervisor at 60 Master and PhD theses. From this group of his students are 35 University Professors, 18 Chairmen of Departments and Clinics, Vice-Deans, Deans and Rectors, some of them most cited croatian scientists in the field of biomedical sciences.
