Prema podacima od 29. srpnja 1992. godine, u ratnim razarinjima oštećeno je 46 muzeja, galerija i zbirki kako navodimo u izvještaju:

Veći dio muzejske zbirke je evakuiran i smješten na sigurnu lokaciju kao i fundus galerije.

Spomen-vlak je i nadalje na otvorenome.

Šteta:

U artiljerijskim višekratnim napadima JNA tijekom listopada do prosinca 1991. godine, u cijelosti je uništen Kombinat »Belišće«, u sklopu kojeg je bio i Muzej.

6. 10. 1991.

Prema pismenoj informaciji direktorice Muzeja Belišća Zdenke Frajtag od 2. 4. 1992., najveća su oštećenja nastala na zgradi Muzeja 6. 10. 91. napadom JNA iz Baranje. Na više mjesta oštećen je krov zgrade, ulazni dio, izbijena su ulazna vrata, slomljena sva prozorska stakla te je fasada zgrade sa prednje i bočne strane oštećena šrapnelima. Velika oštećenja zadobila je prva prostorija i kancelarija, oštećen je djelomično namještaj, zid i lamperija. Prostorije postava manje su oštećene od šrapnela. Spomen-vlak je oštećen padom granate u neposrednoj blizini, ulazna signalizacija raznesena je granatom.

Siječanj 1992.

U dva navrata Muzej Belišća oštećen je šrapnelima granata koje su pale u dvorište zgrade.

I spomen-vlak je pretrpio daljnja oštećenja od šrapnela.

18. 3. 1992.

U artiljerijskom napadu na Belišće s dva pogotka iz minobacača pogoden je krov zgrade muzeja i bočna strana zgrade. Oštećeni su krovna konstrukcija i crijepe te telefonski vod.

7. 10. 1991.

Prilikom uzastopnih napada tijekom listopada, teško je oštećena i spaljena 7. 10. 1991. povijesna jezgra Čilipa i zgrada Zavičajnog muzeja.

Listopad 1991.

Čilipi i područje Konavala okupirale su jedinice JNA u listopadu 1991. Daljnja sudbina čitavog mjesta sa stanovnicima, te muzejske zbirke je neizvjesna i o tome nema daljih informacija.

Stanovništvo je evakuirano i prebjeglo u Cavtat, Dubrovnik i dalje.

Spaljeni su svi objekti centra naselja Čilipi, devastirana zgrada muzeja, devastirana unutrašnjost crkve, spaljeni pojedinačni zaseoci.

Travanj 1992.

Prema informaciji Marine Desin, kustosa, od 2. 4. 1992., fond Muzeja i crkveni inventar, koje je okupatorska vojska pronašla u muzejskom skloništu, prema naredbi komandira JNA toga područja, nakon početnog devastiranja dijela građe od strane vojske, smješteni su u prostorije Mjesne zajednice, zaključani i pod stražom.

Knežev dvor, u kojem je smješten Dubrovački muzej, zaštićen je skelama i vrećama pijeska, a trijem sa stupovima u prizemlju obložen je daskama. Muzejski predmeti iz stalnog postava te ostali fundus, spremljeni su u metalne i drvene sanduke, i sklonjeni na sigurnije mjesto u Dubrovniku. Inventarne su knjige fotokopirane.

Šteta:

12. 11. 1991.

Prema podacima u medijima, u kontinuiranim napadima na Dubrovnik, zgrada Kneževa dvora u kojoj su smješteni kulturno-historijski odio i pinakoteka Dubrovačkog muzeja, oštećena je. Opseg i karakter oštećenja, za sada, nisu poznati.

6. 12. 1991.

Tog je dana više od 150 projektila ispaljeno s ratnih brodova JRM na povijesnu jezgru Dubrovnika. Rezultat dvanaestosatnog napada na grad jest da je 30 posto objekata teško oštećeno, a 10 posto je savršeno ili potpuno izgorjelo u požarima koji su potom nastali. Tijekom tog napada pročelje Kneževa dvora oštećeno je fragmentima projektila koji su pali u neposrednu blizinu.

Prema izvještajima HTV-a, tvrđava sv. Ivana, u kojoj je smješten muzej, oštećena je projektilima s topovnjača JRM. Opseg i karakter štete, za sada, nisu poznati.

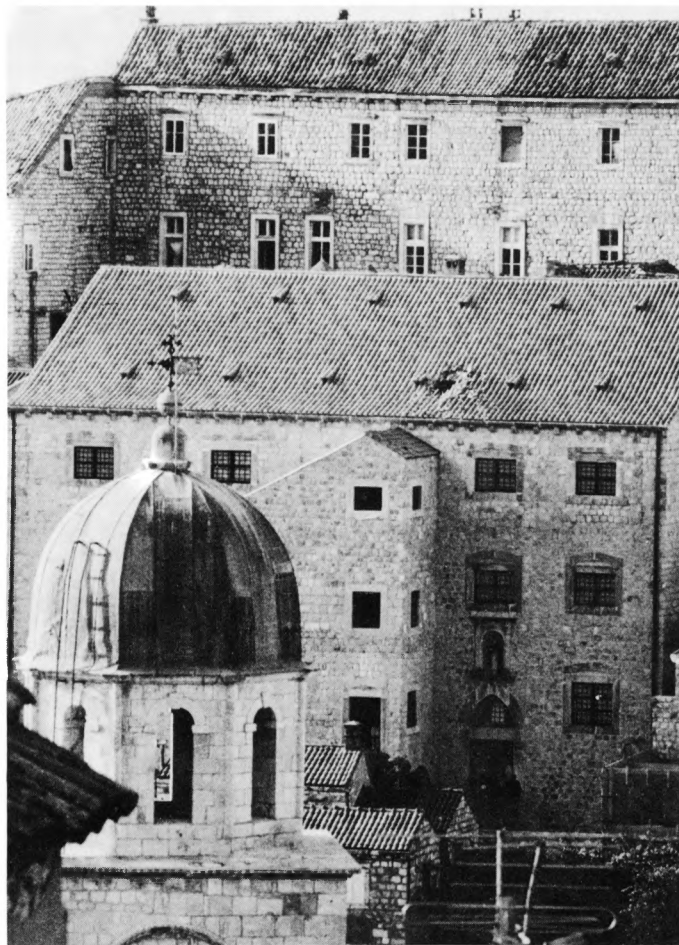
Šteta:

23. 10. 1991.

Priklom napada na grad s brodova Jugoslavenske ratne mornarice, među ostalim objektima-spomenicima kulture, direktnim je pogotkom teže oštećeno krovšte zgrade stare dubrovačke žitnice, u kojoj je smješten netom renovirani (u proljeće 1991.) stalni muzejski postav etnografske zbirke Dubrovačkog muzeja.

6. 12. 1991.

Prema usmenom izvješću Mirjane Zec, kustosa-voditeljice Muzeja »Rupe« (26. 2. 1992.), u napadu JNA na grad projektil jače razorne moći

udario je u rub krova zgrade uz istočnu fasadu Muzeja »Rupe« te uzrokovao veća oštećenja na muzeju. Stradali su kameni okviri prozora najbližih udaru, uništeni su drveni dijelovi tih prozora, a stakla su slomljena na većini muzejskih prozora. Od izravnog udara dijelova projektila stradale su tri vitrine i ormari za tekstil.

Depo muzeja u zgradi bivše tiskare pogođen je projektilom od 120 mm sa zapaljivim punjenjem, koji srećom nije eksplodirao. Taj prostor pretrpio je više pogodaka dijelova projektila koji su oštetili krovšte i prozore.

Depo muzeja u istočnom dijelu prizemlja palače Sponza oštećen je od dijelova projektila koji su padali po susjednoj ulici, te su stradala stakla vitrina koja su tu bila pohranjena.

25. 10. 1991.

Tijekom uzastopnih artiljerijskih napada na grad oštećen je krov samostana, a vitraji u crkvi polomljeni su pogocima šplitera.

6. 12. 1991.

Tijekom napada na grad crkva je dobila četiri direktna pogotka – tri u glavni brod, jedan u oltar. Osam projektila palo je na Dominikansku ulicu i oštetilo kamene fasade okolnih zgrada. Deset projektila pogodilo je i oštetilo krov Dominikanskog samostana.

28. – 31. 5. 1992.

U ponovljenim napadima na Dubrovnik izravnim pogotkom projektila u dio ispod zvonika, ponovo je oštećen samostan. Prema telefonskom izvješću gospodina Marijana Pavlovića, priora, od detonacija je uništena polovica kupole crkve.

Najvredniji eksponati iz muzeja pravovremeno su skinuti i pohranjeni na sigurnije mjesto u za to predviđenim kutijama.

Šteta:

24. 10. 1991.

Muzejska zbirka smještena je u Franjevačkom samostanu. Krhotinama projektila oštećena je kapa zvonika samostanske crkve (probijen je olovni pokrivač kape zvonika). Opseg i karakter drugih oštećenja za sada nije poznat.

6. 12. 1991.

Prema pismenom izvješću dr. Jozę Soptę, gvardijana Franjevačkog samostana, od 27. 2. 1992., u napadu JNA na staru gradsku jezgru dva direktna udarca u pročelje zapadnoga krila klaustera te indirektni udarci – geleri teško su oštetili kamenu plastiku, stupove, kapitele, terasu, balustradu i vrt klaustera. Oštećena je crkva, a direktan pogodak projektila teško je oštetio kupolu zvonika crkve s istočne strane. Direktnim udarcem u krov i probojem u objekt – zapadno krilo samostana, oštećena je biblioteka. Trima direktnim pogocima u krovu objekta – istočnoga krila klaustera i probojem projektila u prizemni prostor u kojem je smješten muzej, oštećen je namještaj, stakla, vrata i tri slike iz muzejske zbirke: 1. Panorama Dubrovnika prije potresa, nepoznati autor, oko 1870., 2. Uznesenje Marijino, Španjolska, 17. st., 3. Sv. obitelj, Španjolska, 17. st.

Oštećeni su i ostali dijelovi samostanskoga kompleksa, a štete su nastale i od fragmenata drugih projektila koji su padali svuda uokolo.

29. 5. 1992.

Prema podacima iz Zavoda za zaštitu spomenika kulture Republike Hrvatske, s tri izravna pogotka projektila u krov i dva u vrt, crkva i samostan Male braće ponovo su oštećeni.

8. 6. 1992.

Prema telefonskom izvješću (od 18. 6. 1992.) gospodina Josipa Soptę, gvardijana, u napadu na grad pogođeni su krov i apsida crkve koja je vrlo teško oštećena. Rupa na krovu veličine je 20 četvornih metara. Teška su oštećenja na sakristiji, stradao je stari namještaj. Polomljeni su vitraji na prozorima, oštećeni kameni vijenci i plastika, krhotinama projektila oštećena je i slika Palmerinija.

Listopad, studeni, prosinac 1991.

Prema telefonskom razgovoru sa Lucijom Aleksić, kustosom Umjetničke galerije (12. 2. 1992.) i njezinom pismenom izvješću (25. 2. 1992.) u uzastopnim napadima JNA na grad Umjetnička je galerija oštećena u više navrata. Oštećena su dvojna vrata izložbene prostorije drugoga kata. Jedna vrata probio je snajperski metak i oštetio parket u izložbenoj dvorani, druga je vrata probio geler i udario u zid dvorane. Od detonacija je popucalo 17 prozorskih stakala na južnoj fasadi, a dva su oštećena na istočnoj fasadi zgrade. Od pogotka gelera oštećen je krov galerije, pomaknuti su i razbijeni crepovi.

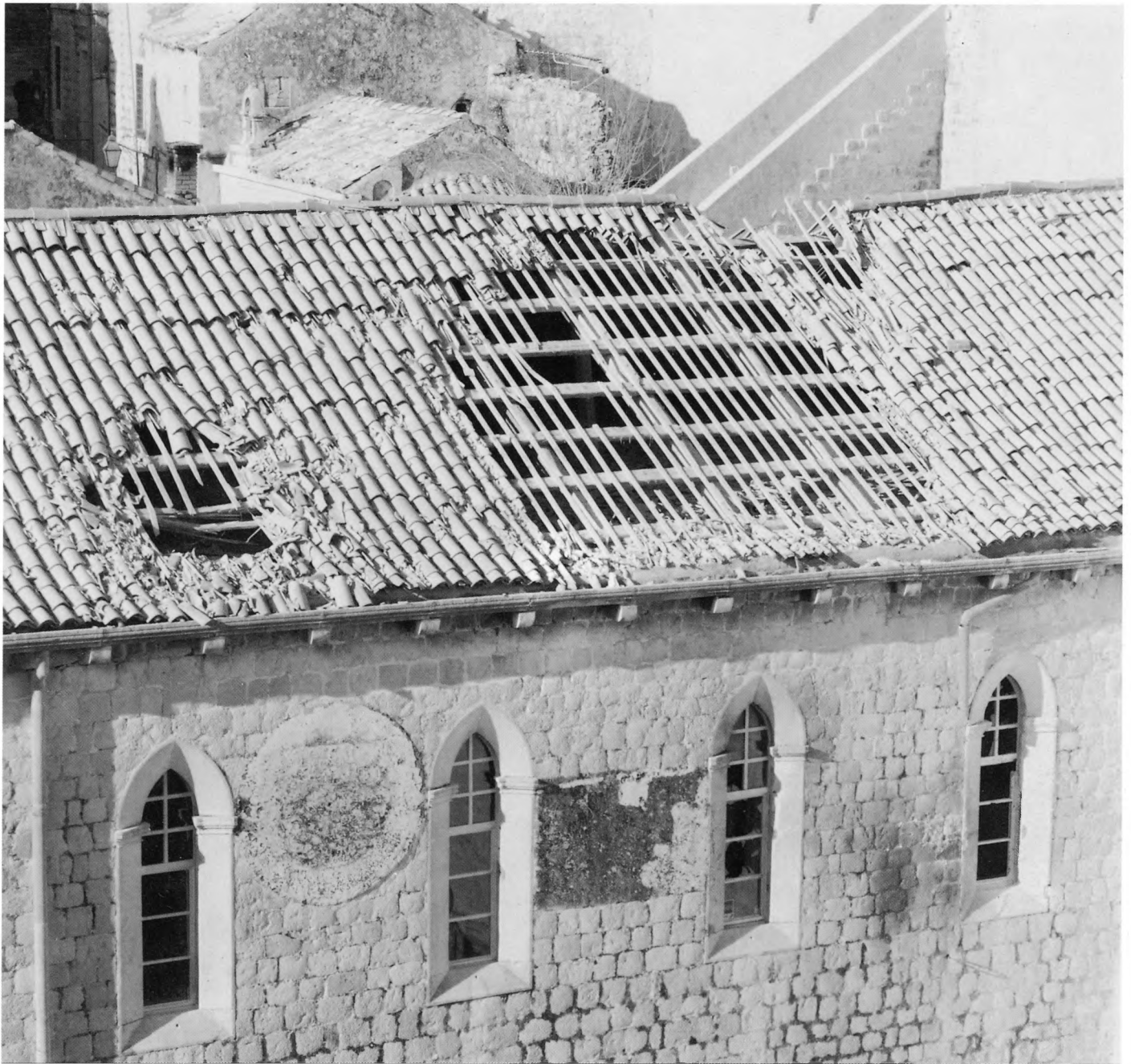

Šteta:

Rujan 1991.

Tijekom ratnih operacija u rujnu 1991. na području oko Novske, zbog snažnih detonacija izazvanih djelovanjem teške artiljerije i ratnog zrakoplovstva, na objektu Memorijalnog muzeja, u sklopu Spomen-područja Jasenovac popucala su sva stakla (površine 200 četvornih metara). Prema našim saznanjima i izvješću direktora Spomen-područja, drugih oštećenja na objektima i lokalitetu Spomen-područja Jasenovac do 1. 10. 1991. nije bilo. Odnosno, nakon intenziviranja ratnih operacija krajem rujna, stanovništvo s područja Jasenovca iseljeno je nakon 1. 10. 1991., kada su to područje okupirale jedinice JNA. Prema informacijama koje ne možemo provjeriti, jer je to područje sada okupirano, sve kuće u mjestu Jasenovac su teže oštećene ili potpuno uništene.

U suradnji sa Zavodom za restauriranje umjetnina iz Zagreba, 27. 11. 1991. godine dio likovnog fundusa muzeja je dislociran, kao i dio zbirke I. Kršnjavoga, dok se preostali dio građe za evakuaciju premješta u adekvatne drvene sanduke.

Šteta:

20. i 21. 9. 1991.

Za vrijeme borbi oko vojarnje Našice od 20. do 21. rujna 1991. godine, oštećen je Dvorac Pejačević u kojem je smješten muzej. Dvorac je oštećen na nekoliko mjesta. Sa zapadne strane, ispod same kupole tornja dvorac je pogođen navodećom raketom, koja je prošla kroza zid i zabila se u suprotnu stranu. 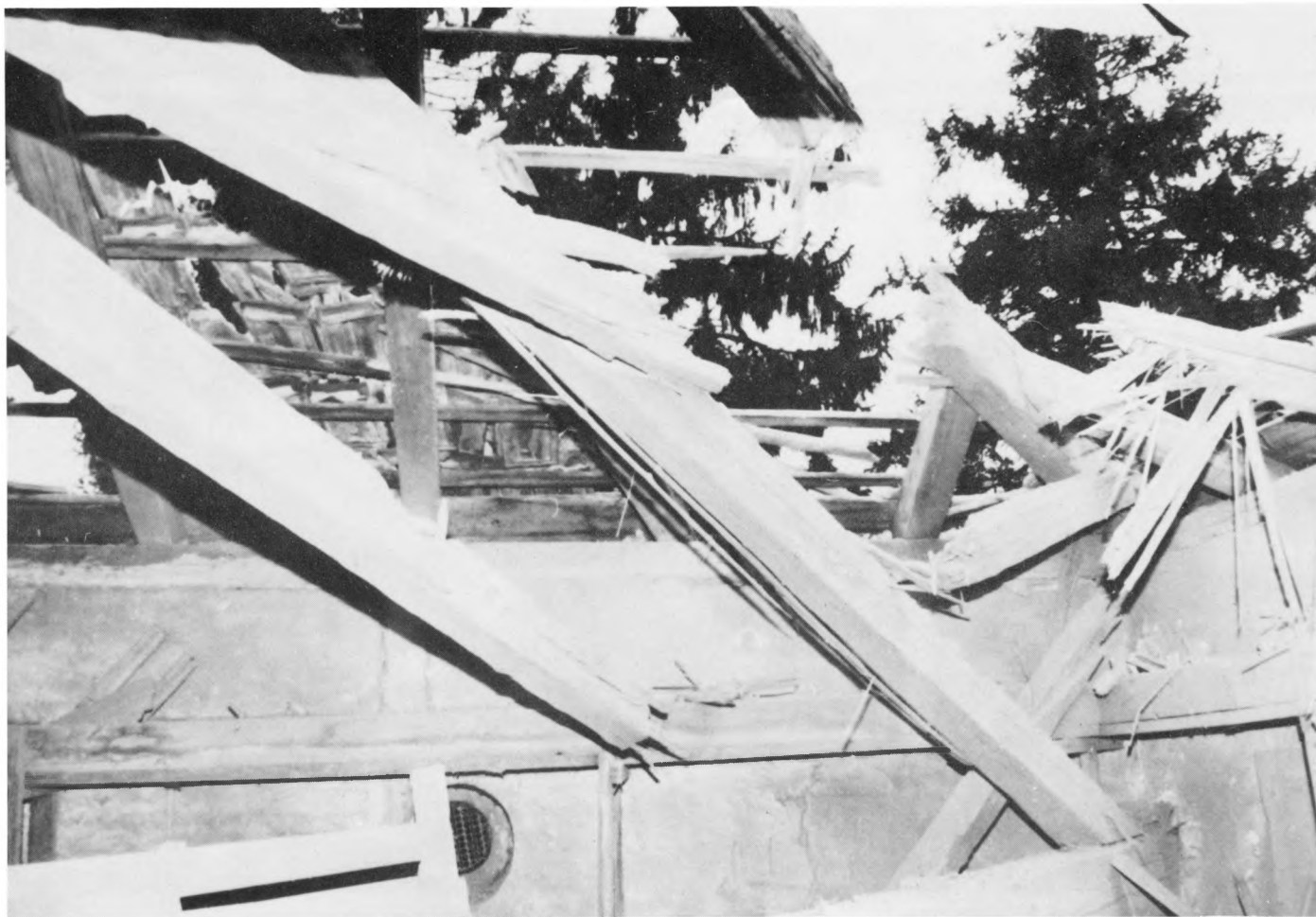

October 6, 1991

According to the written report of April 2, 1992, by Ms. Zdenka Frajtag, the director of the museum, the most extensive damage to the museum was done by the artillery attack launched by the Yugoslav Army from Baranja on October 6, 1991. The roof of the building was struck in several places, all window panes shattered, the main entrance was ruined and its doors torn out. The facade was damaged by splinters. The first room of the gallery space and the office of the museum were badly damaged, too. The rest of the gallery space suffered lesser damages caused by splinters. The windows of the gallery in the basement were all shattered. The historical train was damaged by a mortar shell which exploded in the immediate vicinity, and the entry signal to the railway station was blown to pieces.

January, 1992

More damage was caused by the splinters of the two mortar shells which exploded in the courtyard of the museum.

The historical train suffered further damage, too.

March 18, 1992

In the heavy artillery raid on Belišće on that day, the roof and the wing of the building were hit by two mortar shells. They caused damage to the roof construction and the remaining roof tiles and cut the telephone cable.

According to the information we received from Ms. Marina Desin, curator, on April 2, 1992, the soldiers of the Yugoslav Army have discovered the location of the museum's shelter, where the collection and the inventory of the church had been hidden together prior to the occupation. After the initial vandalizing of a part of them by soldiers, the local military commander ordered their removal to the town office, where they remained locked and under guard.

Mr Jozo Spota, the guardian of the Franciscan Monastery, reported in his letter of 27 February 1992, that in the heavy artillery attack on the historical nucleus of Dubrovnik, launched by the Yugoslav Army on that day, the facade of the western wing of the convent received two direct hits, which, together with the splinters and blasts of the nearby explosions, caused severe damage to the architectural sculpture, colonnade, pavement and the garden of the cloister. The dome of the bell tower of the church received a direct hit on its eastern side, which damaged the nave, too. The library in the west wing of the convent was damaged by a missile which pierced through the roof of the building. The east wing of the convent received three direct hits, which pierced through the building into the gallery space on the ground floor and smashed furniture, glass, and damaged three paintings belonging to the collection: 1. The Panorama of Dubrovnik Before the Earthquake, by unknown author, dated about 1870; 2. The Assumption of the Virgin Mary, Spain, 17th century; 3. The Holy Family, Spain, 17th century. Beside the direct shelling, the whole complex of the Monastery suffered a lot of damage caused by the splinters, rubble and blasts of many nearby explosions.

29 May 1992

According to the data we received from the Institute for the Protection of Cultural Monuments of the Republic of Croatia, the church and the convent of the Minorite friars were damaged again by three direct hits on the roof, and two in the garden.

8 June 1992

Mr. Josip Sopta, the Guardian of the monastery, reported by phone on 18 June 1992 that the church was severely damaged by hits on the roof and the apse. The hole in the roof measures 20 m². There are severe damages to the sacristy and its antique furniture is ruined. The stained-glass windows are all broken, the stone masonry is heavily damaged. The painting by Palermini was damaged by splinters.

The depot of the museum, located in the building of the former printing-house, was hit by a 120 mm flammable missile, which fortunately did not ignite. The roof and the windows of this building were considerably damaged by the splinters of the missiles falling nearby.

The depot of the museum located on the ground floor of the east wing of the palace Sponza was also damaged by the explosions in the neighbouring street. The glass panels of the museums display cases, stored there, were all broken.

12 December, 1991

Ms. Mirjana Zec, curator, reported on February 26, 1992, of severe damage to the building caused by a missile which hit the edge of the roof on the east side. The stonework around the windows and window-frames nearest to the place of impact have been ruined. Most of the window-panes on the entire building have been shattered. Splinters ruined three glass display cases and several closets for storing textiles. A 120 mm projectile with the fire igniting filling struck the depot of the museum, housed in the former printing-house, but fortunately failed to explode. The roof and the windows of this building suffered considerable damage caused by the splinters and blasts of the nearby explosions.

The depot of the museum housed on the ground floor of the east wing of the Sponza palace has been damaged by splinters from the explosions in the neighbouring street, and the glass panes of the display cases, stored there, have shattered.

The permanent display has not been dismantled, except for the most valuable objects which had been evacuated from the museum earlier. After the explosion in the museum, the commission made of the representatives of the Institute for Protection of Cultural Monuments of the Republic of Croatia, the Municipal Institute for protection of Cultural Monuments, The National and University Library and the Serbian

Orthodox Church inspected the damage to the museum holdings and the library and had them packed and evacuated to a safe location appointed by the representatives of the Serbian Orthodox Church.

Damage:

11 April 1992

According to the data held by the Institute for the Protection of Cultural Monuments of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport of the Republic of Croatia, the building housing the offices of the Mitropoly of the Serbian Orthodox Church and the church museum has been

damaged by the heavy explosion caused by a set explosive device, which occurred in 10.45 p.m. on 11 April 1992.

The damage has been done mostly to the entrance area of the building: the staircase and one wall collapsed and all window-panes on the building have shattered.

In the interior of the museum the icons fell off the walls and the glass display cases have been broken. After the investigation the commission had 11 objects sent to be restored in the Institute for Restoration of Works of Art in Zagreb. (Remark: the summary does not state the cause of damage to these objects.)

The incident has been still under investigation.
