



Notification of acceptance will be given by **January 15, 2015**. One-page abstracts will be published as proceedings. Full-length papers will be published on CD-ROM, which together with proceedings will be available to all registered participants at the time of the conference. Full papers should be submitted no later than **April 15, 2015**. The registration fee for all regular participants is EUR 380, for PhD students EUR 280 while for the accompanying person is EUR 150. For late paying after April 16, 2015 registration fee for the regular participant is EUR 430 and for the PhD student is EUR 320. For accompanying person late

registration fee is EUR 200.
