

## Dr. Stjepan Rogan

(Zagreb, October 17, 1960 – Bračak, January 19, 2016)

Tužna vijest o smrti doktora Stjepana Rogana potresla je sve njegove kolege, obitelj, ali i pacijente koji su ga neizmjerno voljeli i cijenili. Svojih kratkih pedeset pet životnih ljeta proživio je u roditeljskom domu u Poznanovcu, uz svoje najmilije. Svakodnevno je na posao dolazio u Opću bolnicu Zabok i bolnicu hrvatskih veterana, koju nije napuštao ni u trenutcima duge i teške bolesti. Kao iznimno stručan, a na prvome mjestu vrijedan i marljiv internist, uvek na usluzi svima kojima je pomoć potrebna, ostavio je neizbrisiv trag koji će pamtitи sve djelatnice i djelatnici, kao i sve pacijentice i pacijenti Odjela interne medicine Opće bolnice Zabok i bolnice hrvatskih veterana.

Dr. Stjepan Rogan osnovnu je školu pohađao u Poznanovcu i Bedekovčini. Opću gimnaziju završio je 1977. godine u Zaboku, srednju medicinsku 1979. u Zaboku, a na Medicinskom fakultetu Sveučilišta u Zagrebu diplomirao je 1984. godine. Dr. Rogan u profesionalnom je radu bio dugogodišnji voditelj odjela za intenzivnu medicinu, odjela interne medicine te pomoćnik ravnatelja za medicinska pitanja Opće bolnice Zabok. U svom je djelovanju bio uvek na strani potrebitih, skrbio se nesebično za bližnje, za prijatelje, za ljude u nevolji, za sve nas uvek je imao vremena, uvek su mu svi drugi bili na prvome mjestu. Stjepan Rogan bio je aktivan i u Hrvatskoj udruzi „Muži zagorskog srca“, Lovačkom društvu Bedekovčina, Ribičkom društvu „Bedekovčina“, NK „Tondach“ Bedekovčina, a aktivan je kao liječnik i na braniku domovine u Domovinskom ratu.

Napustio nas je naš voljeni Štefek, Štefek koji je ostavio neizbrisiv trag svojim djelima, mislima i srcem. U trenu je njegovim iznenadnim gubit-



The sad news of the death of Dr. Stjepan Rogan comes as a heavy blow to all his colleagues, family, and patients that loved and respected him. He spent his short fifty five years in his family home in Poznanovac, in company of his loved ones. He went to work every day to the Zabok General Hospital and Croatian Veteran's Hospital, which he did not leave even during his long and difficult illness. A consummate professional, and above all a diligent

specialist in internal medicine, he was always available to all who needed his help and has left an indelible mark on all the hospital staff and all the patients of the Internal Medicine Department at the Zabok General Hospital and Croatian Veterans Hospital.

Dr. Stjepan Rogan attended primary schools in the towns of Poznanovac and Bedekovčina. He graduated from secondary school in 1977 in Zabok, the health care medical school in Zabok in 1979, and graduated from the University of Zagreb School of Medicine in 1984. Professionally, Dr. Rogan held for many years the positions of department head at the Department of Intensive Medicine and Department of Internal Medicine, and was the Assistant Director for medical issues at the Zabok General Hospital. In all his work he was ever supportive of those in need, caring selflessly for the people around him, be they friends or people in trouble, and always had time for us all – other people were always most important to him. Stjepan Rogan was active in the Croatian association "Muži zagorskog srca", the Bedekovčina Hunting Society, the "Bedekovčina" Fishing Society, and FC
