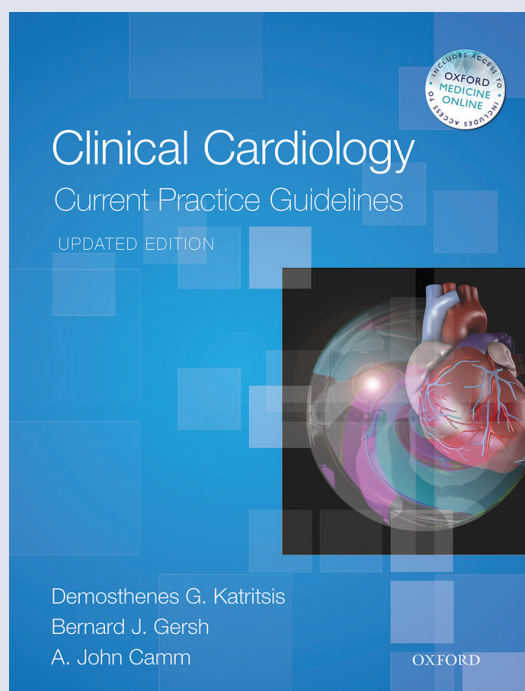
Prikaz knjige *Clinical Cardiology: Current Practice Guidelines*
