

Dobitnik srebrne povelje "Ljubomir Čečuk"
Prof. dr. sc. Vladimir Gabrić,
specijalist urologije i kirurgije,

Rođen je 1. studenoga 1923. godine u Požegi.

Diplomirao je na Medicinskom fakultetu u Zagrebu 1952. godine, specijalizirao je kirurgiju 1960. godine, a urologiju 1964. Doktorirao je na Medicinskom fakultetu u Zagrebu. Primarijus je od 1973. godine.

Stručno se usavršavao u Beču 1955. i 1985. godine, u Düsseldorfu 1966., Münchenu 1967., Varšavi 1976., Barceloni 1978., Parizu 1979., San Franciscu 1987., Londonu 1987. i Berlinu 1988. godine.

Po završetku studija od 1953. do 1957. godine radi kao liječnik u Traumatološkoj bolnici u Zagrebu, od 1957. do 1970. kao kirurg u Kirurškoj klinici Kliničkoga bolničkoga centra u Zagrebu, a od 1970. do 1990. godine kao urolog u Urološkoj klinici Kliničkoga bolničkoga centra u Zagrebu. Od 1970. do 1985. godine obnašao je dužnost zamjenika predstojnika Urološke klinike, a od 1985. do 1990. godine predstojnika Urološke klinike.

Bio je zamjenik predsjednika od 1970. do 1985. godine i predsjednik od 1985. do 1990. godine Katedre za urologiju Medicinskoga fakulteta u Zagrebu.

Također je obnašao dužnost generalnoga tajnika i potpredsjednika Udruženja urologa Jugoslavije, te 1990. predsjednika kongresa urologa Jugoslavije.

Profesor Gabrić je u mirovini od 1990. godine.

Član je Hrvatskoga liječničkoga zbora, Sekcije za urologiju Hrvatskoga liječničkoga zbora, HAMZ-a te Internacionalnoga udruženja urologa.

Nagrađen je Ordenom rada sa srebrnim vijencem.

Medicinski interesi su mu kirurgija i urologija, posebice transuretralne resekcije prostate.

Born on Novemeber, the 1st, 1923 in Požega.

Graduated from the Faculty of Medicine in Zagreb in the year 1952, specialized in surgery in 1960, and in urology - in 1964. He defended his doctoral dissertation at the Faculty of Medicine in Zagreb. Since the year 1973 he has been awarded the title Head Doctor (Primarius).

Underwent professional training in Vienna in 1955 and 1985, in Düsseldorf in 1966, Munich 1967, Warsaw 1976, Barcelona 1978, Paris 1979, San Francisco 1987, London 1987 and Berlin in 1988.

After graduating from the Faculty of Medicine, from 1953 to 1957, he worked as a medical doctor in the Accident Hospital in Zagreb, from 1957 to 1970 he worked as a surgeon at the Surgery Clinic of the University Hospital Centre in Zagreb, and from 1970 to 1990 as a urologist at the Urology Clinic of the University Hospital Centre in Zagreb. From 1970 to 1985 he filled the post of the Deputy Head of the Urology Clinic, and from 1985 to 1990 he was the Head of the Urology Clinic.

He was the Vice-President from 1970 to 1985 and from 1985 to 1990 the President of the Department of Urology at the Faculty of Medicine in Zagreb.

He has also filled the post of the Secretary General and Vice-President of the Yugoslav Association of Urology and in 1990 he was the President of the Congress of Yugoslav Urologists.

Since 1990 Professor Gabrić is retired.

He is the member of the Croatian Medical Association, of the Section for Urology of the Croatian Medical Association, of the Croatian Academy of Medical Sciences, as well as of the International Association of Urology.

He was the recipient of the Decoration "Medal of Labor with Silver Wreath".

His medical interests are surgery and urology, especially transurethral prostate resections.

Rođen je 1927. godine u Svetom Križu Začretje. Srednju školu pohađao je u Zagrebu. Studirao je na Medicinskom fakultetu u Zagrebu, gdje je specijalizirao opću kirurgiju i urologiju. Doktorirao je iz područja transparenhimne kirurgije bubrega. Redovni je profesor Medicinskoga fakulteta u Zagrebu.

Bio je voditelj Odjela za transplantaciju bubrega i renovaskularnu kirurgiju pri Kliničkom bolničkom centru - Šalata. Boravio je na brojnim institutima, klinikama i bolnicama za transplantaciju bubrega u Milanu, Münchenu, Hamburgu, Essenu, Düsseldorfu, Lyonu, Madridu, Barceloni, Beču, Bostonu, Chicagu. Posebno se bavio organizacijom kadaverične transplantacije bubrega. Prvu kadaveričnu transplantaciju bubrega u Zagrebu obavio je 1974. godine.

Obnašao je funkciju predstojnika Klinike za kirurgiju Kliničke bolnice Osijek od 1. svibnja 1992. do 30. rujna 1999. godine. Sudjelovao je na brojnim sastancima i kongresima u zemlji i inozemstvu. Član je udruženja urologa Njemačke, Internacionalnoga udruženja urologa i Internacionalnoga društva za raspodjelu organa za transplantaciju. Izvanredni je član Medicinske akademije Hrvatske, član sekcije urologa Hrvatske i Sekcije za transplantaciju bubrega i dijalizu. Objavio je mnoštvo, što stručnih, što znanstvenih radova, i to sam te u suradnji s ostalim autorima.

He was born in the year 1927 in Sveti Križ Začretje. He finished High School in Zagreb. He graduated from the Faculty of Medicine in Zagreb, where he also specialized in general surgery and urology. His doctoral dissertation was from the field of transparenchymal renal surgery. He is Full Professor of the Faculty of Medicine in Zagreb.

He was the Head of the Department of Kidney Transplantation and Renovascular Surgery at the University Hospital Centre Šalata. He stayed at many institutes, clinics and hospitals for kidney transplantation in Milan, Munich, Hamburg, Essen, Düsseldorf, Lyon, Madrid, Barcelona, Vienna, Boston and Chicago. He was especially engaged in organization of cadaveric renal transplantation. He performed the first cadaveric renal transplantation in Zagreb in the year 1974.

Professor Vidović filled the position of the Head of Urology Clinic at the University Hospital Osijek from May the 1st, 1992 to September the 30th, 1999. He participated in many meetings and congresses both in Croatia and abroad. He is the member of the German Association of Urology, International Association of Urology and International Society for Distribution of Organs for Transplantation. He is associate member of the Croatian Academy of Medical Sciences, member of the Croatian Section for Urology and Section for Kidney Transplantation and Dialysis. He has published a great number of both scientific and professional papers, some as the author, and some as co-author.

specijalist urologije

Vjerislav Peterković rođen je 21. svibnja 1935. godine na Sušaku. Osnovnu i srednju školu pohađao je u Rijeci, a 1953. godine upisao je Medicinski fakultet u Zagrebu. Po otvorenju Medicinskoga fakulteta u Rijeci studij je završio u Rijeci, gdje je diplomirao 1960. godine.

Od 1962. zaposlen je na Klinici za kirurgiju na Sušaku. U okviru programa medicinske pomoći radi u Alžiru od 1964. do 1966. godine u Bolnici "Parment". Specijalistički ispit iz kirurgije položio je 1971. godine, a kao stipendist DAAD (Deutsche Akademisch Austausch Dienst) boravi 1974. godine na savršavanju kod profesora Carla Ericha Alkena na "Universität Urologische Klinik" na Homburgu-Saar. Specijalistički ispit iz urologije položio je 1977. godine na Urološkoj klinici Kliničkoga centra u Ljubljani, a 1982. stječe naslov primarijusa. Od 1983. do 1988. godine bio je predsjednik Kirurško-ortopedske sekcije Zbora liječnika Hrvatske u Rijeci.

Za pročelnika Odjela urologije imenovan je 1986. godine, a od 1962. godine, kada su započete prve hemodijalize na Sušaku, radi i na Odjelu za dijalizu. U siječnju 1971. godine učinio je prvu eksplantaciju bubrega sa živoga donora u nas, te je za to nagrađen brončanom medaljom grada Rijeke. Poučen iskustvima transplantacije bubrega prvi je u Rijeci učinio autotransplantaciju bubrega u koraliformne litijaze i tumora jedinoga bubrega.

Tijekom svoga rada pratio je skoro sva moderna dostignuća u urologiji (rekonstrukcijski i enteralni nadomjestni zahvati, radikalno liječenje malignoma uropoetskih putova, retroperitonejske limfadenektomije, zahvati na beskrvnom pothladenom bubregu itd.). Endoskopski zahvati su započeti davne 1978. godine, a primarijus Peterković uvodi svakodnevne operacije na uretri, vratu mokraćnoga mjehura, prostati i mokraćnom mjehuru. Prvu perkutanu litotripsiju izveo je 1987. godine, a prvu ureterorenoskopsku operaciju učinio je 1993. godine.

Za predsjednika Urološke sekcije Zbora liječnika Hrvatske izabran je od 1989. do 1992. godine, kada je osnovano Hrvatsko urološko društvo, a tada je biran za dopredsjednika HUD-a. Aktivni je član europskoga udruženja urologa (EAU). Odlikovan je 1997. godine, odlukom Glavnoga zbora liječnika Hrvatske, Zahvalnicom u znak priznanja za zasluge u radu Zbora, unaprjeđenja medicinske struke, te zdravstvene i humane djelatnosti. Godine 1998. bio je predsjednik Organizacijskoga odbora II. hrvatskoga urološkoga kongresa u Rijeci. Dobitnik je spomenice Domovinskoga rata.

Umirovljen je 2001. godine.

Primarius Doctor of Medicine Vjerislav Peterković,
Specialist in Urology
and Surgery

Vjerislav Peterković was born on May, the 21st, 1935 in Sušak. He attended elementary and high school in Rijeka, and in the year 1953 he enrolled at the Faculty of Medicine in Zagreb. After the opening of the Faculty of Medicine in Rijeka, he graduated there in the year 1960.

Since 1962 he worked at the Surgery Clinic in Sušak. As a part of the program of medical help, from 1964 to 1966 he worked in Algeria in the "Parmet" Hospital. In the year 1971 he passed the specialist exam in surgery, and as the scholarship holder of DAAD he stayed at Professor Carl Erich Alken's at the University Urology Clinic in Homburg-Saar. He passed the specialist exam in urology in the year 1977 at the Urology Clinic of the University Center in Ljubljana, and in the year 1982 he was awarded the title of Head Doctor (Primarius). From 1983 to 1988 he was the President of the Section for Surgery and Orthopedics of the Croatian Medical Association - Rijeka Branch.

He was elected Head of the Urology Department in 1986, and since 1962, when the first haemodialysis had started in Sušak, he worked at the Haemodialysis Department. In January 1971 he performed the first kidney explantation from the living donor in our country and for that he was awarded Bronze Medal of the City of Rijeka. Having learned from the experiences of kidney transplantation, he was the first in Rijeka to perform kidney autotransplantation in case of coralliform lithiasis and in case of tumor of the only kidney.

During his working career he followed almost all modern achievements in urology (reconstructive and enteral substitute procedures, radical treatment of malignant tumors of uropoietic tract, retroperitoneal lymphadenectomy, procedures on bloodless/exsanguine hypothermic kidney etc.). Endoscopic procedures were initiated in late 1978 and the Head Doctor Peterković introduced everyday surgical procedures on urethra, vertex of the urinary bladder, prostate and urinary bladder. He performed the first percutaneous lithotripsy in 1987 and the first ureterorenoscopic surgery in 1993.

He was elected President of the Section for Urology of the Croatian Medical Association for the period from 1989 to 1992, when the Croatian Society for Urology (HUD) was established and after that he was elected Vice-President of the HUD. He is the active member of the European Association of Urology (EUA). In the year 1997 he was awarded the Certificate of Merits by the Croatian Medical Association for his valuable contribution to the functioning of the Association, promotion of medical profession, as well as health and humanitarian activities and work. In the year 1998 he was the President of the Organizing Committee of The Second Urological Congress in Rijeka. He is the recipient of the Decoration "Certificate of Participation in the Homeland War 1990-1992".

He was retired in the year 2001.
