The current issue brings various interesting topics. It is the confirmation that the Journal is recognized as a valuable professional and scientific tool not only by domestic but also by foreign scholars and experts. This is the first issue that was not funded from the INTEREULAWEAST Project in any part. The settlement of all expenses and the whole logistic support is now carried out by the publisher - Faculty of Economics & Business, University of Zagreb. In 2017 the Journal entered HeinOnline and ProQuest databases. Furthermore, Digital Object Identifier System (DOI) was implemented. The Creative Commons CC-BY-NC 4.0 license was accepted as a standard. All this steps and results regarding the improvements of the Journal's quality made us more than satisfied.

For the 2018 the plans on improvements are at least equal, probably bigger. All the issues regarding authors, reviewers and publishers liabilities and ethics were carefully studied and compiled as the Journals Policy & Ethical Standards which are published on the Journal's webpages. The standards were tailored in order to achieve the best contemporary practices regarding publishing of scientific papers. Additionally, the upcoming extensive revision of the Instructions for the Authors is expected to achieve even higher level of uniformity and consistency of the papers in terms of form and structure. Also, the electronic review forms are to be introduced soon. All the planned improvements of the Journal should reflect already in Volume 5, Issue 1 in June 2018.
