

RIMSKI NOVAC DO KARAKALINE MONETARNE REFORME S PROSTORA BURNUMA, IZ FUNDUSA ARHEOLOŠKOGA MUZEJA ZADAR

Autor u članku obrađuje rimski novac koji se nalazi u zbirci Arheološkog muzeja Zadar a porijeklom je s Burnuma. Obradeno je 144 komada novca koji datiraju od perioda kasne Republike do Karakaline monetarne reforme. Uglavnom, najviše prevladava novac Jullijevsko – Klaudijevske dinastije, odnosno novac I. stoljeća. Po brojnosti zatim slijedi novac Antonina koji je među nalazima vrlo čest. Rad sažeto prikazuje dosad objavljene nalaze rimskog novca s Burnuma, donosi nove primjerke te ukazuje na neke zakonitosti pri ponavljanju vrsta novca na navedenom prostoru. Također određena pozornost se daje i novcu kovanom u Lugdunumu koje je relativno dobro zastupljen te drugima nalazima lionske provenijencije na Burnumu koji bi se s tim optjecajem mogli povezati.

ROMAN COINS UP TO CARACALLA'S COINAGE REFORM FROM THE BURNUM AREA, KEPT IN THE HOLDINGS OF THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM ZADAR

In the paper, the author deals with the Roman coinage which is kept in the collection of the Archaeological Museum Zadar. 144 coins were analysed dating back to the period of late-Republic to Caracalla's coinage reform. Generally, the most prevalent is the coinage from the Julian-Claudian dynasty, that is, the coins from the 1st century. This number is followed by Antonius' coins, which among the finds are very common. The paper summarises the published finds of Roman coins from Burnum, presents new examples and points to some patterns in replicating the type of coinage in that area. Furthermore, special attention is also paid to the coins minted in Lugdunum, which are relatively well-represented, as well as other finds of Lyon origin in Burnum, which could be connected with that circulation.

Iako je s prostora Burnuma¹ dosad objavljeno više od 300 komada novca,² zadovoljavajuće poznavanje optjecaja novca na njegovu arealu i dalje nije potpuno riješeno. Rimski carski novac s Burnuma, posebice ranocarski te kasnorepublikanski, dosad je bio predmetom nekoliko znanstvenih objava i rasprava. Ovaj rad ima za cilj proširiti repertoar poznavanja rimskoga novca na navedenome prostoru i dati bolji uvid u poznavanje ekonomskih prilika i monetarne cirkulacije na prostoru Burnuma i okolice. Dosad objavljeni novaci u razne je muzejske institucije na prostoru Dalmacije došao većim dijelom otkupom (prvi novac otkupljivao je još fra Lujo Marun), a manjim dijelom arheološkim istraživanjima, iako broj novaca pronađenoga u istraživanjima nipošto nije zanemariv.³ Ovaj se članak primarno ograničio na nalaze primjeraka kasnorepublikanskoga i ranocarskoga novca iz zbirke Arheološkoga muzeja Zadar, do pojave antoninijana, odnosno do Karakaline monetarne reforme. U fundusu Arheološkoga muzeja Zadar čuva se više od 600 komada rimskoga novca s Burnuma od 2. st. pr. Kr. do 4. stoljeća, a razdoblju do 213. godine pripada njih 144. Dosad je iz toga fundusa⁴ jedino objavljen Neronov aurej koji je pronađen 1898.⁵ Osim nekoliko Augustovih aseva koji su u muzej u Zadru došli arheološkim istraživanjima u Burnumu 1974. (kat. br. 6 – 8, 31 – 34), svi ostali primjerici novaca došli su otkupom od lokalnih stanovnika na prostoru sela Ivoševci i mjesta Kistanje. Među prodavačima najpoznatija je obitelj Grčić koja je prve transakcije s muzejskim institucijama započela još krajem 19. stoljeća. Obitelj Grčić je Arheološkome muzeju u Zadru u periodu od 1961. do 1982.⁶ prodala sve ostale navedene primjerke novaca, no bez opisa točnoga položaja nalaza, tako da se kao lokalitet može uzeti širi prostor Burnuma.

PREGLED NOVCA

Najstariji novac nađen na Burnumu republikanski je srebrni denar koji se datira u 119. g. pr. Kr. (kat. br. 1.) Riječ je o tipu novca koji se kuje sve do kraja Rimskog Carstva, zbog svoje kvalitete i čistoće metala, nalazio se u optjecaju još dugo nakon što je iskovani. Njega slijede i drugi denari iz nešto kasnijega perioda (kat. br. 2 – 8) te prvi novac Oktavijana i Marka Antonija (kat. br. 6 – 10). Najstariji dosad objavljeni republikanski denar s Burnuma pripada M. Bebiju Tamfilu (M. Baebius Q. f. Tamphilus) i datira se u 137. g. pr. Kr.⁷ Oktavijanu pripada kvinar neutvrđene italske kovnice (ASIA RECEPTA) koji s ovime sačinjava treći takav nalaz s Burnuma⁸ te šesti

Although from the Burnum area¹ more than 300 coins² have been published so far, a satisfactory knowledge of the circulation of coinage in its area is still not completely accomplished. The Roman Imperial coins from Burnum, especially early-Imperial and late-Republcan, have been the topic of several research publications and debates. This paper aims to broaden the repertoire of the knowledge of the Roman coins in the area mentioned above and give a better insight into the economic situation and monetary circulation in the area of Burnum and its surroundings. The coins published to date have reached various museums in Dalmatia mostly by being bought (the first coins were bought by Fra Lujo Marun), and to a lesser extent by archaeological research, although the amount of coins found in archaeological excavations is by no means negligible.³ This paper is primarily focused on the finds of examples from the late Republican and early Imperial coins from the collection of the Archaeological Museum Zadar, up to the appearance of the antoninus, that is, Caracalla's coinage reform. In the holdings of the Archaeological Museum Zadar, more than 600 Roman coins are kept from Burnum dating from the 2nd century BC to the 4th century AD, and 144 pieces belong to the period up to 213 AD. From this holding⁴, only Nero's aureus found in 1898⁵ has been published so far. Apart from several Augustus' asses which came to the Museum of Zadar through archaeological excavations carried out at Burnum in 1974 (cat. no. 6 – 8, 31 – 34), all the other examples of coins were purchased from the local people of the village of Ivoševci and that of Kistanje. Among the vendors, the most famous was the Grčić family, who started their first transactions with the museums as early as the late 19th century. The Grčić family sold to the Archaeological Museum Zadar all the examples of coins mentioned above from 1961 to 1982⁶, but without submitting a description of the exact location of the finds, so that the Burnum area may be taken as the wider area of the site.

OVERVIEW OF THE COINS

The oldest currency found in Burnum was the Republican silver denarius which dates back to 119 BC (cat. no. 1.) It is a type of coin which was minted all the way to the end of the Roman Republic because of the quality and purity of the metal, and was in circulation long time after it had been minted. It was also followed by the other denarii from a later period (cat. no. 2 – 8) as well as the first coins of Octavian and Mark Antony (cat. no. 6 – 10). The oldest Republican denarius from Burnum published so far belongs to M. Baebius Q. f. Tamphilus and dates back to 137 BC.⁷ The quinarius from an undetermined Italic mint (ASIA RECEPTA) belongs to Octavian, which thus makes the third find

dosad objavljeni kvinar.⁹ Marku Antoniju pripadaju 3 legijska denara¹⁰ (kat. br. 6 – 8) i jedan kvinar (kat. br. 4) iskovan za njegovu ženu Fulviju u Lugdunumu. Navedeni denari, koje je za potrebe financiranja svojih legija iskovao Marko Antonije, imali su na sebi numeracije legija kojima su bili namjenjeni. Jedino se za denar pod kat. br. 6 može ustvrditi da se na njemu nalazi broj II. legije, dok je na ostalim dvama primjercima taj podatak nepoznat. Iz Narbonske Galije, odnosno iz Lugdunuma i Nimesa (Nemausus), potječu denar i dva asa (kat. br. 10, 11 i 15), kovani za Augusta. Denar s bikom na reversu iz 11.-10. g. pr. Kr. već je potvrđen na Burnumu.¹¹ Augustovu razdoblju pripadaju regularni i vrlo česti asevi te kvadransi (kat. br. 12, 16 – 20) kovani od 15. g. pr. Kr. do 7. godine. Taj novac, s imenima monetarnih magistrata, vrlo je databilan. Jedan je, kao i novac iz Nimesa, rezan (kat. br. 12) da se dobije manja nominala koja je nedostajala u optjecaju. Augustovu periodu može se pribrojiti i nešto rjeđi dupondij kovan 15. g. pr. Kr., s imenom monetarnoga magistrata Lucija Surdina (L. Surdinus).¹² Osim regularnih aseva, na Burnumu je pronađena i jedna krivotvorina iz Augustova vremena. U tome periodu krivotvorine rimskoga novca nisu rijetkost.¹³ Štoviše, one se češće javljaju kad regularnoga novca ima dosta u optjecaju negoli kad se osjeća njegov manjak.

No najbrojniji je novac julijevsko-klaudijevske dinastije (kat. br. 11 – 77) nakon Augustove smrti, s najvećom producijom novca za cara Klaudija. Takva pojava velike količine Klaudijeva novca može se pripisati upravo demonetizaciji Kaligulina novca. U tome periodu u optjecaju su najčešće bile srednje brončane nominale, asevi i dupondiji, zatim četvrtine aseva, odnosno kvadransi, dok su sesterciji ili denari nešto rjeđi, a ovi potonji često samo pokriveni tankim slojem srebra (kat. br. 31 – 33). Navedeni denari emitirani su za Tiberijeve vladavine. Dosad je objavljen i jedan nalaz Neronova suberata.¹⁴ Na Burnumu su pronađena i dva sestercija iz toga perioda, a iskovani su za Agripinu Stariju i za Nerona (kat. br. 45 i 70). Neronu pripada već spomenuti aurej s prikazom Jupitera na reversu, koji je fra Lujo Marun otkupio od jednoga mještanina Ivoševaca 1898., a točno je mjesto nalaska polje uokolo Šupljaje.¹⁵ Takav tip Neronova aureja predstavlja najčešći nalaz zlatnoga novca julijevsko-klaudijevske dinastije i nije rijetka pojava. No to nije i jedini zlatni novac s prostora Burnuma. Već je objavljen Augustov aurej kovan 19. ili 18. g. pr. Kr., vjerojatno u *Caesaraugsti*.¹⁶ U znanstvenome smislu zlatnici, za razliku od ostaloga numizmatičkog materijala,

from Burnum⁸ and the sixth quinarius published to date.⁹ Three legion denarii belong to Mark Antony¹⁰ (cat. no. 6 – 8) and one quinarius (cat. no. 4) was struck for his wife Fulvia in Lugdunum. The above mentioned denarii, which had been minted by Mark Antony for the purposes of financing his legions, were marked by the numbers of the legions they were intended for. Only the denarius under the catalogue number 6 can be said to bear number II on it, while in the other two examples this information is not disclosed. A denarius and two asses originate from Narbona Galia, that is, from Lugdunum and Nimes (Nemausus) (cat. no. 10, 11 and 15), struck during the reign of Augustus. The denarius with a bull on the reverse from 11-10 BC has already been confirmed in Burnum.¹¹ Regular and very common asses, as well as quadrantes (cat. no. 12, 16-20), struck from 15 BC to 7 AD, also belong to Augustus' period. These coins with the names of monetary magistrates are easily datable. One coin, like those from Nimes, is cut (cat. no. 12) to obtain a smaller denomination much needed in the coinage circulation. A somewhat less common dupondius could also be attributed to Augustus' period minted in 15 BC containing the name of the Monetary Magistrate Lucius Surdinus.¹² In addition to regular asses, a fake coin from the time of Augustus was found at the site of Burnum. At that time counterfeiting of Roman coins was not a rarity.¹³ Moreover, it often occurred when there was enough regular coinage in circulation than when there was a shortage of it.

However, the most numerous were the coins of the Julian-Claudian dynasty (cat. no. 11 – 77) after Augustus' death, with their largest production during the rule of Emperor Claudius. The appearance of such a huge amount of Claudius' coins may be attributed to debasement of Caligula's coinage. This was the time of the most frequent circulation of medium bronze denominations, asses and dupondii, then quarters of asses or quadrantes, while sestertii or denarii were slightly less common, and the latter were often plated with a thin layer of silver (cat. no. 31 – 33). These denarii were issued during Tiberius' rule. A find of Nero's suberatus has also been published so far.¹⁴ Two sestertii were found at Burnum belonging to that period, which were struck for Agrippina the Elder and Nero (cat. no. 45 i 70). The above mentioned aureus depicting Jupiter on the reverse also belonged to Nero; it was bought by Fra Lujo Marun from a local resident of Ivoševci in 1898, and the exact place where it had been found is a field around Šupljaja.¹⁵ Such a type of Nero's aureus represents the most common find of gold coinage from the Julian-Claudian dynasty and is not a rare occurrence.

nisu optimalno korisni u dataciji, osim ako strogo ne korespondiraju s ostalim arheološkim materijalom u određenoj sloju. Razlog tomu leži u činjenici da oni nisu služili za svakodnevne novčane transakcije i, kao takvi, vrlo su teško izlazili iz optjecaja. Osim aurejom, Neron je zastupljen polovicom asa, odnosno semisom, što predstavlja nešto rjeđu pojavu među nalazima (kat. br. 66).

Iz perioda flavijevske dinastije s prostora Burnuma zastupljeno je nešto manje kovanica negoli za julijevsko-klaudijske dinastije (kat. br. 72 – 93). Vrlo je važno spomenuti i rijedak primjerak Titova komemorativnoga asa za Galbu, kovanoga 80. ili 81. godine (kat. br. 85). Taj novac predstavlja vrlo rijetku pojavu u poznatoj numizmatičkoj građi s prostora sjeverne Dalmacije.¹⁷ Većinu flavijevskih nominala sačinjavaju asevi te dupondiji, no važno je posebno izdvojiti Domitianov kvadrans (kat. br. 86). Nakon Flavijevaca, razdoblje 2. stoljeća zastupljeno je s relativno većom količinom novca, što je posljedica povoljnijih ekonomskih prilika u čitavome Rimskom Carstvu. Razlog tomu jest dugotrajno razdoblje stabilizacije i mira, koje se očitovalo i u povećanoj produkciji novoga i svježega novca. Period od Nerve do Marka Aurelija zastupljen je s 29 komada novca (kat. br. 93 – 122), od kojih većinu sačinjavaju veće nominale, dupondiji, ali i sesterciji. Također, to je i vrijeme vrlo česte pojave denara u optjecaju. Nakon Marka Aurelija, pa do vladavine Karakale, zapaža se lagani pad u cirkulaciji novca, izražen nepovoljnim gospodarskim stanjem koje na kraju i dovodi do uvođenja novoga novca, antoninijana, Karakalinom monetarnom reformom. Katalog novca završava Karakalinim denarom iz 214. godine (kat. br. 133).

RASPRAVA

Prikazani se novac kronološki datira od 137. godine pr. Kr. do 214. godine. U tome razdoblju najčešće su kolale moneete od bakra i bronce: kvadrans, asevi, dupondiji i sesterciji. Burnum tu nije izuzetak. Na dvama dosad objavljenim uzorcima, kao i na onome prikazanom u ovome radu, zapaža se standardni spektar rimskega novca na Burnumu koji se, uz manje izuzetke, može očekivati i ubuduće te se može smatrati standardnim. Početkom prvoga stoljeća u Burnumu kola kasnorepublikanski srebrni novac te tzv. imperatorijski novac. Augustovu vladavinu obilježava veći priljev brončanih nominala, posebice aseva, te pojava denara, kovanih većinom u Lugdunumu. To nije izuzetak jer i na prostorima drugih legijskih logora u to vrijeme kolaju monete od plemenitih metala iskovane u toj kovnici.¹⁸ Za vrijeme Tiberija, posebice Klaudija, dolazi do velikoga priljeva novca koji se održava identičnim tijekom do građanskoga rata 68/69. Za flavijevske dinastije osjeća se niski pad koji traje sve do početka 2. stoljeća, kad je općenito nastupilo povoljno vrijeme blagostanja i mira. To se odrazilo i na optjecaj novca.

However, this is not the only gold coin from Burnum. The Augustus' aureus has already been published, minted in 19 or 18 BC, probably in *Caesaraugusta*.¹⁶ In scientific terms, gold coins, unlike other numismatic material, are not optimally useful for dating unless they strictly correspond to the other archaeological material in a particular layer. The reason for this lies in the fact that they were not used for everyday cash transactions and, as such, they were not easily withdrawn from circulation. Apart from the aureus, Nero is represented by half an as or a semis, which is a slightly less common occurrence among the finds (cat. no. 66).

From the period of the Flavian dynasty a slightly smaller amount of coins in the Burnum area were found than was the case with the Julian-Claudian dynasty (cat. no. 72 – 93). It is also important to mention a rare example of Titus' commemoration as for Galba, minted in 80 or 81 BC (cat. no. 85). This coinage represents a very rare occurrence in the known numismatic material from the area of northern Dalmatia.¹⁷ Most of the Flavian denominations consist of asses and dupondii, but it is important to specially single out Domitianus' quadrantes (cat. no. 86). After the Flavians, the period of the 2nd century was represented with a relatively large amount of coins, which was the result of a favourable economic situation all over the Roman Empire. The reason for this was a long stable and peaceful period, which resulted in the increased production of new and fresh coinage. The period from Nerva to Marcus Aurelius is represented with 19 coins (cat. no. 93 – 122), most of which comprise greater denominations, dupondii, but also sestertii. Furthermore, this was also the time of a very frequent appearance of denarius in circulation. After Marcus Aurelius, and even to Caracalla's rule, a slight decrease in the circulation of coins can be noticed, due to the unfavourable economic situation, which eventually led to the introduction of a new coin, the antoninianus by Caracalla's coinage reform. The catalogue of coins concludes with Caracalla's denarius from 214 AD (cat. no. 133).

DISCUSSION

The presented coins chronologically date back from 137 BC to 214 AD. In that period, copper and bronze coins were most commonly used: quadrantes, asses, dupondii and sestertii. Burnum here is no exception. In the two examples published so far, as well as in the one shown in this work, the standard spectrum of Roman coinage in Burnum may be noted, which, with few exceptions, was also to be expected in the future and be considered as standard. At the beginning of the first century, the late Republican silver coins were used, as well as the so-called Imperial coinage. Augustus' reign was marked by a higher inflow of bronze denominations, especially asses, as well as the appearance of denarii, struck mostly in Lugdunum. This is not an exception because in the areas of other legionary camps of that time, coins of precious metals in circulation were

Svakako bi trebalo ukazati na dvije relativno specifične pojave na ovome uzorku. Pojavljuje se određen broj suberata koji su zastupljeni i u druga dva već ranije objavljena uzorka. Iako ovaj uzorak pokazuje sasvim standardni presjek novca kakav se nalazi i u prijašnjim objavama, te s obzirom na to da postoji mogućnost da su nalaznici novac selektirali za prodaju (za različite otkupljivače, institucije i kolekcionare), bez daljnje analize neće se moći optimalno pristupiti pojavi denara suberata na uzorcima burnumskoga novca. Svakako vrijeme prvoga stoljeća i jest vrijeme u kojem kolaju velike količine takvoga novca, no upada u oči da posrebreni primjeri, čini se, predstavljaju veći uzorak negoli suvremenii denari s čitavim srebrnim sastavom. Svakako je bitno spomenuti i nalaze novca provenijencijom iz Lugdunuma. Riječ je o 10 primjera ka novca od kojih je najstariji iskovan za Marka Antonija (Fulviju), a najmlađi za Vespazijana. U pitanju je pet srebrnih kovanica te pet brončanih. Iako novac podrijetlom iz Lugdunuma predstavlja značajnu količinu nalaza u legijskim logorima na Rajni, svakako bi za takvu situaciju u Burnumu trebalo obratiti više pažnje, s obzirom na to da se takav novac može očekivati na trgovačkim pravcima prema Rajni i Dunavu, a manje u Dalmaciji, premda je kovnica u Lugdunumu bila vrlo bitna za produkciju novca u ranome prvom stoljeću. Tome u prilog ide i nešto značajniji uzorak lionske keramike iz Burnuma, inače vrlo rijetke u Dalmaciji.¹⁹ Govori li to o nekim specifičnim korespondencijama Lugdunuma i Burnuma, na osnovu ovoga uzorka teško je reći, no uzimajući u obzir dva navedena aspekta bi i ubuduće trebalo nastaviti sistematizaciju numizmatičkoga materijala s Burnuma jer će se s većim uzorkom lakše moći odgovoriti na neka postavljena pitanja.

ZAKLJUČAK

Prikaz novca s prostora Burnuma u Arheološkome muzeju Zadar sadrži 144 komada novca kovanih od 119. g. pr. Kr. do 214. g. struck in this mint.¹⁸ At the time of Tiberius, especially Claudius, there was a huge inflow of coins which remained unchangeable during the Civil War in 68/69. During the rule of the Flavian dynasty, there was a slight decrease which lasted all the way to the early 2nd century, when the Empire went through a favourable time of prosperity and peace. This was also reflected in the circulation of money. Two relatively specific phenomena should definitely be emphasised in this example. A number of suberati appeared, which are also represented in the other two already published examples. Although this example shows a fairly standard cross-section of coinage as found in previous publications, and given the possibility that coin finders selected them for sale (for different buyers, institutions and collectors), without a further analysis, it will not be possible to optimally approach the appearance of suberati in the examples of the Burnum coinage. The first century was certainly the time of the circulation of large amounts of such coins, but it is striking that silver plated coins appear to have been a larger sample than the contemporary denarii which were entirely made of silver. It is also very important to mention the finds of coins from Lugdunum. These are ten examples of coins, of which the oldest was struck during Mark Antony's rule (Fulvia), and the youngest in Vespasian's time. These include five silver coins and five bronze ones. Although the coins which originate from Lugdunum represent a significant amount of finds in the legionary camps on the Rhine, this situation in Burnum certainly deserves more attention, given the fact that such coins may have been expected on the commercial routes to the Rhine and Danube and less to Dalmatia, even though the mint in Lugdunum was very important for money production in the early first century. This is also supported by a somewhat more significant Lyon ceramics from Burnum, otherwise very rare in Dalmatia.¹⁹ Whether this tells us about some specific correspondences between Lugdunum and Burnum it is difficult to say on the basis of this sample, but taking into account the two above mentioned aspects, the systematization of numismatic material at Burnum should continue in the future because a larger sample will facilitate finding answers to some of the unanswered questions.

CONCLUSION

The overview of the coins from the Burnum area in the Archaeological Museum Zadar contains 144 coins minted from 119 BC to 214 AD. The presentation will certainly contribute to the overall knowledge of the numismatic topography of northern Dalmatia, that is, the southern part of ancient Liburnia, but also contribute to wider research of the problem area of the circulation of the early Imperial coins in the other areas of the former Roman Empire. Given Burnum's character as a site and the state of its exploration, a significant amount of numismatic material is expected to be found in the future, which will make a greater contribution to the knowledge of the past of Burnum and its surroundings.


