Dokumentacijsko-referalni centar (DRC) je ustrojbeni jedinica Udruge hrvatskih veterana Domovinskog rata kojoj su temeljne zadaće prikupljanje, obrada i diseminacija informacija i dokumenata o hrvatskom Domovinskom ratu u svrhu promicanja znanstvenih i stručnih istraživanja o Domovinskom ratu i hrvatskim braniteljima.

Temeljne funkcije DRC-a jesu:
