DEMOCRATIC PROCESSES AND THE BEGINNING OF SERBIAN REBELLION IN THE AREA OF ZADAR, BENKOVAC AND OBROVAC MUNICIPALITIES DURING 1989 AND 1990

Summary

This paper, based on relevant literature, archive material and newspapers, examines transition processes in the area of Zadar, Benkovac and Obrovac municipalities during 1989 and 1990.
