

Annual General Meeting of the Croatian Association of Kinesiology Teaching Methodologists

On October 9, 2018, the annual general meeting (AGM) of the Croatian Association of Kinesiology Teaching Methodologists took place at the Faculty of Teacher Education, University of Zagreb – Petrinja. The Department in Petrinja has been the head office of the Croatian Association of Kinesiology Teaching Methodologists for 15 years. The conclusions of the AGM support the reform of the educational system, which is founded on the scope of the National curricular framework (2011), change in number of teaching hours for the subject Physical and health education in accordance with the recommendations of the profession and scientific research which implies five hours per week in primary education and a minimum of three hours

per week throughout education including higher education, and the change of the subject's name in agreement with the findings of the subsience area 12 kinesiology. According to the conclusion, the name of the subject proposed to the public and through scientific journals is Kinesiology education, and the kinesiology education area. Furthermore, unanimous decisions on the necessity of expanding the Association into international, and the establishment of the International Chair for Kinesiology were reached. Throughout the AGM, participants were informed of the advancements in the curricular reform by Professor Ivan Prskalo, president of the Association and member of the Expert workgroup for the implementation of the curricular reform. Professor Emeritus and honorary president of the Association, Vladimir Findak significantly contributed to the discussions relating to this topic. The AGM was attended by a representative of the Student Council. New members, among whom four are respectable teachers from the University of Maribor, were admitted to the Association.

Godišnja skupština Hrvatske udruge kinezioloških metodičara

U Petrinji je, u prostorima Odsjeka Učiteljskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, koji je već 15 godina sjedište Hrvatske udruge kinezioloških metodičara, 9. listopada 2018. godine održana godišnja skupština Udruge na kojoj je zaključeno kako se podržava takva reforma obrazovnog sustava koja će se temeljiti na dosezima Nacionalnog okvirnog kurikula iz 2011. godine, promjeni satnice predmeta Tjelesna i zdravstvena kultura u skladu s preporukama struke i znanosti, što podrazumijeva pet sati tjedno u primarnoj edukaciji i minimalno tri sata tjedno do kraja školovanja uključujući i studij, te promjena imena predmeta i područja u skladu s dosezima supstratne znanosti 12 kineziologije. Prema tom zaključku, višestruko prezentiranom javnosti i putem znanstvenih časopisa, predmet bi se zvao Kineziološka kultura, a područje kineziološko odgojno-obrazovno područje. Također su donesene jednoglasne odluke o potrebi transformacije Udruge u međunarodnu, te osnivanja Međunarodne katedre za kineziologiju. Tijekom skupštine sudionici su informirani o napretku kurikulne reforme od prof. dr. sc. Ivana Prskala, predsjednika Udruge i člana Ekspertne radne skupine za provođenje kurikulne reforme. U raspravi o toj problematici vrlo je aktivno sudjelovao i prof. emeritus dr. sc. Vladimir Findak, počasni predsjednik Udruge. Na Skupštini su u Udrugu, u čijem je radu sudjelovao i predstavnik Studentskog zbora, primljeni i novi članovi, među kojima su i četiri ugledna nastavnika Sveučilišta u Mariboru.
