

*AMERIČKE, KANADSKE I ENGLJSKE DOKTORSKE
DISERTACIJE O JUGOSLAVENSKIM ZEMLJAMA
I SFR JUGOSLAVIJI*

Bibliografski prilog za razdoblje 1960—1972.

Pregledavajući bibliografske radove prof. Jessea Dossicka¹ u kojima objelodanjuje popis disertacija obranjenih u Americi, Kanadi i Engleskoj unazad desetak godina, ustanovili smo da se zamjeran broj odnosi i na jugoslavenske zemlje i na SFR Jugoslaviju. Zbog toga smo i izradili ovaj popis u kojem smo radove svrstali po tematici i kronološki od općih tema do filologije i književnosti. Na taj način uzeli smo u obzir i ona znanstvena područja, koja nisu direktno povijesna, no na širem planu mogu ipak ponekad poslužiti kao potreban i vrijedan dopunski materijal. Svrstavajući radove ustanovili smo osim toga da je najviše disertacija, koje su za nas zanimljive, obranjeno na Columbia sveučilištu, Harvardu, Berkeleyu itd. Teme su najraznovrsnije, no ipak pretežu one za razdoblje 19. stoljeća do prvoga svjetskog rata i filološko-književne, izuzevši naravno one koje obrađuju neku opću problematiku s težištem veoma često na međunarodnim odnosima. A dosta je velik broj i onih disertacija, koje direktno obrađuju socijalističku izgradnju.

Nastojali smo ustanoviti prema katalogu Nacionalne sveučilišne knjižnice u Zagrebu jesu li pojedine disertacije u međuvremenu i štampane, odnosno je li dotični autor objelodanio i neki drugi rad. Kako je eruirano svega nekoliko podataka, vjerujemo da su naši podaci veoma nepotpuni, no usprkos tome ćemo ih u bilješkama citirati uz svakog autora, ostavljajući otvorenim pitanje za sve ostale nama nedostupne i nepoznate priloge.

Na kraju svake objelodanjene bibliografske jedinice stavljamo kraticu koja ukazuje na sastavljača bibliografije, godište časopisa i stranicu na kojoj se jedinica nalazi — Dossick, godište, stranica.
