To the President of the United States

Dear Sir,

As a Croat and a Croatian writer, I take the liberty to address to you this open letter.

I am convinced that the facts that I will present in this letter are just as well known to you as they are to me, yet you try to forget them and I would like to remind you of them.

Please remember how the large and powerful Yugoslav People's Army came into being. This was done in the interest of security of the United States and its people and to enhance the prestige of your country. The United States needed another military force against the Communist Soviet Union and therefore it readily supported, financed and trained the Yugoslav Army.

This huge military machine of a communist state that is Yugoslavia has now come down with full force on the Croats, one of the nations of that state, simply because they do not wish to abandon the path to democracy and are not prepared to leave their native soil which they have lovingly tilled and defended at great cost through the centuries. The problem that prompted the creation of such a disproportionately large Yugoslav Army no longer exists. You, the citizens of your country and of the West can freely indulge in your hobbies, but before you do that, please remember that you have forgotten something – namely, to remove this unnecessary and dangerous military force. In the meantime, this army has gone wild and is now shooting at everybody who does not believe in communism.

When the United States was helping to create such a powerful Yugoslav Army, it had no idea that it was building up its own enemy and an enemy of the Western civilization, a treacherous force that would turn against it and its allies at the first opportunity. It has done precisely this now in attacking Croatia. At the same time, you delay facing this unpleasant fact and error of judgement on the part of the West. But while you are procrastinating, an ancient European nation is being threatened with extinction. Farewell, Mr. President.

Emperor Constantine VII Porphyrogenitus, A. D. 949: Καὶ γὰρ οὗτοι οἱ Χρῶβῆτοι μετὰ τὸ αὐτοῦ βαπτισθῆναι συνθήκας καὶ ἰδιόχερα ἐποιήσαντο καὶ πρὸς τὸν ἅγιον Πέτρον, τὸν ἀποστόλου ἄγγελον βεβαίως καὶ ἀσφαλεῖς, ὡς μηδέποτε εἰς ἄλλοτριαν χώραν ἀπέλθωσιν καὶ πολεμήσωσιν, ἀλλὰ μάλλον εἰρηνεύειν μετὰ πάντων τῶν βουλομένων, λαβόντες καὶ παρὰ τοῦ αὐτοῦ πάπα Ῥώμης εὐχὴν τοιαύτην, ὡς εἰ τινας ἄλλοι ἔθνη κατὰ τῆς τῶν αὐτῶν Χρῶβῆτων χώρας ἐπέλθωσιν καὶ πόλεμον ἐπιτελέωσιν, ἵνα τῶν Χρῶβῆτων ὁ Θεὸς προσλαμῆται καὶ προσταταί, καὶ νίκας αὐτοῦ Πέτρος ὁ Χρῆστος μαθητῆς προέξει.*

Emperor Constantine VII Porphyrogenitus, A. D. 949: For after their baptism the Croats made a covenant, confirmed with their own hand and by oaths sure and binding in the name of St. Peter the apostle, that never would they go upon a foreign country and make war on it, but rather would live at peace with all who were willing to do so; and they received from the same pope of Rome a benediction to this effect, that if any other foreigners should come against the country of these same Croats and bring war upon it, then might God fight for the Croats and protect them, and Peter the disciple of Christ give them victories.
