

## **SURVEY AND CHRONOLOGY OF CROATIAN BANS AND DUKES FROM 1321 TO 1330 – PART 2**

In this contribution, which is a continuation of the article published in the last number of *Numizmatičke vijesti*, the author shows from the text of Latin documents the extent of the powers of Mladen Šubić (1312-1322), Ban of the Kingdom of Dalmatia and Croatian and Ban and Duke of Bosnia, and of Ivan Babonić (1316-1322), Nikola Amadijev (1322-1324) and Mikac Mihaljević (1324-1343), Bans of All Slavonia, Croatia and Dalmatia, and how these bans participated in contemporary social and political life. He also writes about the parts of the documents important for giving a picture of the time, and about the coins and the monetary system that they mention.

Finally, in the wish to also show the reader something visually beautiful and not easily accessible, he has again enriched the text with illustrations of several original documents that he examined to write this article. The documents are kept in the Croatian State Archives in Zagreb.
