INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

The journal LIBRI ONCOLOGICI publishes original, full-length scientifc papers, professional papers, research reports, review articles, case reports, short communications and professional information pertinent to oncology implying that the paper has not been published or submitted for publication elsewhere.

The authors alone are held responsible for the accuracy of their manuscripts. The Editorial Board recommends a maximum of 12 pages. Except otherwise approved by the Editorial Board, all manuscripts exceeding the above limit will be returned unread to authors.

LIBRI ONCOLOGICI will consider manuscripts prepared according to the Vancouver Agreement.

All papers are subjected to editorial review and review by two independent referees selected by the Editorial Board. Papers which do not comply with the technical requirements stated below will be returned to the authors for correction before the review.

Accepted papers become the property of the journal and cannot be published elsewhere without writ en permission from the Editorial Board.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Manuscripts, including all supplements - figures and tables, should be submited in printed form and digital form (Word for Windows) via e-mail.

Type the manuscript double-spaced on one side of A4 sheet, with a 4 cm margin at the top and on the left, preferably with no indent at the beginning of each paragraph. Words which are to be printed in italic or bold are to be underlined. Make note in the left hand margin where fgures or tables are to be inserted. Abbreviations are to be avoided unless writen in full the frst time they are used.

TEXT

The frst page should include:

Title, Author(s), Full name of the institution from which the work originates, Summary - short (maximum 500 words) and substantive Key words - three to six covering the main topics. Key words should be separated by a semicolon.

If appropriate, the text should be organized as follows:

Introduction - a short and clear review of the problems involved **Material and methods** - providing enough information so that experiments can be repeated

Results - presented clearly and concisely with their signif cance statistically analyzed

Discussion - should interpret the results obtained and compare them with major relevant findings from which clear

Conclusion(s) - can be drawn.

TABLES AND FIGURES

Tables and figures should be intelligible, without abbreviations except for standard units of measurement. Pictures should be in TIFF or IPEG format with minimal 300 DPI.

REFERENCES

References should be writen on a separate sheet observing the Vancouver style. Number the references consecutively in the

order in which they appear in the text (the first reference in the paper gets number 1). References style should follow the NLM standards summarized in the ICMJE: Recommendations for the Conduct, Reporting, Editing and Publication of Scholarly Work in Medical Journals. The author will be sent a galley proof for technical and printing corrections. The proof should be marked with imprimatur, date and signature and as soon as possible returned to the Editorial Board.

ETHICS

All data on the manusript and the authors are priviledged information and should not be disclosed or used throught the submittance and review process for other purposes.

Conflict of interest should be avoided in both submittance and review process and potential conflicts with industry and institutions should be declared within the cover letter. In case the conflict of interest is not declared and is discovered after the publication the Editor reserves the right to widraw the already accepted/published article and inform the appropriate bodies of this breach in ethical code.

Authors may be asked to provide the original data related to the manusript if reviewers need more clarification. Requirements for the authorship are active involvement in research/manuscript draft, data gatherin, literature search, crutial interpretation of data andmanusript writing. Authors responsibility is similarity awareness, precise quating of other publications. These are checked by a computer software prior to review process.

Reviewers are chosen by the editorial board based on their field of expertise. They are obliged to review the manusript with a given timeframe or else excuse themselves from the process upon recieving the request. The manusript are not to be shown or distributed to the third parties except with the approval of the Editor in Chief. All remarks should be well argumented. The referrences should be evaluated for their upto date content and relevance. The reviewer is responsible for declaring his/her conflict of interest for competition or collaboration reasons or involvement with the industry and widraw from the review process in case these exist.
