SUMMARY

STATERS (TRIDRACHMS) OF THE ILLYRIAN KING MONUNIUS COINED IN DYRRACHION

In the article “Markings on Old Staters of Dyrrachion”, published in *Numizmatičke vijesti* 2017, I listed, showed and explained the markings on the staters of Dyrrachion, and mentioned only in passing some staters of the Illyrian King Monunius. In this article I show in more detail Monunius’s staters minted in Dyrrachion, which were found in the meantime and mostly determined. I use staters known from literature, also those less well known, and two undescribed specimens from my own collection.

In literature different reverses are not taken into account, especially ethnic, the position of the letters and the position of the king’s title, and often different staters are classed in the same group (edition). I showed and described all the known obverses and reverses of King Monunius’s staters, which is the subject of this article. So far only some specimens have been mentioned, especially in our literature. I give fourteen variants of the Monunius stater.
