Result: In this process, we should develop the Internet in coordination with students' moral education and psychological literacy education, build an information-based teaching system, build an information-based management platform, improve teachers' professional ability and students' self-education ability. Schools should actively carry out demonstration activities of moral education. With the help of the Internet, the analysis of College Students' psychological health of moral education and the demonstration of moral education can not only enable college students to standardize their own behavior, but also rigorously enforce the school spirit and correct the bad atmosphere to a certain extent. Conclusions: The practice results have proved that there is an inseparable relationship between College Students' moral education and psychological health. 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LEARNING SPACE CONSTRUCTION OF UNIVERSITY LIBRARY BASED ON READERS' PSYCHOLOGICAL NEEDS

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Background: From the national reading survey in recent years, it will be found that the number of national books read in China has lagged far behind developed countries such as Europe and America, and the reading level has basically reached the average level.
