

Guidelines for writing and publishing a scientific paper

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Knowledge of scientific methodology and professional competences are basic prerequisites of successful writing and publishing of a scientific paper. In the workshop part all the article parts will be analyzed: summary, introduction, methods, results, discussion, and conclusion. The participants will be given theoretical and practical guidelines in successful forming of these parts. Since the goal of the researcher is to publish the paper in scientific journals, which are numerous in the field of biomedicine, the workshop will help the participants to acknowledge the skill of researching the journals and finding the best choice for their paper using information and communication technology².
