

EDITORIAL

Generally speaking, there is almost no bigger museum without its own paper, its professional scientific magazine, or at least a bulletin in which it briefly, with written words, leaves traces both of its aspirations and of the results of its activities.

By a combination of somehow strange circumstances and reasons (which would undoubtedly require a deeper analysis), Natural History museums of Croatia, during more than 150 years of their organized work, (there are museums in Zagreb, Dubrovnik, Split, Zadar, Rijeka etc.), did not have any professional journals. It is needless to prove how bad it was for the museology itself as well as for the development of natural sciences in Croatia.

EDITION OF A NEW PERIODICAL

Croatian Natural History Museum, which is the editor of this new periodical, is a relatively young institution grown up out of three independent Natural History museums. Croatian National zoological museum, Geological and paleontological museum and Mineralogical and petrographical museum were merged in 1986. The main purpose of the integration of three not so big, but quite famous museum institutions into one big museum was to create conditions for a better and more successful work - to create one relatively big national museum which, with its professional staff and with its adequate equipment, would be able to answer new challenges of time in this part of the world, as well as in the new

IZDAVAČ NOVOG ČASOPISA

Hrvatski prirodoslovni muzej, izdavač ovog časopisa, u organizacijskom pogledu mlada je ustanova nastala spajanjem triju samostojnih prirodoslovnih muzeja. Intergacija je provedena 1986. a u jedan veći muzej ujedinili su se dotadašnji Hrvatski narodni zoološki, Geološko-paleontološki i Mineraloško-petrografske muzej. Svrha takva stapanja triju nevelikih, ali dosta poznatih mujejskih ustanova, u jednu, bila je stvoriti uvjete za uspjšniji rad, oblikovati jedan relativno snažan nacionalni muzej koji će, stručnošću osoblja i primjerenošću opreme, biti kadar odgovoriti novijim izazovima vremena u ovome dijelu svijeta, u integracijskim procesima u koje se

integration processes in which Croatia, as a Centroeuropean and Mediterranean country, must become involved. And indeed, although in this moment lots of renovations are being made in this Museum (and they will last for two more years), it can firmly be said that - with its enriched collections, its more and more intensive professional and scientific analysis of older and newer materials and documents, with its field research, its successful saving and arranging of rich Natural History collections in Zagreb and in other parts of Croatia, its experts, its rich and valuable library, and with the development of new ways of public relations - Croatian Natural History Museum represents a respectable institution which will certainly very soon become an important link in the chain of similar institutions in this part of Europe.

While we are writing this introductory text, a shockingly cruel, destroying and conquering war in Croatia and in neighboring Bosnia and Herzegovina is still going on. So, why are we starting a new enterprise so optimistically? Where does all this self-confidence of ours come from? Both our optimism and self-confidence are founded in the bottom of our hearts, because we know that we are suffering a great injustice and that we are fighting against it. We also know that very soon the evil will be recognized, destroyed and vanished. Besides, only one superficial insight, not only into the richness and interestingness of *natura croatica*, of museum collections and museum staff, but also an insight into our past inspires and justifies all our big hopes! Our famous ancestors, famous

Hrvatska kao srednjoeuropska i mediteranska zemlja mora uključiti. I doista, iako je ovaj Muzej trenutačno u velikim zahvatima preuređenja, koji će potrajati još dvije godine, utemeljeno se može ustvrditi da već sada svojim obogaćenim zbirkama, svojom sve intenzivnijom stručnom i znanstvenom obradom starije i novije građe, terenskim istraživanjima, pothvatima u spašavanju i sređivanju bogatih prirodoslovnih zbirk u Zagrebu i u ostalim dijelovima Hrvatske, svojim kadrovima, vrijednom knjižnicom i razvijanjem novih oblika odnosa s javnošću, predstavlja respektabilnu ustanovu, koja će zacijelo, u dogledno vrijeme, biti važna karika u lancu sličnih ustanova u ovom dijelu Europe.

Dok ovaj uvodni tekst pišemo, još uvijek hara nečuveno okrutan razarački i osvajački rat u Hrvatskoj, u susjednoj nam Bosni i Hercegovini. Pa otkud optimizam kojim krećemo u novi pothvat, odakle samouvjerenost koju smo jasno iskazali u recima što ste ih netom pročitali? I optimizam i samouvjerenja sigurnost utemeljeni su u najdubljoj srži naših bića jer znamo da podnosimo nepravdu i da se protiv nje borimo, te da nije daleko dan kad će zlo biti prokazano i uklonjeno. K tome, već letimičan uviđaj ne samo u bogatstvo i zanimljivost *natura croatica*, muzejskih zbirk i kadrova, nego i pogled u prošlost budi i opravdava velike naše nade! Slavni naši pređi, čuveni prirodoslovci i muzealci, da spomenemo samo zoologa i paleomalakologa S. Brusinu (1845-1908), geologa i paleoantropologa D. Gorjanovića-Krambergera (1859-1936), mineraloge M. Kišpatića (1851-1926) i Lj. Barića (1902-1984), gotovo da jednako bijahu "kod kuće" u

naturalists and museum experts - and let us mention only a few of them: S. Brusina (1845-1908), zoologist and paleomalacologist; D. Gorjanović-Kramberger (1859-1936), geologist and paleoanthropologist; M. Kišpatić (1851-1926) and Lj. Barić (1902-1984), mineralogists - they all felt "at home" in Natural History museums of the world, or in their publications. But also - the other way round - naturalists, museum experts and other researchers from all over the world felt "at home" in Zagreb and in our museums. We do not want to deny successful co-operation which was undoubtedly present, but, as we do not want to paint everything black and white, we must also admit that in the last seventy years, even in that way, there have been lots of stagnation and backwardness. Still, we are witnesses of far-reaching changes in many parts of the world, and these changes are now present even in our small, but proud and interesting country - Croatia. We sincerely hope that a new chapter in our history has been started. We hope that nothing can stop new opening possibilities of work and co-operation.

This is something of which this new scientific magazine (both for naturalists and museum experts) would very much like to be an active participant.

program, something which would enable a better and easier orientation for our readers and co-operators.

First of all, the title itself - *Natura Croatica* - does not show only the country in which the magazine is published, the title also shows its program. That is to say that in this magazine we will publish the results of the many-sided Natural History research of Croatian nature. We will publish scientific works about all the Natural History branches present in our Museum's Departments (Botanical, Geological and Paleontological, Mineralogical and Petrographic, and Zoological). As a rule, we will publish the results of Natural History research which are interesting and important for the work of Natural History museums and for the work of Natural History museum experts. In other words, along with scientific and professional contributions which will come out as the results of studying museum objects, there will also be works about soil research, flora and fauna of Croatia, and which, in epistemological and methodological way, might help us solving different museological problems (collecting, analyzing, treatment, arranging and the exhibition of museum objects and collections). That is why in *Natura Croatica* there will also be works from the field of ecology, morphology, systematics, stratigraphy, crystalography, etc. It is also understandable that there will be no purely theoretical and speculative texts.

As a Natural History and museological magazine, *Natura Croatica* will also provide enough place for scientific contributions from the field of

Drugim riječima, uz znanstvene i stručne prinose koji će proizaći kao plod proučavanja muzejskih predmeta, tu će se naći radova koji spadaju u širi sklop proučavanja tla, flore i faune Hrvatske i koji u epistemologiskom i metodološkom smislu služe razriješavanju raznih pitanja muzejske djelatnosti (prikupljanje, obrada, uređivanje i izlaganje muzejskih predmeta i zbirk). Zato je opravdano što će se tu naći i radova iz ekologije, morfologije, sistematike, stratigrafije, kristalografske i sl. Razumljivo je međutim, da neće biti strogo teorijskih, čisto spekulativnih priloga. Kao prirodoslovni i muzejski časopis *Natura Croatica* važno mjesto dat će također stručnim i znanstvenim prinosima iz područja muzeologije, posebno rezultatima istraživanja novih putova i metoda uspješnije muzejske obrade, izlaganja predmeta, pohrane podataka, kao i kritičkim člancima o razvoju muzejskih prirodoslovnih struka i zbirk.

museology, and especially for the results of the research of new ways and methods of a more successful museological treatment, of object exhibiting, data deposit, as well as for the critical articles about the development of museological Natural History disciplines and collections.
