International Symposium on Art and Science in Life Potential Development 4th – 8th October 2023, Croatia

Twenty four years ago in Croatia, in the exclusive convention halls in the hotels Amphora and Palace, and in the beautiful interior of the Old Theatre (the oldest preserved public Theatre in Europe) in the city of Hvar on the island bearing the same name, one of the cradles of Renaissance cultural movement in this part of Mediterranean, the first International Symposium on "Arts and Science in Life Potential Development", was held from 23rd until 28th of May 1999.

As far as is known, it was the first conference of this kind in Croatia and worldwide, that gathered participants from various disciplines in the fields of art and sciences (Biomedicine, Humanist studies, Social Sciences, Anthropology, Education, Theology, Engineering and Technology, Visual and other arts - music, drama, dance...). Over 150 participants attended from all corners of the globe. The International symposium was organized by the Croatian Association of Psychosocial oncology in cooperation with the Faculty of Education and Rehabilitation Sciences University in Zagreb, University Clinic for Tumors in Zagreb, Croatian League Against Cancer, and Department of Music Therapy - Maryville University St. Louis, USA. The Symposium was held under the auspices of the Croatian Ministry of Science and Technology, Union International Against Cancer, Croatian League Against Cancer and was supported by the Open Society Institute in Croatia.

In the program of the first International Symposium, the term sophrology was considered as an innovative concept and a blend of Eastern and Western practices and philosophies, and as the complementary science of the new epoch which studies the human conscience, its modifications, and the means of varying it with a prophylactic, therapeutic and teaching aim. On that occasion, as well, a summary of the contents of the first World Congress of Sophrology was made, which was organized two years earlier in the *Centre de Rencontre Internationales* in the Principality of Monaco (from 8th – 11th March 1997) by the French Society of Sophrology, Japanese Society of Sophrology, Columbian Foundation for the Development of Sophrology in Bogota, and other institutions, under the auspices of the Princess Antoinette de Monaco.

Since then, the international symposium has been held ten times in various venues in Croatia, attended by numerous participants from various universities, clinics and professional associations from Croatia and abroad. These international gatherings were held every two to three years depending on the circumstances, and under the auspices of the Croatian Ministry of Science and Education, the Croatian Ministry of Health and Social Welfare, the Croatian League Against Cancer, Union Inter-

national Against Cancer, the European Consortium of Universities EcARTE, the University in Split, European Union of Sophrology, and also with the support of the President of the Republic of Croatia.

Verba volant scripta manent

An ancient Roman proverb says "Verba volant, scripta manent" (Spoken words fly away, written words remain). In this light, the works of many of authors which participated at these gatherings are appreciatively printed as symposium proceedings that were published in bilingual and / or trilingual editions- in Croatian, English and French. Some of these books are shown here in Figure 1.

In these papers, the authors presented the results of their research and other activities in various fields, for example: Existential Spiritual Approach in Supportive Therapy; Oriental Culture, Habits, Traditions and Cancer in India; Body-Image Assessment and Acoustic Analysis of Prosodic Features of Voice; The Pictorial Media in Art Therapy Workshops; From Psychopathological Expression to "Art Brut"; Education in Psycho-oncology; Short-term Art-psychotherapy, Sophrology and Stress Hormone Secretion in Breast Cancer Patients; Homo Symbolicus and Homo Religiosus; Terpsichore - Clinical Dance; Aesthetics in Existential Experience; Africa and Philosophy of Art, Music and Pain Management; Interdisciplinarity and Deontology; Growth Hormone Replacement Therapy in Patients With Cushing's Disease; Lifestyle and Gastric Cancer; Complementary Supportive Therapy in Pediatric Oncology; Sign Language and Deaf Culture; Creativity and Cosmic Responsibility of Man; Passion, Love & Eternity of Life etc. In these papers, Art and Science are presented on the same path in the discovering and support of life potential development. While on the one hand, the hierarchical relations in science are manifested in the development of traditional and new scientific disciplines, on the other hand the primeval and magic power of various arts constantly enters the metaphysical field of experience, as a form of life energy and self-realization of an individual.

3) Bioethics, Gastronomy, Tourism and Recreation

Hotel Management, Culture and Communication; Landscape and Gastronomy; Mission of the University Study at the Department of Tourism and Economy at the University in Split; Nutrition and Diet; Wine Varieties in Croatia with a Review on Gastronomic Delights and Health; Tourism and Recreation; Workshops; Performances.

Joy of Life and Existential Anxiety as "the Struggle of Living Being Against non-Being"; Eros, Culture and Psychoanalysis of Morality; Laugh and Life; Mission of the NATO Science for Peace and Security (SPS) Program; Fetish cult and Self-esteem; Quotes from The Qur'an, Music and Spiritual Messages; Sanctuaries, Pilgrimages and Well-being.
