
Introduction

In this issue, the thematic section of the journal *Rasprave: Časopis Instituta za hrvatski jezik i jezikoslovlje* is dedicated to papers that originated from presentations at the international scientific conference *LLOD approaches for language data research and management* (LLODREAM2022), which took place in Vilnius, Lithuania, on September 21 and 22, 2022. The conference was organized by the Institute of Humanities at Mykolas Romeris University as the host, with the Institute for the Croatian Language as a co-organizer, and it received financial support from the COST action CA18209, *European network for Web-centred linguistic data science* (NexusLinguarum). Approximately 90 experts in the fields of linguistics, computational linguistics, and natural language processing from nearly all European countries participated in the conference. The main topics of the conference were LLOD modeling, resources and interlinking, and their application in the fields of linguistics, humanities, and social sciences. However, some presentations also addressed topics related to translation studies and deep learning in language data processing.

A call for papers from the conference resulted in 15 submissions, of which only 6 were accepted for publication in this issue. This not only reflects the rigor of the peer-review process but also the high level of quality that *Rasprave* aims to maintain and enhance with each new issue.

We would like to express our gratitude to all the authors for their interest in publishing in the *Rasprave* journal, and especially to all the reviewers for their dedication and time invested in the review process.
