Our readers hold before them the supplement to the *Acta Clinica Croatica* journal, dedicated to the celebration of 100 years of Orthopedics education at the School of Medicine, University of Zagreb.

In 1917, the School of Medicine at the University of Zagreb was founded, and when the first students were in their fifth year of studies, the Department of Orthopedic Surgery was established, on December 15, 1922. From that date until today, Orthopedics has been an independent Department within the School of Medicine.

On December 14, 2022, a festive meeting was held in the Revival Hall of the National Home Palace of the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts in Zagreb to commemorate 100 years of orthopaedics education at the School of Medicine, University of Zagreb.
