

Introduction

In this issue, the thematic section of the journal *Rasprave: Časopis Instituta za hrvatski jezik i jezikoslovlje* is dedicated to papers that originated from presentations held at the international scientific conference *Terminology and Specialized Knowledge Representation: New Perspectives on User Needs* (TESK2022), which was held on 9–10 June 2022 in Rijeka, Croatia. The conference was organized by the Institute for the Croatian Language and the University of Rijeka, Faculty of Law, where the conference was held. The Croatian Science Foundation financially helped the conference within the installation research project the *Dynamism of Specialized Knowledge Categories* (DIKA).

Over 60 experts in the fields of terminology, terminography, computational linguistics, and natural language processing (NLP) from various European countries participated in the conference. The main topics of the conference were terminology work for non-specialists and the general public, changes in terminology work due to crisis, issues in linking general and specialized terminological resources, developing legal literacy, terminology and linguistic linked data, as well as traditional terminological topics, such as terminology and specialized translation and the role of terminology in LSP.
