In **Studies and Papers** we offer three scholarly papers († Fr. Petar Runje, "History of the Conventual Franciscans in Krk, part I" / Supplemented by Fr. Ljudevit Anton Maračić, OFM Conv. Prepared for print and edited by Tomislav Galović; Danijel Ciković, "Three contributions to the catalogue of Paolo Campsa's workshop"; Vedran Dukovski, "The bombardment of Pula during the First World War and the Austro-Hungarian naval air force in Pula").

In **Sources for the History of the Island of Krk**, we are presenting the paper by Željko Drinjak on "Collaboration between the municipalities of Taglio di Po and Omišalj in the 1992-1996 period".

In this volume, the Thematic Section contains Selected papers from the scholarly conference in the Third Order Franciscan Glagolite Monastery of St. Mary - "The Monastery of St. Mary at the Island's Head": Five and a Half Centuries of Spirituality, History, Culture and *Art on Krk (latter half of 15th century – 2018) / (part I),* held in Glavotok, 31 July and 1 August 2018. Joso Živković, "The library in the Monastery of St. Mary at Glavotok, Island of Krk (With appendix: Inventory of the Archive of the Monastery of St. Mary at Glavotok)"; Velimir Mikac, "Preventive conservation of book/archival materials from the library in the Monastery of St. Mary at Glavotok"; Branko Orbanić, "Traditional materials and techniques in the protection of cultural monuments". In this volume there are – unfortunately – three obituaries in the *In memoriam* pages, for Prof. Petrica Novosel-Žic, Ph.D. (1931-2021), Bernardin Modrić (1954-2021), and Drago Crnčević (1934-2022).
