

On the Occasion of the Hundredth Issue of the Journal *Contributions to the Research of Croatian Philosophical Heritage*

The publication of the hundredth issue of *Contributions to the Research of Croatian Philosophical Heritage* is an opportunity to remember the editors-in-chief who have led the journal from 1975, when it was launched, until today.

The founder and first editor-in-chief of *Contributions* was Vladimir Filipović (1906 – 1984), the director of the Institute of Philosophy. After his death in 1984, Franjo Zenko (1931 – 2017) was briefly editor for just one year. Erna Banić-Pajnić was the editor-in-chief from 1985 to 1987, Damir Barbarić from 1988 to 1990, Ljerka Schiffler (1941 – 2016) from 1991 to 2012, Ivica Martinović from 2013 to 2020, and Ivana Skuhala Karasman has been the editor-in-chief since 2021. All editors-in-chief of *Contributions to the Research of Croatian Philosophical Heritage* were scientists employed at the Institute of Philosophy. Of the seven editors-in-chief, three were women, with Ljerka Schiffler being the longest-serving editor-in-chief of *Contributions*.

The editors-in-chief have ensured the quality of published articles, and thanks to their engagement, the journal regularly published reviews of recent books and journals related to Croatian philosophers, history, and literature. In addition to editing *Contributions*, the editors-in-chief significantly contributed to the study of Croatian philosophy and Croatian philosophers through the publication of their own texts (articles, reviews, obituaries, prefaces, materials). Their texts were the result of their research and an indicator of their philosophical interests.

It is important to mention that since 1975, *Contributions* has been published continuously, regardless of changes in funding, regimes, and war years. It is particularly encouraging that young scientists also publish in this long-standing journal, thus allowing *Contributions* to gain new collaborators with fresh perspectives on Croatian philosophy.

I thank all the editors-in-chief who have invested their knowledge, time, and effort in editing this journal, thereby contributing to the longevity and recognition of *Contributions to the Research of Croatian Philosophical Heritage*.
