

Black Holes and Wormholes: Speculative Scenarios of University's City Spaces

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The thesis starts from the premise that the University of Rijeka campus has been fully completed, along with ongoing major urban projects. By imagining Rijeka's near future as outlined in national, regional and local strategic documents, a conceptual framework of Rijeka 2030 is created, onto which the University expands through its own long-term strategic plans. Its slogan "Open University of the Future" is taken at face value and embraced as an ethos that the thesis seeks to wholeheartedly embody.

The work explores scenarios for reclaiming existing university buildings as imagined components of future public infrastructure, aiming both to maintain and unfold the latent relationships between the city and the University, seeking to establish urban experience as a key element in academic life. It examines emerging strategies, programs and uses through which the University could reshape its urban presence and deepen its "anchoring" within the community. To this end, the thesis reevaluates three case studies: the Faculty of Maritime Studies, the Faculty of Medicine and the IVEX building, which houses the Urban Studies program. The project therefore proposes varied approaches to reusing the University's residual building inventory.

The intended outcome is a departure from current efforts to relocate all University activity outside the city center. While acknowledging the benefits of the territorial consolidation of the campus, the thesis advocates anticipatory planning of the soon-to-be vacant spaces, focusing on the unconventional intersection of non-profit and profit-oriented programs, socio-spatial inclusion of non-traditional users and academic spaces as intergenerational commons. These interventions aim to cultivate a resilient, socially engaged and open academia as advocated by the University.

In conclusion, the thesis calls for a reconsideration of the campus model as the default urban planning paradigm for the University of Rijeka.




Rijeka City Development Plan 2021 - 2027




Ecosystem 2: university environment



Flows of communication, knowledge and movement




Ecosystem 2: innovation environment



Strategic policy of the University of Rijeka 2021 - 2025




Rijeka's official urban vision for 2030 positions the University of Rijeka as a key catalyst in the city's transformation into a hub of smart, digital, green, and creative industries. The University's Strategic policy in turn asserts autonomy, integrity, and radical openness - anchoring its mission in innovation, sustainability, and education aligned with a shifting labor market.

The transplantation of faculties to a centralized campus unlocks a network of university buildings in the city center. These urban sites could become extensions of the campus - semi-autonomous territories where unexpected connections spark and strategic partnerships emerge with the actors in the city's evolving innovation ecosystem.



Contemporary education demands connectedness - spatial centralisation enables synergies between faculties, centers, departments, administration, students and staff. University buildings scattered across the city have become **BLACK HOLES** - closed, disconnected and unfit. Chaotic and inefficient but colorful and generative, they emerged through gradual territorial annexation - *the campus was the city*.


Rujevica, the historical center, and the University campus form a polycentric triangle of planned urban hubs. With faculties relocating to the campus, the city center is left impoverished - *the city needs the campus more than the campus needs the city*. Preservation, labor and inclusivity are the Speculations questioning the University's place in the urban fabric.



A HERO'S JOURNEY: THE CAMPUS ANCHORS ITSELF IN THE CITY RECLAIMED.


THE CAMPUS PARADIGM IS SUBVERTED THROUGH THREE PROPOSED INTERVENTIONS IN THE LEFTOVER AREAS: **CAMPUS CONFETTI I, II, III** ACT AS SHORTCUTS BETWEEN THE INSTITUTION AND ITS DIVERSE CAST OF STAKEHOLDERS.

THESE ARE SPECULATIVE ENTITIES OF A UNIVERSITY EMBEDDED IN THE URBANE - OCCUPYING FORMER FACULTY BUILDINGS THAT ONCE WERE A WINE PRODUCTION FACILITY, A TRADE SCHOOL AND AN ASYLUM.



Existing buildings are reimagined through collaborative frameworks between stakeholders. Hybrid renovation models reconcile market interests with non-profit needs, anchoring the institution in the community. Contents spark programs, activities, knowledge transfers - enabling *unexpected relations between the University and the city*.

A *network* links the sites to transit corridors, tourists to researchers. A *threshold* opens academic spaces to previously excluded social groups. A *platform* facilitates new modes of knowledge transmission. These **WOUNDS** are spatial structures that articulate overlooked socio-spatial phenomena.




A) THINKING BELT

B) TOWN & GOWN


