ENTERTAINMENT AND LEISURE IN THE GOLDEN AGE OF DUBROVNIK

Summary

In the second half of the 20th century, historiography began to move away from political and event-based history, thanks to the work of scholars gathered around the Annales journal. Interdisciplinary research and new methodological approaches enabled the popularization of the history of everyday life, which became a key element of contemporary historiographical perspectives. An example of this is the study of leisure and entertainment in the Republic of Dubrovnik during the Humanism and Renaissance periods, focusing on aspects of nightlife, games, and drunkenness. Although the image of everyday life in Dubrovnik from that era is incomplete due to a lack of sources, it is possible to reconstruct fragments of the social activities of the time.
