

5th Advent Symposium Restorative and Regenerative Procedures in Dental Medicine

The 5th Advent Symposium *Restorative and Regenerative Procedures in Dental Medicine* was held on Thursday, 4 December 2025, at the Library of the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts (HAZU). The event was organized by the School of Dental Medicine, University of Zagreb, the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts – Division of Medical Sciences, Committee for Orofacial Diseases and the Croatian Society for Restorative Dental Medicine of the Croatian Medical Association, under the leadership of Professor Zrinka Tarle, Head of the Committee for Orofacial Diseases and the Croatian Society for Restorative Dental Medicine. The Symposium gathered **120 participants** and featured distinguished experts from Switzerland, Slovenia, and Croatia, who presented the latest insights, techniques, scientific and clinical approaches in restorative and regenerative dental medicine. The scientific program included the following lectures:

- **Assoc. Prof. Marko Granić, PhD:** *Regenerative Procedures in Oral Surgery*

Lecturers addressed a broad range of topics from restorative dental medicine, endodontics, prosthodontics, and oral surgery. Through lively discussions, the speakers emphasized the need for new guidelines that support biological and minimally invasive principles across all fields of dental medicine.
