(The Croatian Academy of America, New York, USA; Association for Croatian Studies, Cambridge, Massachusetts, USA), Professor Dr. Arne Marjan Mavčič (European Faculty of Law, Nova Univerza, Nova Gorica, Slovenia), and Professor Dr. Sanja Zubčić (Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, University of Rijeka).

In the 78th volume of the *Krčki zbornik*, valuable and interesting discussions, articles, and other contributions are presented, organized into several permanent or occasional sections.

In the **Studies and Papers** section, we present three scholarly articles: † Fr. Petar Runje, *History of the Conventual Franciscans in Krk*, Part III / supplemented by Fr. Ljudevit Anton Maračić, OFM Conv., prepared for print and edited by Tomislav Galović; Anton Božanić, *The Parish Church of the Holy Trinity in Baška: On the Occasion of the 300th Anniversary of the Beginning of Construction*; and Sanja Todorović – Željko Bartulović, *History of the Administration of the Municipality of Vrbnik (1913–1921)*.

In **Sources for the History of the Island of Krk**, we publish the work of Julijano Sokolić *Čo Krčani, čemo će!?* (Krk natives – what do we want?) – a call for Krk residents to subscribe to the newspaper *Otočki vjesnik* (Island Messenger).

In this volume, the **Thematic Section** contains **Selected papers from the scholarly conference in the Third Order Franciscan Glagolitic Monastery of St. Mary - “The Monastery of St. Mary at the Island’s Head”: Five and a Half Centuries of Spirituality, History, Culture and**

*Art on Krk (latter half of 15<sup>th</sup> century – 2018) / (part II)*, held in Glavotok, 31 July and 1 August 2018.
