GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION:

We invite abstracts in a single paragraph, without indentation, that summarizes the key points of the manuscript in 150 to 250 words.

The text should be in English, American or British usage is accepted, but not a mixture of both.

Please provide 3–5 keywords that reflect your study. Use APA style (latest edition).

Panel proposals should include:

- Panel Session title,
- brief summary of the session contents,
- Topic area (choose one from the topics of the conference or select a new topic within the main theme of the conference),
- The List of Panelists and Moderator with their affiliations,
- Panel Presentation Mode (In-Person or Virtual)
- List of abstract titles

Submitted abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee. All submissions should report original and previously unpublished research results no matter the type of research paper you are presenting. Manuscripts should meet the format set by the Conference committee and are subject to review. Detailed instructions and full paper submission guidelines will be emailed within a few weeks following the conference.
