MICROLEPIDOPTERA OF CROATIA. GELECHIOIDEA PART 1: AUTOSTICHIDAE, LECITHOCERIDAE, LYPUSIDAE, DEPRESSARIIDAE, PELEOPODIDAE, PTEROLONCHIDAE, ELACHISTIDAE, SCYTHRIDIDAE, BLASTOBASIDAE, AND MOMPHIDAE

Part one of the first comprehensive species list of the superfamily Gelechioidea in Croatia is presented. This list includes 10 families: Autostichidae, Lecithoceridae, Lypusidae, Depressariidae, Peleopodidae, Pterolonchidae, Elachistidae, Scythrididae, Blastobasidae and Momphidae. The compilation is based on a review of available published records, supplemented with data from accessible museum collections and the authors' own field surveys, which have been conducted intermittently since the 1970s.

In total, 258 species from the above families have been documented in Croatia. Of these, 41 species are reported for the first time and are considered new to the country's fauna. As no checklist of Microlepidoptera for Croatia has previously existed, this study makes a significant contribution to the fauna of these families and to the overall knowledge of the Croatian micromoth fauna.

Ovaj prilog predstavlja prvi dio popisa vrsta iz natporodice Gelechioidea za Hrvatsku. Popis uključuje vrste iz sljedećih 10 porodica: Autostichidae, Lecithoceridae, Lypusidae, Depressariidae, Peleopodidae, Pterolonchidae, Elachistidae, Scythrididae, Blastobasidae i Momphidae. Popis odražava pregled objavljenih nalaza za Hrvatsku i dodatne nalaze iz dostupnih muzejskih zbirki, kao i materijala prikupljenog tijekom terenskih istraživanja autora, a koja su provedena u nepravilnim razmacima od 1970-tih.

Ukupno je utvrđeno 258 vrsta iz gore navedenih porodica. Analiza prikupljenog materijala pokazuje da 41 zabilježena vrsta nije bila prethodno utvrđena u Hrvatskoj te se smatraju novima za njenu faunu. S obzirom na to da ne postoji checklista Mikrolepidoptera za Hrvatsku, ovime je dan velik doprinos poznavanju faune spomenutih porodica, kao i ukupne hrvatske faune Mikrolepidoptera.

INTRODUCTION

The Gelechioidea represent one of the most species-rich yet least-studied superfamilies of Lepidoptera (HEIKKILÄ *et al.*, 2014). Over 18,400 species have been described worldwide, many of which are considered economically significant due to their impact on human production and livelihood (WANG & LI, 2020). According to LEPIFORUM (2025), 2,838 species of Gelechioidea are currently recorded in Europe, with additional species described or added to the European fauna each year. Given the high diversity of this superfamily, our species list is divided into two parts. The first part covers ten families: Autostichidae, Lecithoceridae, Lypusidae, Depressariidae, Peleopodidae, Pterolonchidae, Elachistidae, Scythrididae, Blastobasidae and Momphidae.

Gelechioidea comprises mostly small or very small moth species. Their wings are usually drab in coloration, and accurate identification often requires genitalia dissection or DNA barcode-based methods (HEIKKILÄ *et al.* 2014). As noted by HEIKKILÄ *et al.* (2014), members of this superfamily exhibit highly diverse life-history strategies, including herbivory (e.g., borers and miners), saprophagy, fungivory, and scavenging. Remarkably, some Gelechioidea are predatory (POWELL *et al.*, 1998) or have adapted to an aquatic lifestyle (RUBINOFF & SCHMITZ, 2010). Many species are considered serious pests, such as the Tomato Leafminer (*Tuta absoluta* (Meyrick, 1917) on tomatoes, Potato Tuber Moth (*Phthorimaea operculella* (Zeller, 1873)) on potatoes, Angoumois Grain Moth (*Sitotroga cerealella* (Olivier, 1789)) on stored cereal grains, Pink Bollworm (*Pectinophora gossypiella* (Saunders, 1844)) on cotton, and Peach Twig Borer (*Anarsia lineatella* Zeller, 1839) on stone fruit trees (GREGERSEN & KARSHOLT, 2022; HUEMER & KARSHOLT, 2010; LOPEZ-VAAMONDE *et al.*, 2010). According to LOPEZ-VAAMONDE *et al.* (2010), 97 non-native Lepidoptera species have been established in European fauna, of which six belong to the family Gelechiidae and five to the family Blastobasidae.

According to WANG & LI (2020), resolving the relationships among families or subfamilies within Gelechioidea has proven exceptionally challenging when using morphological or single-gene analyses. Although multiple gene datasets have been used in recent molecular phylogenetic studies, the relationships within the superfamily remain contentious, largely because of limited taxon sampling relative to its immense species

diversity. Their findings, when combined with comparative morphological studies, strongly support the clade of Gelechioidea and separate it from other superfamilies, further confirming its monophyly. VAN NIEUKERKEN *et al.* (2022) reported that the use of the family-group name Gelechioidea Stainton, 1854 at the superfamily level is threatened by three senior family-group names established by BRUAND, 1850 [1851]. They recommended conserving the name Gelechioidea, as a strict application of the Principle of Priority would cause considerable confusion, given its near-universal usage for this highly diverse and economically important group of Lepidoptera.

Although Lepidoptera in Croatia have been studied for over two centuries, microlepidopteran families have remained only partially investigated. Historical records rarely focused on a specific family but rather provided lists of species from various families covering different regions of Croatia or combined with regions outside Croatia (e.g., MANN 1857, 1867, 1869; WOCKE 1871; ABAFI-AIGNER *et al.* 1896; GALVAGNI 1909; REBEL 1910, 1914, 1917, 1919; SCHAWERDA 1920, 1921; KOČA 1925; KLIMESCH 1942, etc.). Most recent publications have primarily dealt with butterflies and other Macrolepidoptera, while micromoths have not been thoroughly studied or published (e.g., BALDIZZONE 2019; GAEDIKE & BALDIZZONE, 2008; GOMBOC & SULE 2022; GOMBOC *et al.* 2023, 2024; HABELER 2008; KARSHOLT *et al.* 2023; ŠUMPICH 2013; TREMATERRA & BALDIZZONE 2004). Consequently, no comprehensive species list of Croatian Microlepidoptera has been published to date.

In 2020, the first comprehensive attempt to compile a list of all Microlepidoptera families occurring in Croatia was undertaken. During the preparation of her doctoral thesis, Gumhalter summarized all available data from historical publications and recent studies on micromoths reported in the country (GUMHALTER 2020). This preliminary list includes approximately 2,000 microlepidopteran species. However, as the list relied mainly on the literature, especially historic documents, possible species misidentifications from the past remained to be verified by specialists for each group. Owing to the time-intensive nature of this process, the list was not published immediately. Since then, only a few partial checklists based on this compilation have been published to date. In 2019, the first checklist covering Pyralidae and Crambidae in Croatia was published (GUMHALTER 2019a, 2019b). Subsequently, in 2023, a checklist of Micropterigidae, Eriocraniidae, Hepialidae, Nepticulidae, Opostegidae, Heliozelidae, Adelidae, Prodoxidae, Incurvariidae, Tischeriidae, Alucitidae, and Pterophoridae was published (GUMHALTER *et al.* 2023). Recently, a checklist of Tortricidae from Croatia has been published (GUMHALTER *et al.* 2024).

Information on the occurrence and distribution of these families is scattered across various museum collections and publications spanning a long period. This study provides a synthesis of available published records, supplemented with data from accessible museum collections and our own field surveys. We aim to make these records of the occurrence of species in Croatia accessible and to stimulate further interest in these micromoth families. We hope to encourage future research on this group and the compilation of checklists for other Microlepidoptera families in Croatia. Future efforts should focus on verifying species reported in historical literature and examining museum collections containing material from Croatia. As is often the case with historical data, not every record presented in this study could be verified by voucher specimens, and some species may have been misidentified. We welcome further contributions to clarify these uncertainties, correct errors, and expand the available knowledge.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

Our species list integrates data from a wide range of sources, including historical and recent literature, selected museum collections, and the results of our field surveys. In total, more than 300 literature sources were reviewed to compile the first comprehensive list of Gelechioidea species reported from Croatia to date. Records posted on Lepiforum until June 2025 were also considered.

Fieldwork has been conducted in various Croatian regions since the early 1970s. Specimens were either observed or collected at night using UV light or during the day using a sweep net. The collected material is deposited in the private research collections of the respective authors. In some cases, the collected material was deposited in museums. The material collected by the second and fourth authors was deposited in the private collection of the second author (Coll. Berggren) or deposited in the Natural History Museum, University of Oslo (NHMO). The material collected by the eighth author was deposited in the Natural Museum in Prague (NMPC).

The species list also includes data from accessible museum collections. The Lepidoptera sub-collection from the NMPC includes approximately one million preserved specimens stored in approximately seven thousand boxes. In addition to valuable fauna material (primarily species that are extinct in their traditional locations), the Lepidoptera sub-collection contains several hundred type specimens from almost all groups of insects. The processing of voluminous type material relating to *Zygaena*, described by Otto Holik in the mid-20th century, and several dozen species of moths collected by Kristián Krušek, should be mentioned as being particularly valuable.

The HNHM, with 1.7 million specimens, preserves significant material from every continent. It not only documents the achievements of Hungarian science related to butterflies, the diversity of the butterfly world on Earth, and its changes, but also serves as a basis and source of inspiration for the most modern nanotechnology, ecology, nature conservation, and biodiversity research related to butterflies in Hungary.

The identifications were carried out using relevant taxonomic literature, the authors' long-term expertise in recognizing well-distinguishable species in the field, examination of male and female genitalia, and DNA barcoding for genetic confirmation where available. Publicly accessible barcodes are available in the open dataset hosted by the Barcode of Life Data Systems (BOLD; RATNASINGHAM & HEBERT, 2007).

For several decades, the classification of the taxa mentioned above has largely followed Karsholt & Razowski (1996). More recently, a comprehensive systematic study proposed an updated and more refined classification of Gelechioidea (YAPAR *et al.*, 2026), which we adopted in this study. Within each genus, species are arranged according to the system used by LEPIFORUM (2025).

For each species, the following information was provided: scientific name, author, year of publication, and a list of available records organized by year of publication. Synonyms are listed with references to the corresponding publications for species previously described under different names. For species recorded during field surveys, additional information is included: date and locality of collection, collector's name, remarks indicating whether the specimen was barcoded or dissected, and, where available, data on altitude and geographic coordinates in the WGS84 coordinate system. For some records, the name of the county is also

provided (e.g., Lika-Senj = Lika–Senj County). The following abbreviations are used for specimens housed in museum collections:

RESULTS

A total of 258 species have been recorded in Croatia. The family Autostichidae is represented by 19 species, Lecithoceridae by two, Lypusidae by eight, Depressariidae by 85, Peleopodidae by three, Pterolonchidae by two, Elachistidae by 89, Scythrididae by 38, Blastobasidae by five, and Momphidae by seven. Of these, 41 species are reported from Croatia for the first time and are considered to be new additions to its fauna. A complete list of all the registered species is provided in Tab. 1.

The species *Depressaria veneficella* Zeller, 1847 was mentioned by BUCHNER & CORLEY (2014), but this record requires confirmation. Although we have listed it, it is possible that it

was previously misidentified.

The species *Elachista disemiella* Zeller, 1847 has been mentioned several times in the literature (MANN 1867, 1869; WOCKE 1871; ABAFI-AIGNER *et al.* 1896; STANTON 1921), but this record requires confirmation.

One species, *Xenopathia novaki* (Rebel, 1891), is listed as “Gelechioidea unplaced.” Although it was previously placed in the family Blastobasidae, recent studies have shown that it does not belong to this family and, consequently, is not listed in the current Blastobasidae of the World catalogue (SINEV 2014). The species was recorded on Šolta Island (Maslinica, Šipova, 23.VIII.2025, leg. S. Gomboc, N. Kirichenko, det. O. Karsholt) and was previously mentioned in the work of Rebel (1891) and ŠUMPICH & SKYVA (2012).

Several species were not included in this list.

Although there is plenty of historical data on *Oegoconia quadripuncta* (Haworth, 1828) from the family Autostichiidae, it was excluded from the list (MANN 1857, 1869; WOCKE 1871; ABAFI-AIGNER *et al.* 1896; REBEL 1904, 1914, 1919; SCHAWERDA 1921; STANTON 1921; PROHASKA 1922; KOČA 1925; KLIMESCH 1942; DANIEL *et al.* 1951; NEUSTETTER, 1956). This species occurs in Western Europe, extending eastward into Germany. Since correct identification is only possible by studying the genitals, it was probably misidentified in the past.

The species *Aprominta bifasciata* (Staudinger, 1870) was only mentioned by REBEL (1919), so it was possibly misidentified in the past.

The same applies to *Pantacordis pallida* (Staudinger, 1876), which was only mentioned twice (REBEL, 1917; SCHAWERDA 1921) and was probably misidentified by the authors. The same applies to *Aгноea subochreella* (Doubleday, 1859), which was previously mentioned by SCHAWERDA (1916, 1920) and KOČA (1925). The identification of *Aгноea* species is only possible by studying the genitalia.

According to BUCHNER & CORLEY (2024), *Agonopterix aspersella* (Constant, 1888) occurs only in the west and is probably misidentified. This was mentioned by GALVAGNI (1902) and ABAFI-AIGNER (1903). The same applies to *A. umbellana* (Fabricius, 1794), which was previously mentioned only by CARNELUTTI (1994).

Throughout our research, several notable species have been recorded, including *Depressaria hansjoachimi* Buchner & Corley, 2024; *Carcina ingridmariae* Huemer, 2025; *Elachista dalmatiensis* Traugott-Olsen, 1992; *E. dimorphella* Kaila & Tokár, 2026; *E. platamodes* Kaila, 2018; *E. amseli* (Rebel, 1933); *E. grotenfelti* Kaila, 2012; *E. atricomella* Stainton, 1849; *Scythris albostrigata* Hannemann, 1961; *S. richteri* Bengtsson, 2013 and *Blastobasis glandulella* (Riley, 1871). The latter, an original North American species, was already known from Croatia under the junior synonym *B. huemeri* (KOREN & GOMBOC 2017). According to ŠUMPICH (2010), this species was originally described from southern Europe (Croatia and northern Italy) and was subsequently reported from Hungary, Austria, and the Czech Republic. According to LANDRY *et al.* (2013: 26), *B. glandulella* was originally described as *Gelechia glandulella* in 1871 in Missouri, USA, by Zeller. Since then, the species has spread from North America to Croatia and continues to spread as an invasive species throughout Southern Europe. It is now widespread across Europe and often occurs in high numbers. The earliest record from Croatia originates from Krk Island in 1986, 1987, and 1989.

BUCHNER & CORLEY (2025) treated *Agonopterix adpersella* (Kollar 1832) and *A. thapsiella* (Zeller 1847) as separate species. Because they cannot be separated from each other externally,

nor by genitalia or DNA barcoding, we have interpreted our series from the *A. adspersella/thapsiella* complex as belonging to *A. adspersella*.

A large series of 50 paratypes of *Depressaria hansjoachimi* was collected from Greece, Crete, Croatia, Armenia, and the Asian part of Turkey (Ankara). This species has a wide distribution, ranging from Croatia (Dubrovnik and Pirovac) throughout Greece (numerous localities) and Crete (Omalos and Ida-Andron). According to BUCHNER & CORLEY (2025), the holotype originates from Greece (Evritania, Karpenision, 1850 m), one paratype from Ankara in Turkey, and several specimens were collected in Armenia ([https://lepiforum.org/wiki/author/Buchner%20%26%20Corley%20\(2025%3A%20346\)](https://lepiforum.org/wiki/author/Buchner%20%26%20Corley%20(2025%3A%20346)))

Carcina ingridmariae was recently described based on specimens from Crete, with paratypes from Croatia, southern Greece, Northern Cyprus, and the western part of Asian Turkey (LEPIFORUM, 2025). According to the data in BOLD, this species also occurs in Lebanon, suggesting a wider distribution across the eastern Mediterranean. This new species cannot be externally distinguished from *C. quercana* with certainty. The genital structures of both species differed significantly.

KAILA (2015) reports *Elachista dalmatiensis* from Bulgaria, Croatia, Greece, and Turkey, noting that "Traugott-Olsen's (1992) records from Austria require verification." Kaila examined the holotype and provided the following information: "Holotype male labelled: Type [rounded with red margin]; Dalmatien [Croatia] Umg. Dubrovnik 19.–23.9.1970 leg. M. u. W. Glaser; Genital praeparat nr. C. 24.11.86 sex male E. Traugott-Olsen; Akvarel 30.11.86 E. Traugott-Olsen; *E. dalmatiensis* sp. n. det. E. Traugott-Olsen (ZMUC)."

Elachista dimorphella is currently known from a small number of localities near the Adriatic Sea: Italy – Region of Veneto, Caorle, Slovenia – Petrinjski kras, Brestovica, Croatia – Istria, Pula, Rovinj; Dalmatia, Bilišane, Zadar County; Zaton Obrovački, Zaoštrog (KAILA & TOKÁR, 2026). It has been recorded from near sea level to approximately 450 m (Petrinjski kras). The specific name *dimorphella* is derived from the striking difference in external appearance between males and females. Eleven specimens of this new species were successfully sequenced. Additional data are accessible via the public dataset DS-ELADIM New dimorphic *Elachista* species (https://bench.boldsystems.org/index.php/MAS_Management_DataConsole?codes=DS-ELADIM).

According to KAILA & NUPPONEN (2018), the only known specimen, which is also the holotype, is described as follows: "Holotype male: Croatia, Biokovo Mts., Vošac, 1370 m, 27. vi. 2006, Z. Tokár leg. (L. Kaila prep. 5593, DNA sample 22163 Lepid. Phyl; Coll. Tokár)." ([https://lepiforum.org/wiki/author/Kaila%20%26%20Nupponen%20\(2018\)](https://lepiforum.org/wiki/author/Kaila%20%26%20Nupponen%20(2018)))

GAEDIKE (1975) treated *E. amseli* as a valid species, designated the lectotype, and illustrated the male genitalia. KAILA (1999: 164) subsequently listed *E. amseli* as a synonym of *E. atrisquamosa*. However, in 2019, he listed the species in his annotated catalogue of Elachistinae of the World.

KAILA & MUTANEN (2012) demonstrated that the taxon *E. nuraghella* sensu auct. exhibits a marked division of haplotype groups in the DNA barcode sequence: one widely distributed in the western Mediterranean region and the other in the eastern Mediterranean (Bulgaria, Greece, and Turkey). These haplotypes correspond to consistent differences in both male and female genitalia and, in general, in external morphology. *E. nuraghella* Amsel is therefore considered to consist of two species with a vicariant distribution pattern, with the eastern

taxon described as *E. grotenfelti*. ([https://lepiforum.org/wiki/author/Kaila%20%26%20Mutanen%20\(2012\)](https://lepiforum.org/wiki/author/Kaila%20%26%20Mutanen%20(2012)))

E. atricomella was previously reported in Croatia by HABELER (2003). However, KAILA (2019) stated that it was not present in the country at that time. In the same year, we collected three specimens and performed DNA barcoding, which confirmed the correct identification of *E. atricomella* in this study (Fig. 71).

HECKFORD & BEAVAN (2021) reported the caterpillar occurrence of *Scythris albostrata* from Croatia ([https://lepiforum.org/wiki/author/Heckford%20%26%20Beavan%20\(2021\)](https://lepiforum.org/wiki/author/Heckford%20%26%20Beavan%20(2021))). It was found feeding on the leaves of *Petrorhagia saxifraga* L., a previously unknown foodplant of any species of *Scythris*.

BENGTSOON (2013) stated: "*S. richteri* sp.n. is named after Ignác Richter, the collector of the holotype and of some paratypes". He further provided the following information: "Holotype: male; CROATIA, South Velebit, 26.8.2011, Lgt. Ignác Richter (white label); Gen. prep. no 1978X, *S. richteri*, B Å Bengtsson (yellow label); HOLOTYPUS *S. richteri* male BENGTSOON (red label). In coll. ZMUC [Copenhagen]." All 16 paratypes (all males) originate from South Velebit and are deposited in ZMUC (Copenhagen), the collection of Ignác Richter, and the private collection of B.Å. Bengtsson (coll. BÅB). The type locality is situated at 1.200 m elevation in South Velebit, Croatia. The species closely resembles *S. taygeticola* Scholtz, 1997, and *S. hornigii* (Zeller, 1855). (https://lepiforum.org/wiki/page/Scythris_taygeticola" taygeticola, https://lepiforum.org/wiki/page/Scythris_hornigii" hornigii)

DISCUSSION

According to Lepiforum, the family Autostichidae is currently represented by 242 species in Europe. However, this number may increase as ongoing studies continue to reveal previously unknown or cryptic species. A total of 19 species have been recorded in Croatia.

The family Lecithoceridae remains poorly understood, despite being a highly diverse group with numerous species described worldwide, particularly in the Old World tropics. According to LEPIFORUM (2025), only 11 species have been recorded in Europe, and only two in Croatia.

Lypusidae was long considered to be part of the tineoid group. However, HEIKKILÄ & KAILA (2009) demonstrated that the genus *Lypusa* Zeller, 1852, belongs to Gelechioidea. In a close scrutiny of its systematic affinities, they placed it in its own family, *Lypusidae*, which was studied using extensive data from larval, pupal, and adult morphology, as well as certain behavioral traits. The three genera *Lypusa* Zeller, 1852, *Agnoea* Walsingham, 1907 (syn. *Pseudatemelia* Rebel, 1910), and *Amphisbatis* Zeller, 1870, historically assigned to the conglomerate family Oecophoridae, were transferred to Lypusidae by HEIKKILÄ & KAILA (2009). Later, HEIKKILÄ et al. (2014) transferred *Diurnea* Haworth, 1811, and *Dasystoma* Curtis, 1833 from Chimabacchidae to Lypusidae as the subfamily Chimabachinae. Currently, only 30 species are recorded in the European fauna (LEPIFORUM, 2025) and eight in Croatian fauna. However, additional species of this family are expected to occur in Croatia.

In 2014, the family Depressariidae was redefined in a broader sense (HEIKKILÄ et al., 2014), encompassing approximately 2,300 species from the subfamilies Acriinae, Aeolanthinae, Cryptolechiinae, Depressariinae, Hypercalliinae, Hypertrophinae, Peleopodinae, Oditinae, Stenomatinae, as well as a diversity of predominantly New World

taxa previously excluded from Lypusidae but left without family assignment (BUCHNER & KARSHOLT, 2019). This classification was followed in the present study. In recent years, interest in European Depressariidae has increased considerably, leading to the identification of many new species and the critical revision of several species' groups (BUCHNER, 2017a, 2017b, 2020a, 2020b; BUCHNER *et al.*, 2017; BUCHNER & CORLEY, 2019, 2025; BUCHNER & ŠUMPICH, 2020). According to LEPIFORUM (2025), 210 species have been recorded in Europe, of which 85 are found in Croatia. For some of these species, the type locality is also in Croatia. Although this family has been relatively well studied in Croatia, additional species are still expected. Peleopodidae (elevated from subfamily status within Depressariidae by WANG & LI (2020)) and Pterolonchidae are species-poor families with only a few described species worldwide. In Europe, Peleopodidae is represented by three species, all of which are found in Croatia. Pterolonchidae comprises eight species (LEPIFORUM 2025), of which two have been recorded in Croatia.

Elachistidae was first established as a family by BRUAND (1859), and since the independent works of BUSCK (1909) and WALSINGHAM (1909), it has been restricted to the large genus *Elachista* Treitschke, 1833, along with a few smaller related genera. In 1916, Mosher assigned the family to Gelechioidea based on pupal characteristics, a placement that is now universally accepted. YAPAR *et al.* (2026) suggest that Elachistidae is not monophyletic and transfer Cacothroinae (Depressariidae), Ethmiinae stat. nov. and genera *Pupulanella* and *Tonica* to Elachistidae sensu nov. Also, Stenomatinae was recovered as sister to the rest of Gelechioidea, away from other Depressariidae, and was raised to Stenomatidae stat. nov. to restore the monophyly of the core Depressariidae. As a result of the revisions listed above, the extent of Depressariidae has now changed and includes the subfamilies Depressariinae (without *Pupulanella* and *Tonica*), Aeolanthinae, Hypercalliinae and Hypertrophinae. Altogether 89 species occur in Croatia. A considerable amount of undetermined material is housed in museums and private collections; in particular, the Baldizzone and Gomboc collections contain several hundred unidentified specimens collected on the island of Krk and in other regions across the country.

Moths of the family Scythrididae are generally small and often cryptic in appearance. They are distributed throughout most regions of the world (BENGTTSSON, 2014) and comprise 669 species (NIEUKERKEN *et al.*, 2011), the majority of which belong to the genus *Scythris* Hübner, [1825]. The European fauna of this family has been comparatively well studied (BENGTTSSON, 2013), with 217 species reported to date (LEPIFORUM, 2025). However, systematic research focused on Scythrididae has been conducted only in restricted areas, even in Europe (NUPPONEN & SAVENKOV, 2019), including Croatia, where only 38 species are currently known. Hundreds of undescribed species housed in museums worldwide await formal description (BENGTTSSON, 2024), particularly in North America.

Blastobasidae and Momphidae are both relatively species-poor families. The European fauna contains 52 species of Blastobasidae (LEPIFORUM, 2025), while the Croatian fauna contains five species. Momphidae is a cosmopolitan family characterized by narrow forewings with raised scale tufts. Their larvae exploit a wide range of host plant resources, including mining, galling, and boring, in six plant tissues: flowers, fruits, leaves, shoot tips, stems, and roots. To the best of our knowledge, all momphids are monophagous or oligophagous on one of seven dicotyledonous families: Cistaceae, Haloragaceae, Lythraceae, Melastomataceae, Onagraceae, Rubiaceae, and Polygonaceae. The nominate genus, *Mompha* Hübner, 1825, is the

largest genus in this family (WAGNER *et al.*, 2004). Approximately 19 species have been recorded in Europe (LEPIFORUM, 2025), of which seven occur in Croatia.

This study provides the most comprehensive and up-to-date overview of the Gelechioidea fauna of Croatia to date, recording 258 species across 11 families, including 41 species new to the national fauna. Several noteworthy taxa have been documented, including recently described or taxonomically revised species, highlighting the dynamic state of research within this superfamily. Our findings demonstrate that, although the Croatian Gelechioidea fauna is relatively well studied in some regions of the country, especially the coastal regions, significant gaps remain, particularly within underexplored groups such as Scythrididae, Lecithoceridae, and Elachistidae. The presence of numerous undescribed or undetermined specimens in museums and private collections suggests that further fieldwork, coupled with integrative approaches combining morphology and molecular methods, will undoubtedly reveal additional taxa. This study represents a substantial contribution to the knowledge of Lepidoptera biodiversity in the Balkans and provides an essential foundation for future systematic, ecological, and conservation-oriented studies.

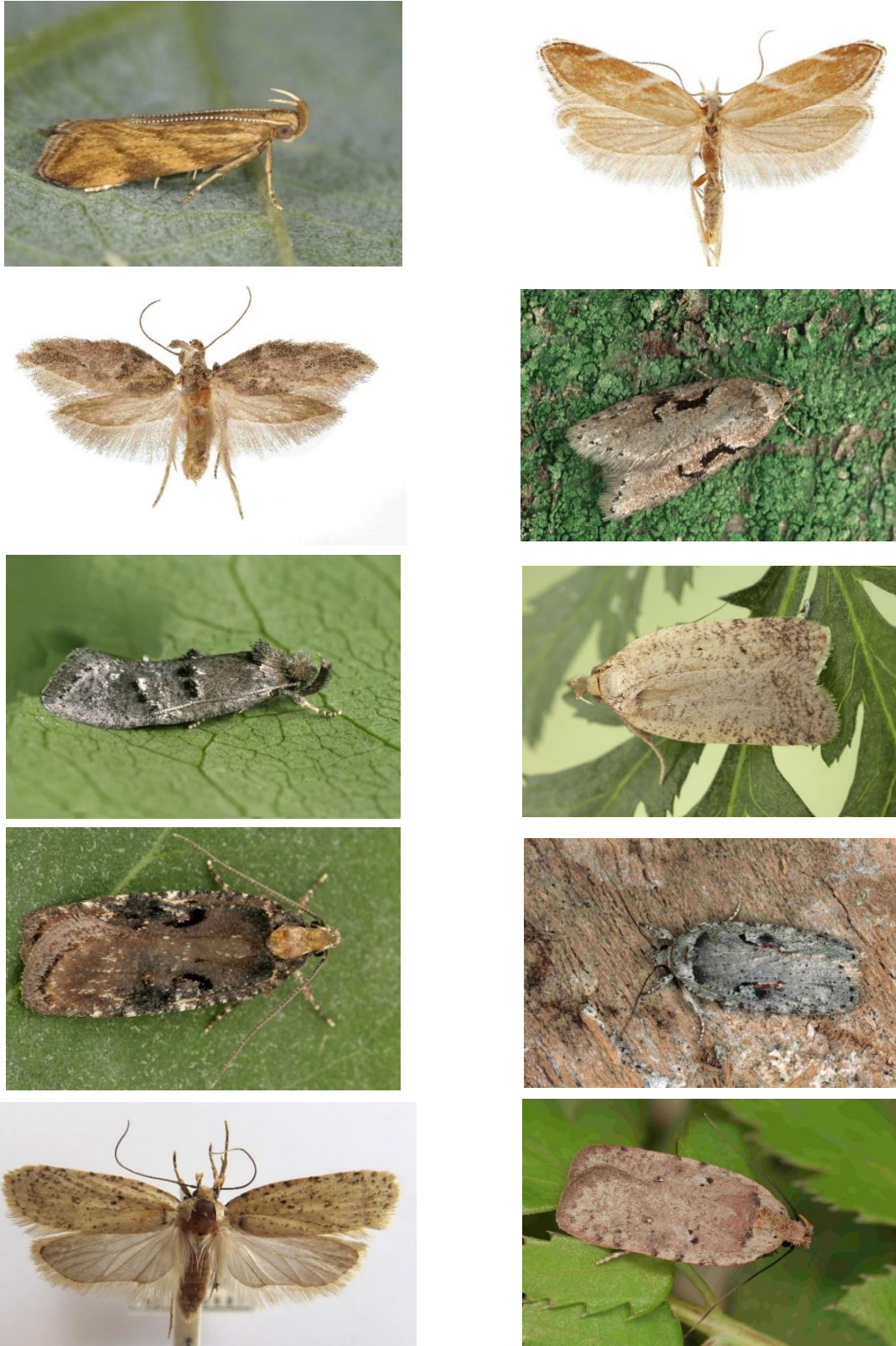


Fig. 11. *Orophia ferrugella* (Photo: P. Buchner). **12.** *O. zernyi* (Photo: J. Šumpich). **13.** *Rosetea corfuella* (Photo: J. Šumpich). **14.** *Semioscopis steinkellnerella* (Photo: P. Buchner). **15.** *Luquetia lobella* (Photo: P. Buchner). **16.** *Exaeretia preisseckeri* (Photo: P. Buchner). **17.** *Agonopterix liturosa* (Photo: P. Buchner). **18.** *A. ocellana* (Photo: P. Buchner). **19.** *A. adspersella* (Photo: Z. Tokár). **20.** *A. cervariella* (Photo: P. Buchner).

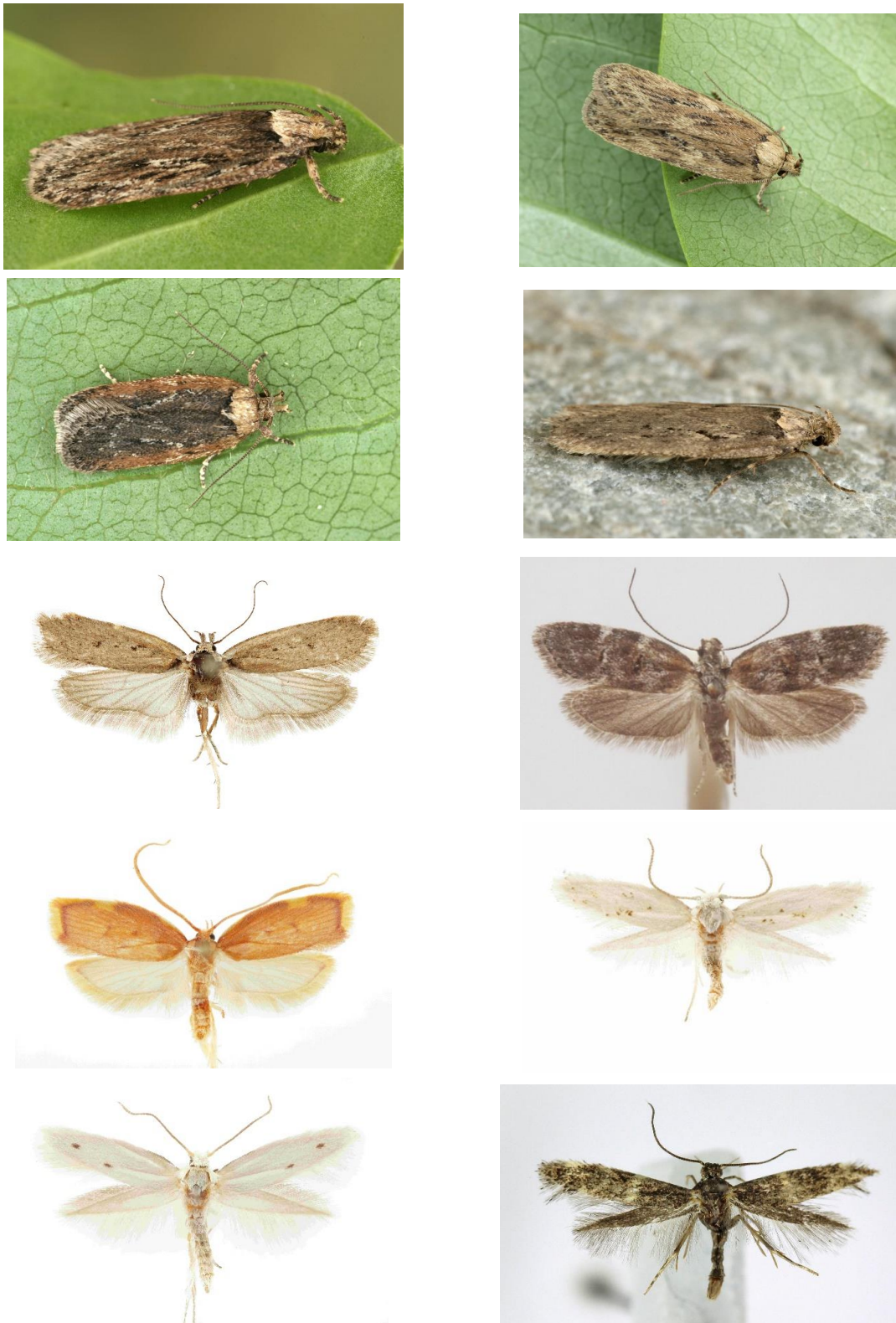


Fig. 51. *D. ultimella* (Photo: P. Buchner). **52.** *D. radiella* (Photo: P. Buchner). **53.** *D. pimpinellae* (Photo: P. Buchner). **54.** *D. discipunctella* (Photo: P. Buchner). **55.** *D. pentheri* (Photo: J. Šumpich). **56.** *Anchinia laureolella* (Photo: Z. Tokár). **57.** *Carcina ingridmariae* (Photo: J. Šumpich). **58.** *Elachista constitella* (Photo: J. Šumpich). **59.** *E. spumella* (Photo: J. Šumpich). **60.** *E. atricomella* (Photo: K. Berggren).

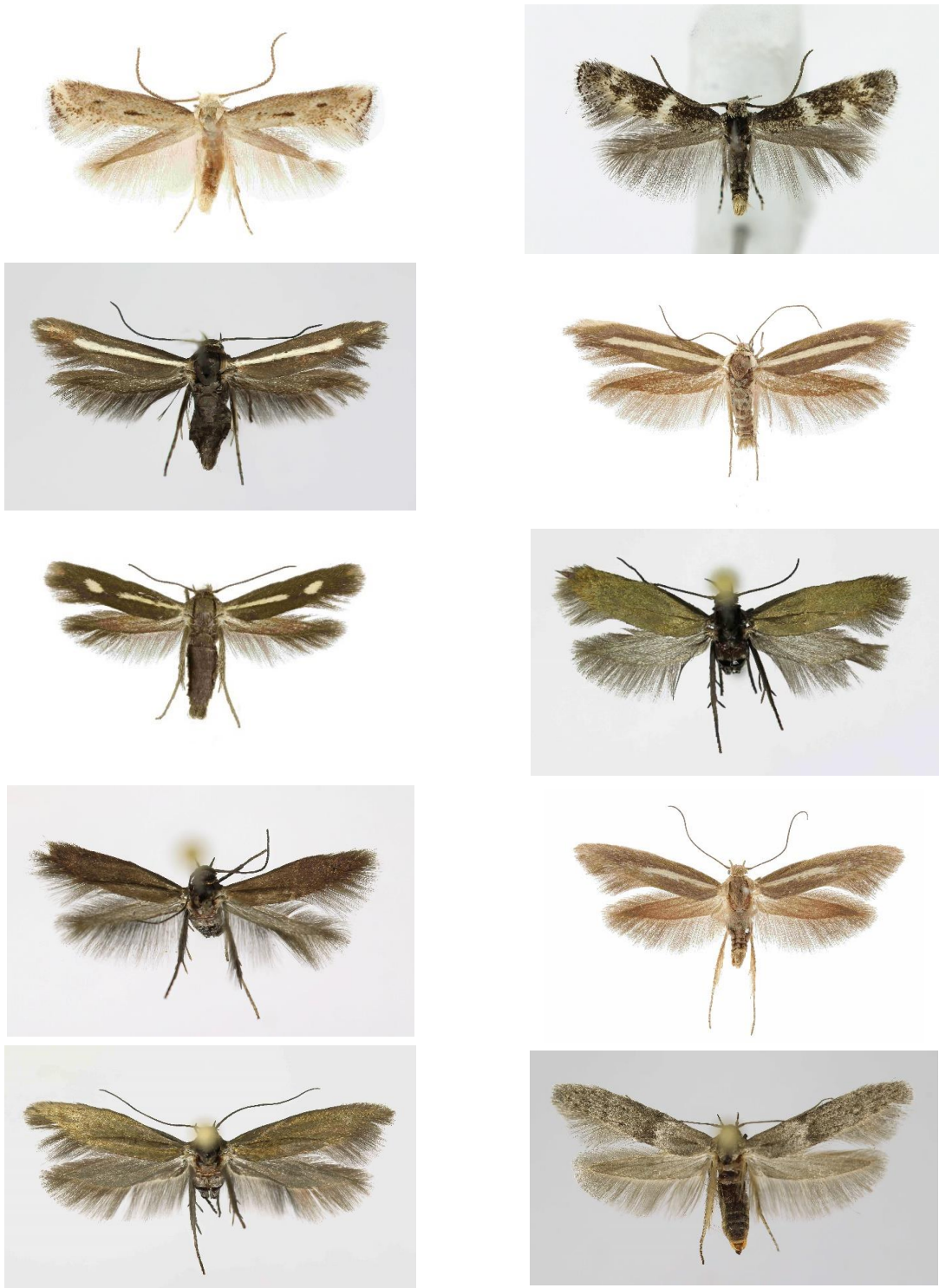


Fig. 61. *E. biatomella* (Photo: J. Šumpich). **62.** *E. clivella* (Photo: K. Berggren). **63.** *Scythris albostrata* (Photo: K. Berggren). **64.** *S. richteri* (Photo: J. Šumpich). **65.** *S. punctivittella* (Photo: J. Šumpich) **66.** *S. clavella* (Photo: K. Berggren). **67.** *S. laminella* (Photo: K. Berggren). **68.** *S. tenuivittella* (Photo: J. Šumpich). **69.** *S. fallacella* (Photo: K. Berggren). **70.** *Blastobasis phycidella* (Photo: K. Berggren).

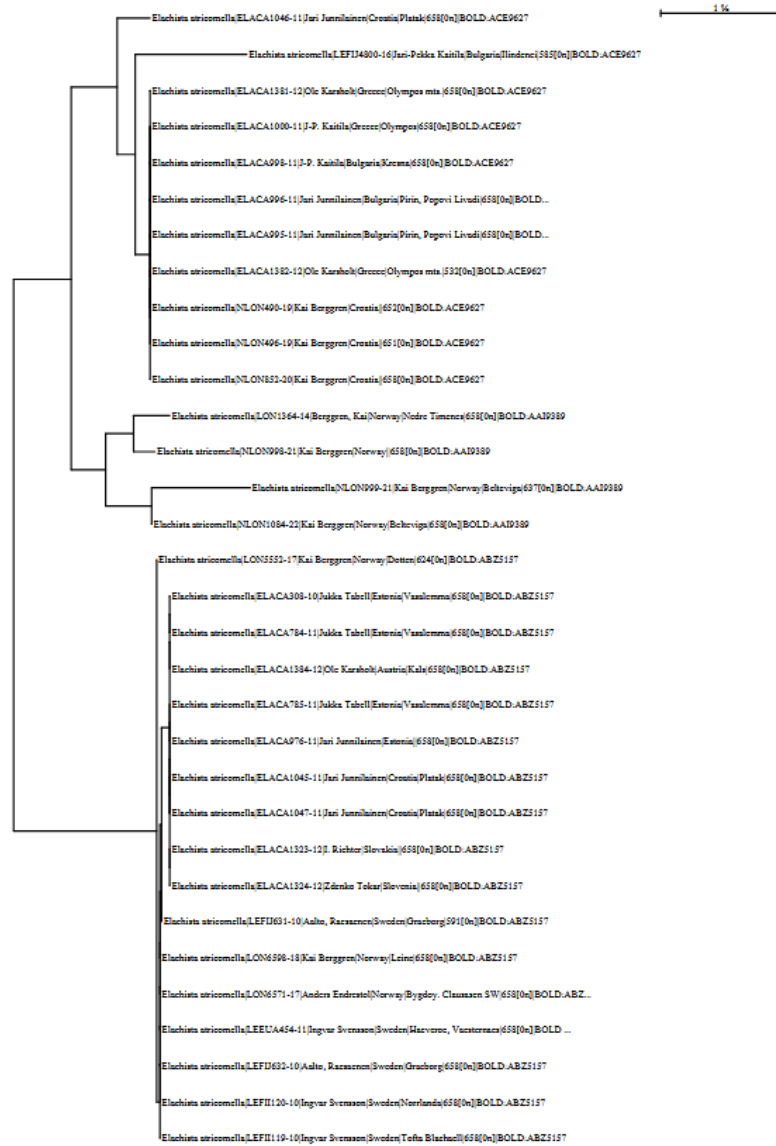


Fig. 71. The tree within BOLD showing the details of the species *Elachista atricomella*.
