

# 1st ICA Symposium on Cartography for Central and Eastern Europe

*Vienna, February 16-17, 2009*

The first ICA Symposium on Cartography for Central and Eastern Europe organized by the International Cartographic Association and the Vienna University of Technology was held in Vienna on February 16 and 17, 2009.

About 140 participants from the professional and academic community participated in the symposium. Although the idea was to bring together cartographers mainly from central and Eastern Europe, participants from other European and world countries attended the symposium.

Papers from disciplines of cartography and GIS were presented at the symposium. The papers were classified into following themes: cartography in education, atlas cartography, national cartography, multimedia cartography, cartographic modelling, history of cartography, cartographic applications and topographic cartography.

William Cartwright, the president of the International Cartographic Association and Milan Konecny, his forerunner, added to the importance of the symposium, as well as Ferjan Ormeling, ICA past Secretary General, who held an interesting keynote lecture titled *From Ortelius to OpenStreetMap – Transformation of the map into a multifunctional signpost*.

The *PhD/Master forum* was held on the first day of the symposium, and it was intended to students of postgraduate studies, who thereby had a chance to present

their theses and current work in a special session. Following postgraduate doctoral students of geodesy and geoinformatics from University of Zagreb, Faculty of Geodesy participated with presentations and posters

Pleased with the quality of presented papers, the president of the Organising Committee and Vice-president of ICA Georg Gartner announced that a book consisting of symposium's best papers is going to be published. He said he hoped the symposium would be recognized as a traditional place for sharing knowledge from disciplines of cartography for the area of Central and Eastern Europe.

# Prvi kartografski simpozij ICA-e za centralnu i istočnu Europu

Beč, 16-17. veljače 2009.

U organizaciji Međunarodnoga kartografskog društva (ICA) i Tehničkog sveučilišta u Beču, u Beču je od 15. do 17. veljače 2009. godine održan *Prvi kartografski simpozij za centralnu i istočnu Europu ICA-e (1st ICA Symposium on Cartography for Central and Eastern Europe)*.

Simpoziju je prisustvovalo oko 140 sudionika iz akademske zajednice i gospodarstva. Iako zamišljen da okupi prvenstveno sudionike iz centralne i istočne Europe, na simpoziju je bilo sudionika i iz drugih zemalja.

Na simpoziju su bili prikazani radovi iz područja kartografije i GIS-a, a bili su svrstani u sljedeće skupine: kartografija u edukaciji, atlasi, nacionalna kartografija, multimedijaska kartografija, kartografsko modeliranje, povijesna kartografija, kartografske aplikacije i topografska kartografija.
