CUSTOMS AND DAILY LIFE OF THE SERBS IN KORENICA AND UDBI-NA REGION BEFORE THE WORLD WAR II AND DURING SOCIALISM

In this paper the author provides information about the customs and everyday life of Serbs in the area of Korenica and Udbina during socialism. On the basis of oral statements and archival material from the Croatian State Archives, he draws conclusions about inter-ethnic relations, the attitude of the Serbs of the Korenica region towards religion and customs at the time of child birth, marriage and death. It also deals with the position of women in the patriarchal environment of eastern Lika.
