

## Focus and scope

Krčki zbornik (Krk Almanac - ISSN: 0455-0609; e-ISSN: 2975-3546) is a multidisciplinary and peer-reviewed, scientific and professional open access journal, which aims to publish quality scientific and professional articles that will deepen the understanding of the Krk and Kvarner area, especially in the domain of humanities, but also in other various sciences, then to accentuate the most relevant social, cultural, scientific and educational issues, challenges and problems of the mentioned microregion, as well as to find certain possible solutions for the latter. Non-review articles, such as book reviews and reports from scientific conferences, as well as relevant news, obituaries, and other, are also published in the Krčki zbornik (Krk Almanac). This journal publishes texts in Croatian, English, Italian, as well as German. Authors will not be charged any kind of fee for submission or publishing in the journal. The Krčki zbornik focuses on the publication of papers from these scientific areas and fields:

- ✓ social sciences, *especially*
  - sociology,
  - demography;
- ✓ humanities, *especially*
  - philology,
  - history,
  - art history,
  - archaeology,
  - ethnology and anthropology,
  - religious studies (*interdisciplinary field*);
- ✓ artistic area, *especially*
  - literature;
- ✓ interdisciplinary fields of science, *especially*
  - geography,
  - croatology;
- ✓ as well as articles from other areas and fields of science, provided that their research and topics are related to the island of Krk, Kvarner and/or the Northern Adriatic.

Since the Krčki zbornik by its very profile encourages multidisciplinary research, other relevant topics are also welcome, especially those that correspond to the scope of this journal, depending on the expert assessment of its Editorial board.
