Publishing ethics

Jezik, a journal for the culture of the Croatian literary language, operates in accordance with accepted ethical principles in science. By submitting their papers to Jezika, the authors confirm the authenticity of the content and guarantee that the submitted papers have not been previously published in another language (in part or in full), that they have not already been published or are not in the process of being published in another journal.

By sending the text to the journal Jezik, the author undertakes that the text is original, that it does not infringe other people's copyrights in the sense of the Copyright and Related Rights Act (http://www.zakon.hr/z/106/Zakon-o-autorskom-pravu- and-related-rights.) If the work has already been published or if the author has submitted the work to another publisher, he will inform the journal Jezik.

Authors are responsible for the authenticity of their work and thus possible plagiarism, regardless of whether the plagiarism was discovered in a review process or after the publication of the paper in a journal.
