

Publication ethics and scientific integrity statement

Since its foundation in 1969, i.e. since the beginning of its publishing activities in 1970, the Krk Historical Society has dedicated itself to the publication of high-quality scientific, professional and other articles, texts and many various publications according to editorial and review processes aligned with the strictest ethical standards. Therefore, Society has been continuously focused on maintaining, preserving and protecting the integrity of the publication process as one of the essential elements of academic work and scientific research.

The Editorial board of the Krčki zbornik (Krk Almanac) also pays particular attention to the question of scientific and academic integrity in publishing, so it strongly supports and applies the principle according to which the editorial responsibility includes efforts to discern, prevent and disable any deviation from the fundamental principles of scientific integrity, such as plagiarism, possible copyright infringement, as well as other types of non-compliance with academic standards. The Editorial board of the journal undertakes to prevent any attempt to violate the stated principles and standards by authors, reviewers and other collaborators or, on the other hand, by the editors themselves, that is, by individual members of the Editorial board.

All ethical standards that the Editorial board of the Krčki zbornik (Krk Almanac) strives to apply in the editorial process emanate from the intention to ensure a fair, impartial and clear review process, and the same is expected from the reviewers. From the latter, as well as from all the authors who publish their works in the Krčki zbornik (Krk Almanac) and from every participant in the publication process, the Editorial board of the aforementioned journal and the Krk Historical Society, as its publisher, expect that when cooperating with each other, they respect established customs of civilized academic communication, as well as the good practice of sustainable publishing, and especially all principles, and established norms related to scientific and academic integrity, as well as publication ethics, in accordance with the internationally accepted criteria for scientific publication recommended by the [Committee on Publication Ethics – COPE](#) and according to publicly available recommendations of the Ministry of Science and Education of the Republic of Croatia, that is, its Committee for Ethics in Science and Higher Education ([Odbor za etiku u znanosti i visokom obrazovanju](#)), which are highly respected and applied in the process of editing and publishing each volume of the Krčki zbornik (Krk Almanac).
