

Publication Ethics and Publication Malpractice Statement

Croatian Conservation Institute's periodical, *Portal*, is a peer-reviewed academic journal published annually since 2010. Directed at presenting research and professional papers on investigations, treatments, results, theoretical reflections and historical overviews, *Portal* is open to all those who wish to contribute, professionally and scholarly, to the reflection and promotion of art conservation and restoration. *Portal* is committed to following strict ethical rules and expects all submitting authors to uphold the high standard of publication ethics as set out by the Commission on Publication Ethics ([COPE](#)).

Editorial Board:

The editorial board assesses the intellectual content of manuscripts with impartiality, irrespective of the authors' age, race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, ethnic background, citizenship, or political orientation. It bears complete responsibility for ensuring the engagement of highly qualified expert reviewers. Prior to arriving at a final decision regarding manuscript acceptance, the Editorial Board reviews both the manuscript itself and the comments and recommendations provided by the reviewers. The board may decide to accept the manuscript, accept it following suggested revisions, or reject it. The names and email addresses included in this journal will be exclusively used for publication purposes and will not be disclosed to any third party.

Reviewers:

Each manuscript undergoes evaluation by a minimum of two independent experts in the respective field. These experts are accountable for scientifically assessing the manuscript and providing recommendations regarding its publication. The review process is carried out anonymously, ensuring that the reviewers' identities remain undisclosed to the authors, and conversely, the authors' identities are kept confidential from the reviewers. Should a selected reviewer feel inadequately qualified to review the research presented in a manuscript or anticipate an inability to promptly conduct the review, it is expected that they inform the editor and recuse themselves from the review process. Additionally, reviewers are encouraged to bring to the editor's attention any significant similarity or overlap between the manuscript under consideration and any other previously published paper within their personal knowledge.

Authors:

The manuscript submitted for publication is anticipated to be an original work, with no prior publication or submission for review to any other journal. The author assumes complete responsibility for the content of the article and must secure permission to publish any necessary information. Before publication, the author is required to meticulously review the edited copy of the manuscript provided by the editor and provide authorization. Authors are responsible for obtaining the necessary permissions to use visuals and any other contributions from the relevant copyright holders.
