

# Instructions for Authors

## Accepted Formats

To ensure rapid refereeing and publication, please submit your paper in MS Word (.doc or .docx) file format according to the detailed [Instructions for Authors](#). The journal publishes a complete selection of original articles, review articles, feature articles and technical notes:

- 1. Original Research Papers** - Articles which report original research work
- 2. Review Articles** - Articles which present an overview of the "state of the art" of current research and reports from leading researchers working in a given field, recent major advances and discoveries, significant gaps in research, current debates and ideas concerning future directions for research initiatives
- 3. Invited Feature Articles** - Articles intended to serve readers with an in-depth analysis and the author's interpretation of a new and cutting-edge argument, usually commissioned from a well-known expert in the sector
- 4. Technical Notes** - Technical notes are short, fully referenced technical articles. A typical technical note will have limited scope often dealing with a single technical issue of particular importance to RFID and WSN studies. The number of pages is at the discretion of authors; on average papers are 4-12 pages long. When preparing your paper for publication, we strongly advise that you pay particular attention to your research methods, key results and language.

## Originality

Submissions must be original work, the copyright to which is not already owned elsewhere. Originality, creativity and a cross-disciplinary approach or perspectives are strongly encouraged.

Publication of conference papers which have been substantially rewritten and augmented to be suitable for journal publication is allowed. Significant duplication of papers and parallel submissions are not allowed and in such cases InTech reserves the right to withdraw publishing rights from authors and co-authors of the paper for a substantial period of time. It is the author's responsibility to check for possible copyright conflict with the copyright holder.

## Language

Given that the manuscript must be written in English, if English is not your mother tongue we recommend that you have your paper proofread to ensure its accuracy and improve the language quality.
